

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INTRODUCTION:

From October 31 - November loth 1974, Herman O.Plank and John Schoonderwoert prospectors conducted a limited amount of diamond core drilling on the FAP 2 Mineral claim, Summerland area on behalf of Austro-Can Explorations Ltd.

The purpose of the drilling was to examine an area of copper bearing mineralization exposed by trenching to try and locate any lenses of massive sulphide mineralization or any major structure zones that may possibely be associated with mineralization of economic interest.

PROPERTY, LOCATION AND ACCESS.

The FAP 2 Mineral claims are situated along Trout Creek, west of the village of Summerland. Located on the western side of Okanagan Lake, Ossoyoos Mining Division, Promince of British Columbia. Latitude 49 37 N, Longitude 119 52 W N.T.S. 82 E/13

Access to the property is via a good Secondary gravel road up Trout Creek, this Road passes in an area East-West direction through the claim.

PREVIOUS WORK:

Previous work on the mineral claim consisted largely of trenching, magnetometer and electromagnetometer surveying.

DIAMOND DRILL CORE LOGS:

Drill core recovery on all 138 feet were good. Drilling from the surface to 55 feet consisted of greenish-grey miliceous dolomite, mineralized with pyrite and some chalcopyrite, drilling from 55 feet to 113 feet consists of fenite, from 113 - 116 feet of dolomite, from 116 - 138 feet of fenite respectivly.

THE DRILL HOLE LOCATION

is loo' East and 60 feet north of the south west corner of FAP 2 mineral claim.

The elevation is approx. 2300 feet, drill hole direction is 90 magnetic to the east, inclination of the hole 70, distance 138 feet.

LOCATION OF THE CORE STORAGE:

The cores are storaged in a adit, 200 feet north of the FAP 2 mineral claim south west corner.




