

ZULU EXPLORATIONS LTD (NPL)

DRILLING Z4 DRILL HOLE

The drill used was a Longyear no. 38.

Wire line drill size BQ with 1 7/16" core.

LOCATION

Bowron River Area, 50 miles SE of Prince George, Cariboo Mining Division.

On LAD 9 Mineral Claim

On the Lot adjoining and south of LOT 4844, formerly coal license 960.

Approximately 3,600 feet south of the Bowron River and 200 feet west of Tsus Creek.

AZIMUTH - 1° quadrilateral 53° 121° NW

Reference map - 93 H/13 W

ELEVATION - approximately 2460

INCLINATION - 90°

DEPTH OF HOLE - 431 feet

Because of the unusually deep overburden, containing thick beds of silt, soft clay, bentonite and boulders, the drill hole was costly and time consuming. Bit costs were high and a new sub-adapter and 200 feet of new BW casing had to be purchased.

The numerous large boulders, not only ruined the Tricone bits, but wasted considerable time. When the Tricone bit at the bottom end of the casing had penetrated a large boulder, the casing had to be lifted from the hole in order that the Tricone bit could be replaced with a casing shoe. After putting the casing back down the drill hole into the boulder, the drill rods with a diamond bit was used to drillthrough the boulder. Then after pulling out the drill rods, the casing had to be lifted out and the casing shoe replaced with a Tricone bit. The casing was then put down again to complete the hole through the boulder.

The casing was drilled into the solid strata-soft shales and sandstone-at a depth of 350 feet.

On several occasions the drilling mud failed to hold the hole through the soft shales and congolmerates, and eventually the casing reached a depth of 399 feet. From 355 feet to 392 feet the strata consisted of soft shale, conglomerate and sandstone bands of from 2" to 6" in thickness. The shale bands contained numerous coal stringers. Also the sludge from the circulating water indicated some of the coal bands were at least 6" thick. The conglomerate seams were easily broken and it was difficult to recover any core more than 3 inches in length. This forced the driller to pull up the core tube dozens of times after having only drilled not more than one foot.

Because of the soft conglomerates and shale bands from 396 to 431 feet the driller thought it was too risky to attempt pushing the casing down 32 feet to 431 feet.







