### INTRODUCTION

During 1973 a geochemical program was conducted over the Cub Mineral Claims which are located on Vancouver Island 20 miles north of Tofino, British Columbia.

This program was accomplished by Mr. Walter Guppy under the direction of W.G. Stevenson, P.Eng. This report compiles the data collected, describes the methods used and details the cost of this work in accordance with the provisions of the Mineral Act, and is designed to satisfy the assessment requirements on the Cub Mineral Claims 8 - 12 and Nub 1 and 2 for a period of one year.

#### CLAIMS AND TITLE

Mr. Guppy holds title to 14 contiguous mineral claims. You will find attached a tabulation marked Appendix C with data pertaining to these mineral claims, as shown in the Gold Commissioner's office in Vancouver. I have also attached a map marked Appendix B drawn to a scale of 1" = 1,500 feet which shows the outline of the claim block, the individual mineral claims, their relation with some of the surface features, and the outline of the area surveyed.

#### LOCATION AND ACCESS

The mineral claims are in a one contiguous block extending over Dry Creek, a tributary on the northwest side of Bedwell River, three miles north of its junction with Ursus Creek. The claims are approximately six miles north of the logging camp at the mouth of Bedwell River, approximately  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles northwest of the Bucaneer and Muscateer Mines. More precisely they are located at  $49^{\circ}$  26' north latitude and  $125^{\circ}$  44' west longitude.

Access can be gained to a boat landing at Bedwell then by an improved logging road which extends northerly up Bedwell River and across the south east corner of the claim block.

#### HISTORY

In 1938 gold was discovered in the Drainage of Bedwell River. Underground drifting was accomplished during 1941 on the nearby Prosper, Muscateer and Bucaneer Mines.

In 1940 the B.C. Department of Mines and Petroleum Resources published a map contained in preliminary Bulletin Number 8, on the geology of Bedwell River area. This was updated as Bulletin No. 13 in 1941. Since that time, additional

prospecting, claim staking, development and mining has been accomplished.

Mr. Walter Guppy has prospected and held mineral claims in the area since 1938. In 1964 he shipped eight tons of copper magnetite ore from his mineral claims located three miles south of the Cub Claims.

In 1971 and 1972 Mr. Guppy staked the Cub Mineral Claims and during 1972 and 1973 accomplished a program of geological mapping and geochemical sampling.

#### **GEOLOGY**

The contact between Coast Range intrusive rocks and Volcanic rocks of the Vancouver Group is exposed near the headwaters of Dry Creek. The attached geological map based on the data collected by Mr. Guppy will show this relationship.

A strong, west-northwesterly trending fault crosses the west side of the claim block, as shown on the map accompanying G.S.C. Paper 68-50.

#### MINERALIZATION

The Bedwell River property is positioned 15 miles northeast of Falconbridge's Catface Mountain property, 12 miles

southerly from WesternMines, and 28 miles northwest of Noranda's old Maggie Lake iron copper mine.

Within the Cub Claim Group, copper and molybdenum mineralization have been recognized.

#### GEOCHEMISTRY

During 1972 a reconnaissance geochemical sampling program was conducted over a part of the subject claim block.

One hundred and two soil and silt samples were collected for geochemical determination of copper, and gold content.

The samples were collected from the "B" soil horizon from holes put down with a sharp narrow bladed spade to a depth of approximately 6 inches. The samples were packaged in specially prepared heavy paper bags. They were partially dried in the field, then completely dried and screened to minus 80 mesh in the laboratory. The geochemical assaying was accomplished by Acme Analytical Laboratories with hot HCL extraction for copper then assayed with atomic absorption.

Based on the assay data copper 70 ppm or greater; and gold .05 ppm or greater are considered anomalous.

On the attached map marked Appendix D, the sample locations, and the assay results in parts per billion for gold has been shown, and on Appendix E the sample locations and assay results for copper.

The samples with anomalous assay results have been indicated with special symbols.
