The property lies at a low elevation of fapp. 1130 feet above sea level near Shuswap Lake. Although near the base of the hill the sulphides exposed have for the most part been in an area of a subdivision where future work will have to await the approval of the Department of Fisheries in Victoria B.C. and in Ottowa, Ontario. Sulphides exposed appear to trend in a north-northwesterly direction and appear to be bedded, and heavy to iron sulphides. For the present the property is being held as a mineral property for the gravel. It is anticipated that very little if any future exposing of the sulphides so near the worlds richest spawning salmon beds will be allowed the departments concerned. However, this will have to await decisions by the departments concerned.


