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SUMMARY AND DISCUSSION:

A total expenditure in excess of \$70,000 was incurred coring 1819 feet of BQ diamond drill holes on the An Claim Group in a 31-day period between July 1, 1975 and July 31, 1975. The job was helicopter-supported with minimal disturbance of the terrain.

Only \$1,000 of the above work was available for assessment credits and the 358 feet of BQ core from DDH An-75-2 located approximately 200 metres west of the Initial Post of An #4 mineral claim. One half of the core was bagged and shipped for assay. The remainder was left in core boxes stored beside a small lake 2 miles southeast of Mt. Kinney.

Enclosed cost data includes one invoice for an amount in excess of assessment credits applied.

Coates Enterprises Ltd., of 256 A Simpson Road, Richmond, B.C., was the drilling contractor.

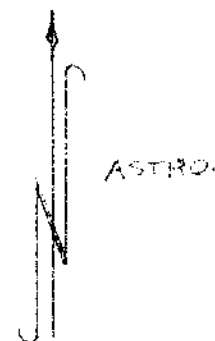
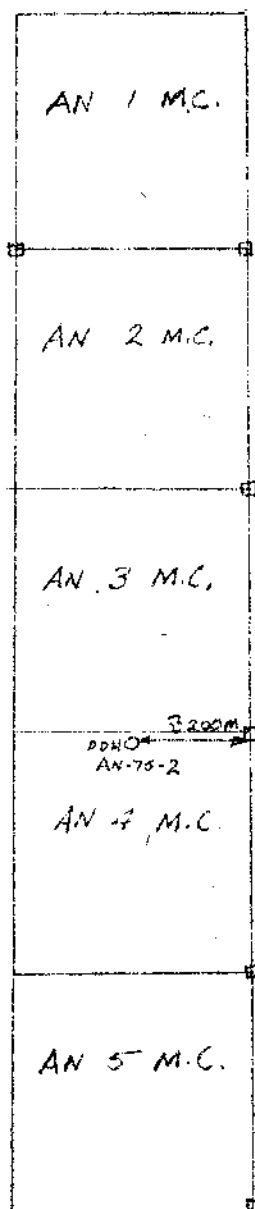
