

INTRODUCTION

This report summarizes the results of a magnetometer survey performed for assessment work credit over the area of the JOE 1-12 mineral claim group, Taylor River Area, Alberni Mining Division, British Columbia. The field work was done during the period November 19-22, 27-30 and December 16, 1974. The writer was assisted in the field by Mr. Uno Leis, Strato Geological Ltd., Vancouver, British Columbia.

The JOE 1-12 mineral claim group is under option to Gold Valley Resources Ltd., 202 - 640 West Hastings Street, Vancouver, British Columbia.

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

Fracture patterns associated with quartz-vein structures on Mineral Lease 66 (L. 975, 976, 977) lying north of the JOE 1-12 mineral claim group, strike southwesterly into the area of the JOE claims.

Results of the magnetometer survey confirm the geological observations in that isomagnetic contours trend from the area of the quartz-bearing fracture zones on Mineral Lease 66 southwesterly onto the area of the JOE claims. Total local magnetic relief was 678 gammas.

No opinion can be given as to the actual ground area covered by the JOE 1-12 mineral claims until a survey of the location of the JOE claim posts has been completed.

PROPERTY - LOCATION, ACCESS, TOPOGRAPHY

The property consists of 12 located mineral claims situated about twenty-six miles east of Port Alberni, British Columbia, astride Highway No. 4 en route to Tofino.

Taylor River occupies an east-west valley depression through the claim group. As a result of recent timber-cutting activities secondary logging roads provide fairly easy access over the property. Overburden is mostly gravel in the river valley. The depth is unknown.

Topography varies from about 200 feet to some 800 feet above sea-level over the claim group.

CLAIMS

Twelve located mineral claims named JOE 1-12 inclusive are recorded with the British Columbia Department of Mines and Petroleum Resources in the Alberni Mining Division, Vancouver Island, B.C. Information on record with the B.C. Department of Mines at Vancouver on January 24, 1975 is as follows:

The writer assisted by Mr. Uno Leis searched for claim posts over the claim group area. No claim posts were found except the initial post JOE #8. Data from British Columbia Department of Mines and Petroleum Resources Forms A and G (copies at end of this report), a report by J.P. Elwell, P.Eng., dated October 24, 1974 and topographical features were used in the search for the claim posts. During the course of the magnetometer survey a constant lookout was made for the claim posts. Finally

the initial post for JOE 8 was found on December 16, 1974.

A survey station bearing a metal tag on which was inscribed "McElhanney TG 3633", was located during the period of the magnetometer survey in the area of Crown Grant L. 975. A survey plan showing the location of this metal tag and the initial post of JOE 8 was obtained from Mr. L. Trenholme, Teck Mining Group, on January 27, 1975. This information was forwarded to Gold Valley Resources on January 28, 1975 for consideration.

No opinion can be given regarding the actual area covered by the JOE 1-12 mineral claims until a survey is made of the location of the remaining JOE claim posts.

HISTORY - PREVIOUS DEVELOPMENT - REFERENCES

Little evidence was found of any previous exploration work done on the ground believed to belong to the JOE claim group.

Prospectors in search of gold dug test-pits and drove adits on the nearby Crown Grants L. 975, 976, 977 north of the JOE claims in the early decades of this century.

Sileurian Chieftain Mining Co. Ltd. did exploration work on gold-bearing quartz veins carrying sulphides of iron and copper on the Crown Grant claims during the 1960's.

Lou-Mex Mines Ltd. acquired the Crown Grant claims and adjoining mineral claims in 1971 and carried out diamond drilling. The company optioned their ground in 1974 to the Teck Mining Group, who did further diamond drilling and exploration work.

#### GEOLOGY - REGIONAL AND PROPERTY

The following is taken from a report by J.P. Elwell on the JOE Claim Group dated October 24, 1974. The information relates generally to the nearby Crown Grant claims (Mineral Lease 66) which lie just to the north of the JOE mineral claims. Elwell writes as follows:

#### "REGIONAL GEOLOGY

The regional geology is described in some detail by B.W.W. McDougall, P.Eng. in his report dated 1959. The following has been based on his description.

The general area covered by the JOE claims and surrounding groups is underlain by volcanic rocks of the Vancouver group, considered Jurrassic age, and include andesites and basalts as well as hybred types. The volcanics are sparsely intruded by dikes of diorite and quartz diorite with the transition on the contact from coarse grained diorite to the grainless volcanics taking place over a width of one inch or less.

Shearing has taken place in a generally northeast-southwest direction over a width of at least 650 feet on the area covered by the southwest trending branch of the Mineral Lease which adjoins the JOE #8 claim. Within this shear are a number of roughly parallel shear zone type of veins varying in width from a few inches to over ten feet. The veins consist of quartz carrying varying amounts of sulphide mineralization, mainly pyrite, with minor amounts of chalcopyrite. Gold values appear to be largely associated with the pyrite with the amount of gold being fairly consistent with the amount of pyrite present. McDougall states that the veins show no difference in the type of mineralization over a 2,000 foot altitude range, indicating that they are of high temperature origin, and have been exposed by deep erosion.

#### ECONOMIC GEOLOGY

Most of the exploration work on the Crown Grant claims has been directed on the main, or No. 6 vein. This work includes a 363 foot adit and two short adits, and a number of diamond drill holes cutting the vein at a number of places along strike, both near surface and a depth. This work shows the vein to have a fairly consistent strike of about  $56^{\circ}$  and a dip to the north of about  $85^{\circ}$ . The width varies from 5 to over 7 feet with gold values ranging from less than 0.1 oz. per ton to better than 0.80 oz. per ton over these widths, depending on the concentration of sulphides. The lowest showing of this vein is very close to the north boundary of the JOE #8 claim.

Projecting this vein to the southwest, it should cross through the JOE #8, #2, and #1 claims with the most likely chance of locating it well above the river valley on either side, in the JOE #1 and #8 claims.

In addition to this main vein, the maps show a number of other parallel veins on which very little work has been done, but which could conceivably also continue into the JOE claims."

This writer is of the opinion from megascopic inspection the basic volcanics on the north side of Taylor River are more altered than those on the south side and may be separated by an east-west trending fault zone.

#### MAGNETOMETER SURVEY

#### CONTROL

Compass lines, chained at 100-foot intervals, were run on azimuth 100 degrees and 280 degrees (True) from a base line. Survey lines were done at intervals of 200 and also 400 feet. Magnetometer reading stations were marked with flagging as shown on the plan accompanying this report on scale 1" = 200 feet.

#### INSTRUMENT AND METHOD

The instrument used was a Coni-Mag self-orienting digital readout-type portable magnetometer, serial #00133. Accuracy is quoted at  $\pm$  15 gammas by the manufacturer, Coniagas Research Inc., Toronto.

RESULTS

Total magnetic relief varied between 11000 and 11678 gamma intensity, a difference of 678 gammas. Isomagnetic contours were drawn at 100 gamma intervals.

INTERPRETATION


Local magnetic "lows" occur in the overburden areas of the claim group particularly in the valley of the Taylor River. Small single or double-reading "highs" occur in the areas of abundant outcrop of basic volcanic lavas above the valley depression.

The trend of the isomagnetic contours is southwest suggesting the geologic structures north-northeast of the claim group are continuing along strike onto the JOE claim group area.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The remaining JOE claim posts should be located and surveyed to establish the claimed area relative to adjoining claims. Once this has been done consideration should be given to a program of diamond drilling.






