## DRILLING REPORT - JADE 1 - 6 CLAIMS

**INTRODUCTION:** During the 1975 exploration season at Provencher Lake, B.C. several areas of in-situ jade were drilled concurrently with the placer boulders. As the in-situ material has similar drill-parameters as the boulders, costs for all drilling were totalled to provide a reasonable estimate of average drilling costs.

**LOCATION AND ACCESS:** Provencher lake is located in the south central part of Cry Lake mapsheet (104-I), 52 miles east-south-east of Dease Lake, B.C., and 125 miles due south of Watson Lake Y.T. The lake lies at 4400 feet altitude in the pass between Letain Creek and Kehlechoa River.

Easiest means of access to the camp is by float plane from Watson Lake, Y.T. or Dease Lake, B.C. A rough winter road exists from Dease Lake to the property. Figure 1 shows the general area and figures 2 and 3 the claim group.

The "Jade" 1 - 6 claims are centered on the camp area. Two separate areas drill tested were BBS area 500 feet east of camp and M area 1500 feet west.

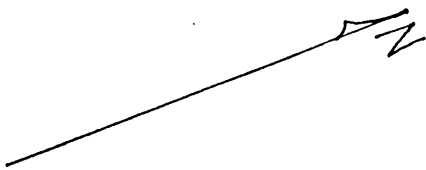
**EXPLORATION WORK - 1975:** During the 1975 season, at the "M" area two short holes totalling 50" (4.2 ft.) were drilled at inclination -45, azimuth 225 into a jade band trending across the creek valley. Both holes intersected poor quality jade.

At the "BBS" area near camp, hole BBS-1 was drilled 83" (6.9') at inclination -30, azimuth 090 into a talcy jade band between serpentine and sheared metamorphic rocks. Hole BBS-2, several feet to the north, at the same orientation, intersected 12" (1') of poor jade. Total footage drilled in the two areas was 145" (12') at an average cost of \$78.33 per foot. All costs of wages, drill supplies, food, aircraft support, supervision, etc. are included in the calculation, and all supporting cost data for the entire project are illustrated on the following pages to substantiate the high cost of drilling jade.

NOTE: All material drilled was poor talcy jade; thus no drill logs are submitted.

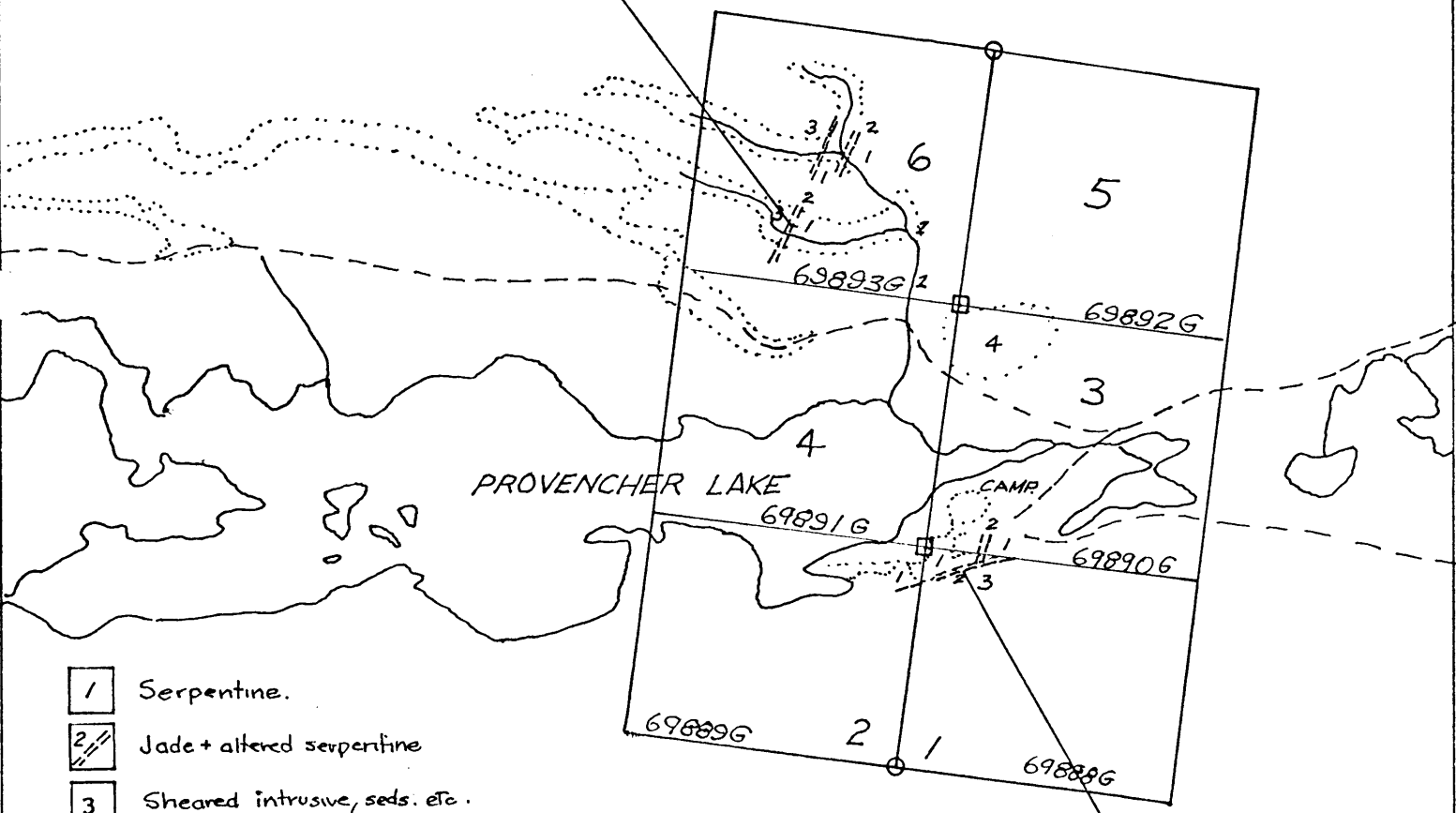
