## PROSPECTING REPORT - CUB MINERAL CLAIMS

During 1974 systematic prospecting was carried out over the Cub Group Mineral Claims.

Three areas were traversed and mapped, covering the accessible sections of 10 mineral claims. Most of the remainder of the area covered by these claims is inaccessible or too steep to traverse.

### CLAIMS & TITLE

Attached is a photo-copy of part of map 92F5E (M) showing the location of the claim group. Also attached is a claim map on the scale of 1" to 1500' showing areas traversed and mapped in relation to claim boundaries. Appendix C attached gives the tabulation of claim data. These claims are held in the name of Golden Hinde Mines Ltd. (N.P.L.)

### LOCATION & ACCESS

These claims cover an area drained by Noble Creek and Dry creek, which are tributaries on the northwest side of Bedwell River, about six miles inland from tidewater at the head of Bedwell Sound. Access is by trails branching from the main Bedwell River road, which is a logging road that was re-located over the old Department of Mines access road that was originally constructed previous to 1914.

### History

Placer gold was discovered at Bedwell River in the 1860's and Chinese placer miners were active in the area until about 1889. Lode gold and copper prospects were located in the area before the turn of the century. Some of these are still held as Crown grants. The Cub claims represent a re-location of some of the old prospects. B.C. Dept. of Mines Bulletin #8 by H. Sargent, published in 1940, mentions narrow quartz veins on Noble Creek and disseminated mineralization on Dry Creek. These showings, as well as the O.K. property described by Sargent, are covered by the Cub group.

### Mineralization

The stock-work and disseminated mineralization described by Sargent is shown on the "Dry Creek Section" map. Some indications of disseminated mineralization that could be tied in with geochemical anomalies were also found to the north-east and south-west of Dry Creek. A number of the narrow gold-bearing quartz veins were also found and their position mapped.

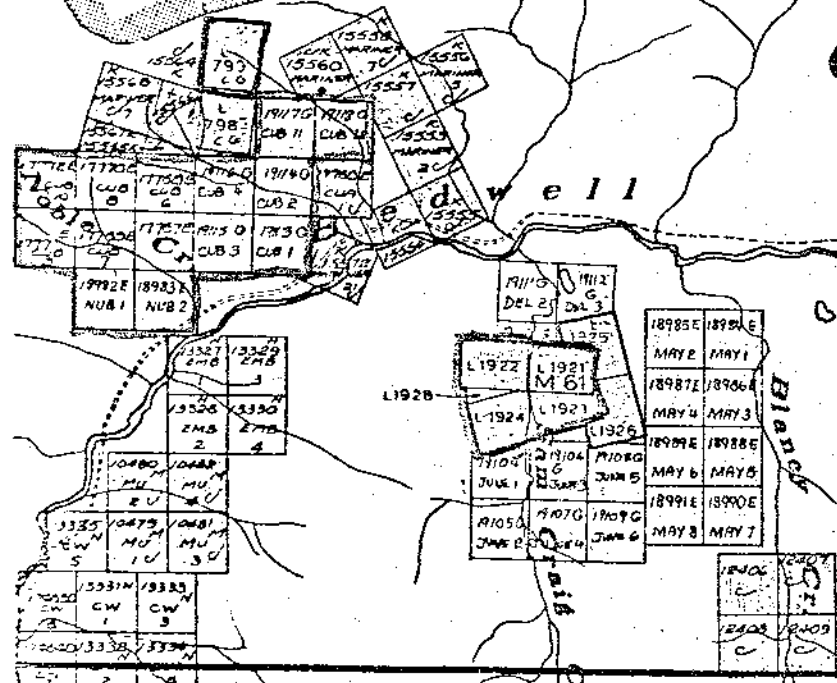

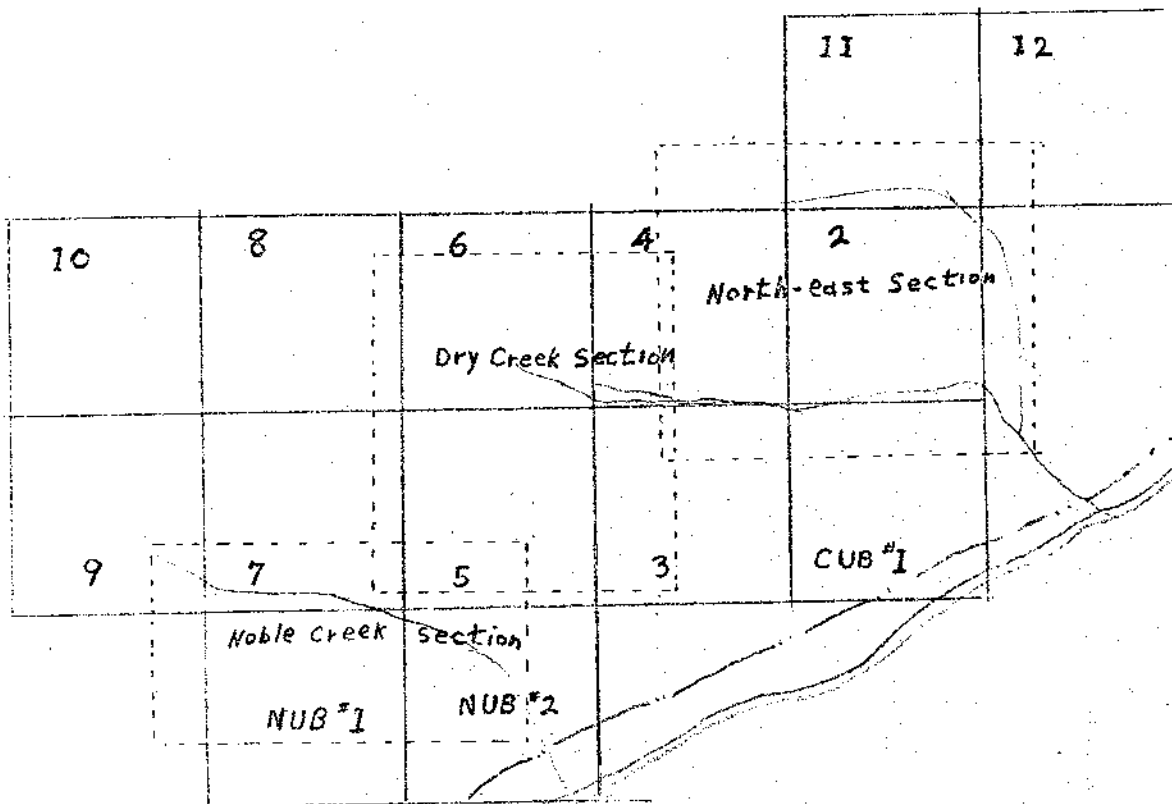

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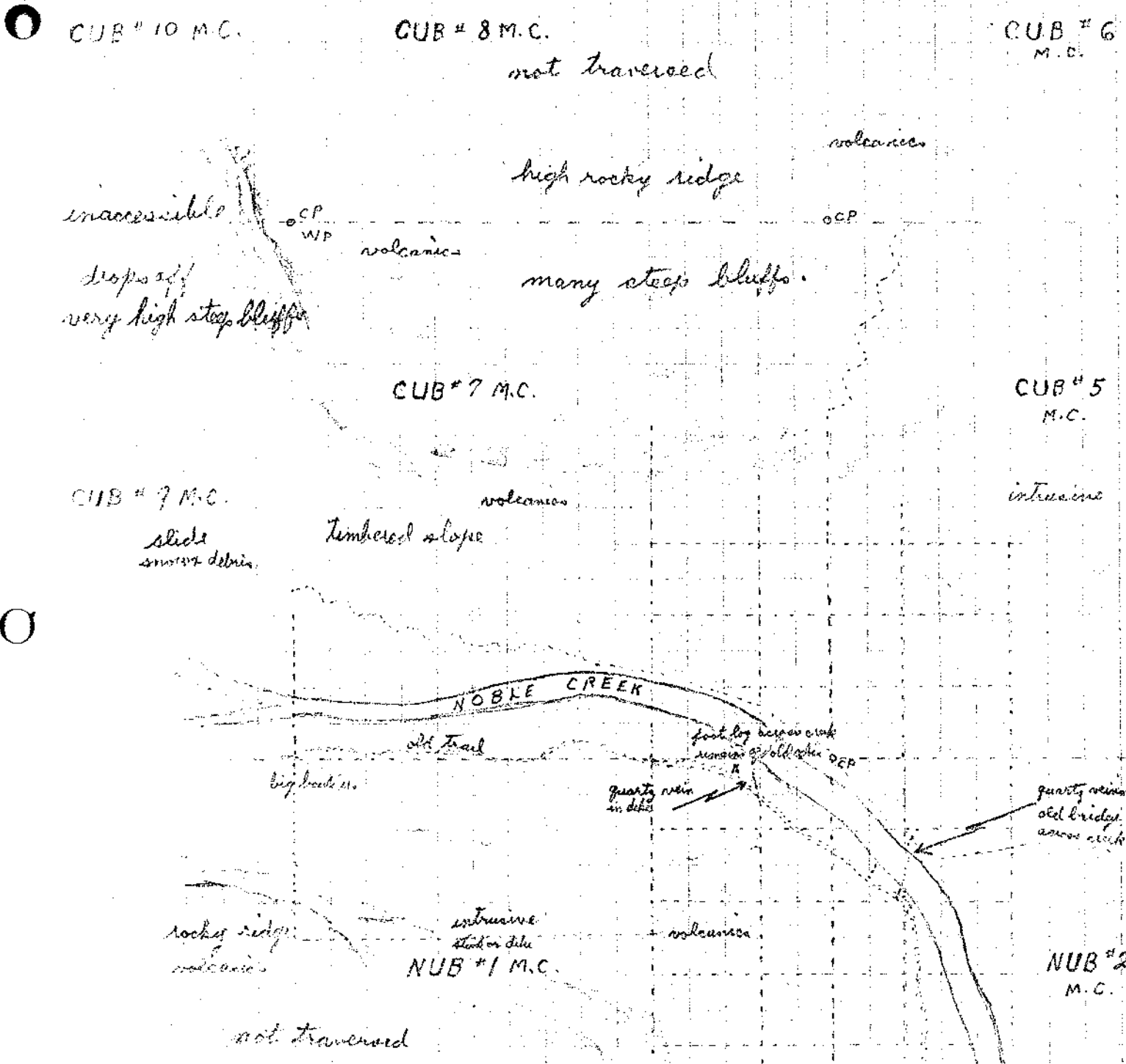

STATEMENT OF COSTS

ASSESSMENT WORK PROGRAM - CUB MINERAL CLAIMS
