PROGRAM

During the month of January 1976 a program of percussion drilling was carried out over a favourable structure located approximately 3500 feet north-east of the current open pit.

The writer and a helper prepared a grid, spotted the drill holes, split and inspected all drill cuttings and marked the locations of the holes.

The drilling was carried out by H. D. Drilling of Kamloops, B. C. Assaying of drill cuttings was done at the laboratory of Bondar Clegg & Co., 1500 Pemberton Ave., North Vancouver.

During the period of this report fourteen percussion holes were completed with a total footage of 1145'. During the same period forty-eight assays were done representing 235 feet of hole. These assays are included with this report. Work is still being carried out on the claim group in a continuing program which will be recorded during the next year.

A map of scale 1" equals 400' is included with this report and shows the locations of the drill holes in relation to claim boundaries, the open pit and the roads in the area.

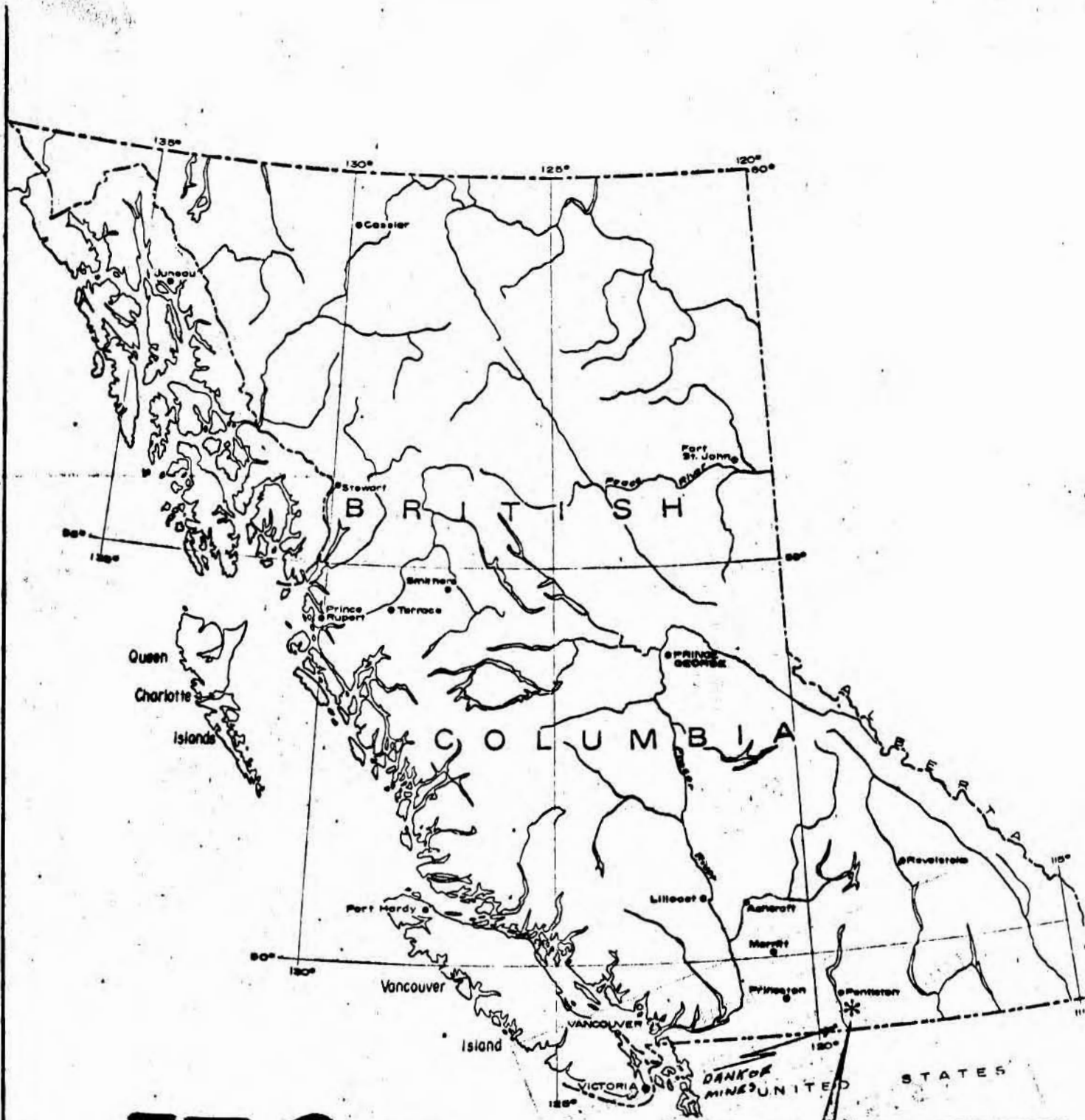

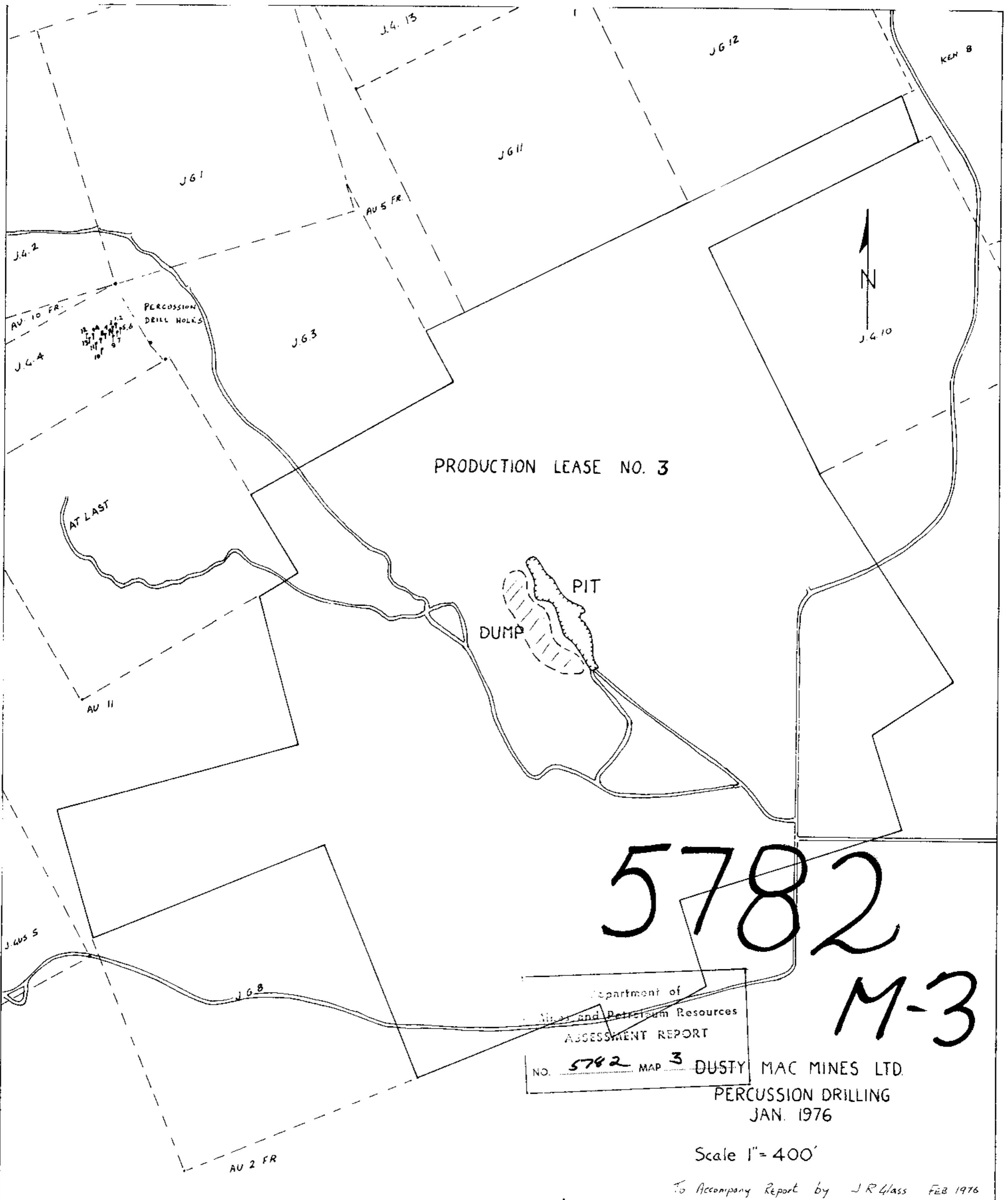
