#### KAMLOOPS MINING DIVISION

Under our supervision a magnetometer survey was completed on the Sunshine Nos. 10, 11, 15 and 16 Mineral Claims, which are a portion of the Vanex Minerals Ltd. holdings in the Meadow Creek area, Highland Valley.

A sharp No. 3 magnetometer was used in the survey. The readings were taken at 300 foot intervals as shown on the accompanying map.

A background of 27400 was taken, and the readings shown on the map are the difference between the actual readings on the instrument and the background count.

The readings on the map do not indicate the presence of an Anomaly, and no further geophysical work is recommended.
