Description of Observations and Samples Taken while Prospecting
"Royal Ruger Group"

With the exception of the Sorcerer Creek and Downie Creek canyon walls, overburden covers the heavily treed "Royal Ruger" group. The "Royal Ruger Group" is situated on the valley floor. The center of Ruger #1 claim is approx. where Sorcerer Creek flows into Downie Creek.

In June, 1976, Robert Westerberg and Al Hurlbert built a heliport at this location so as to facilitate access to the "Royal Ruger Group" for assessment work purposes.

The exposed rock along the canyon walls is primarily quartzite.

Mineralized zones were found in several locations along the canyon walls.

Mineralized zones are basically iron sulphide or magnetite associated with minor copper, chromium and tungsten.

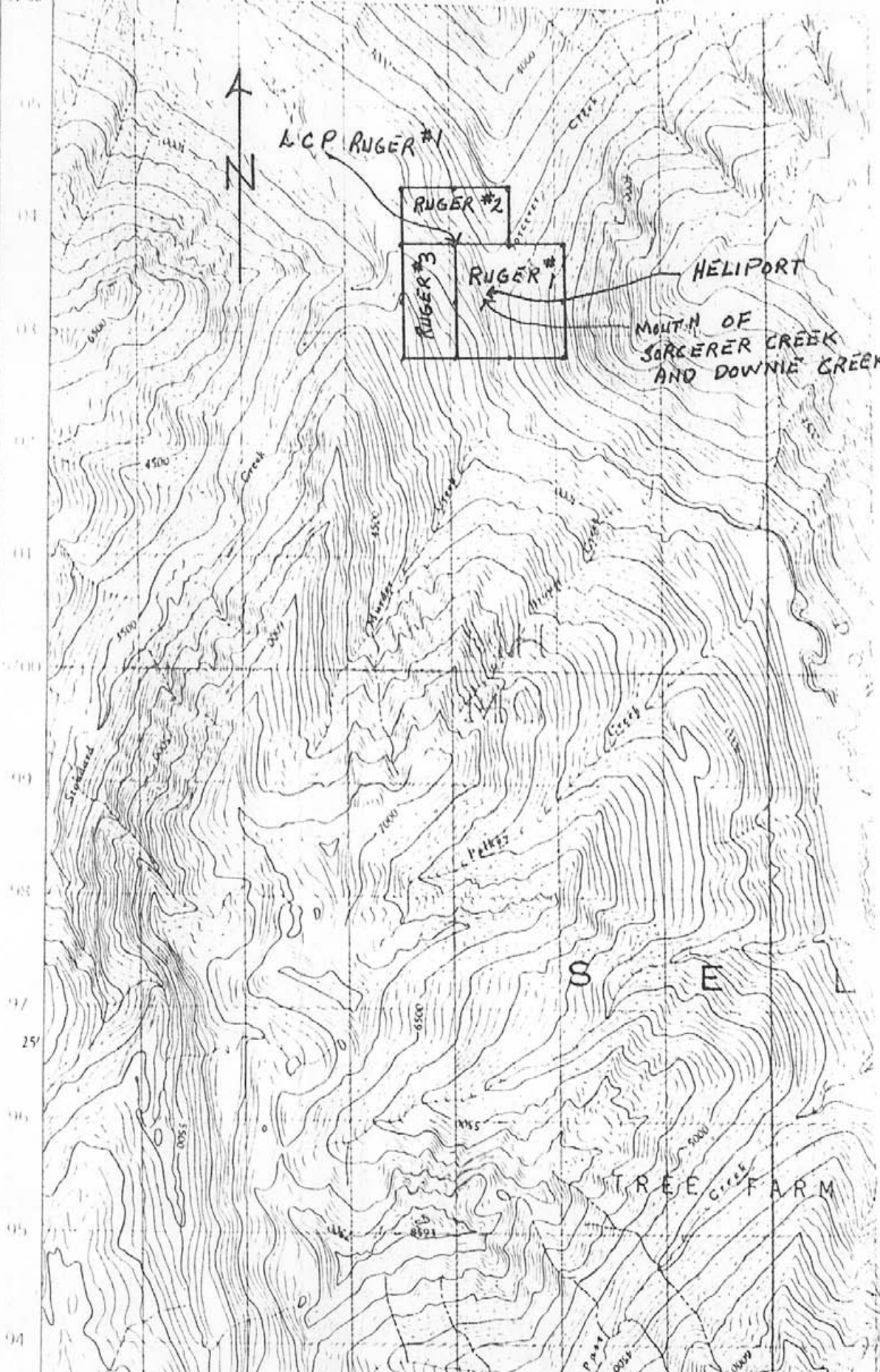
Four samples were taken and assayed at locations indicated on Sketch #1. Results of these assays are enclosed.

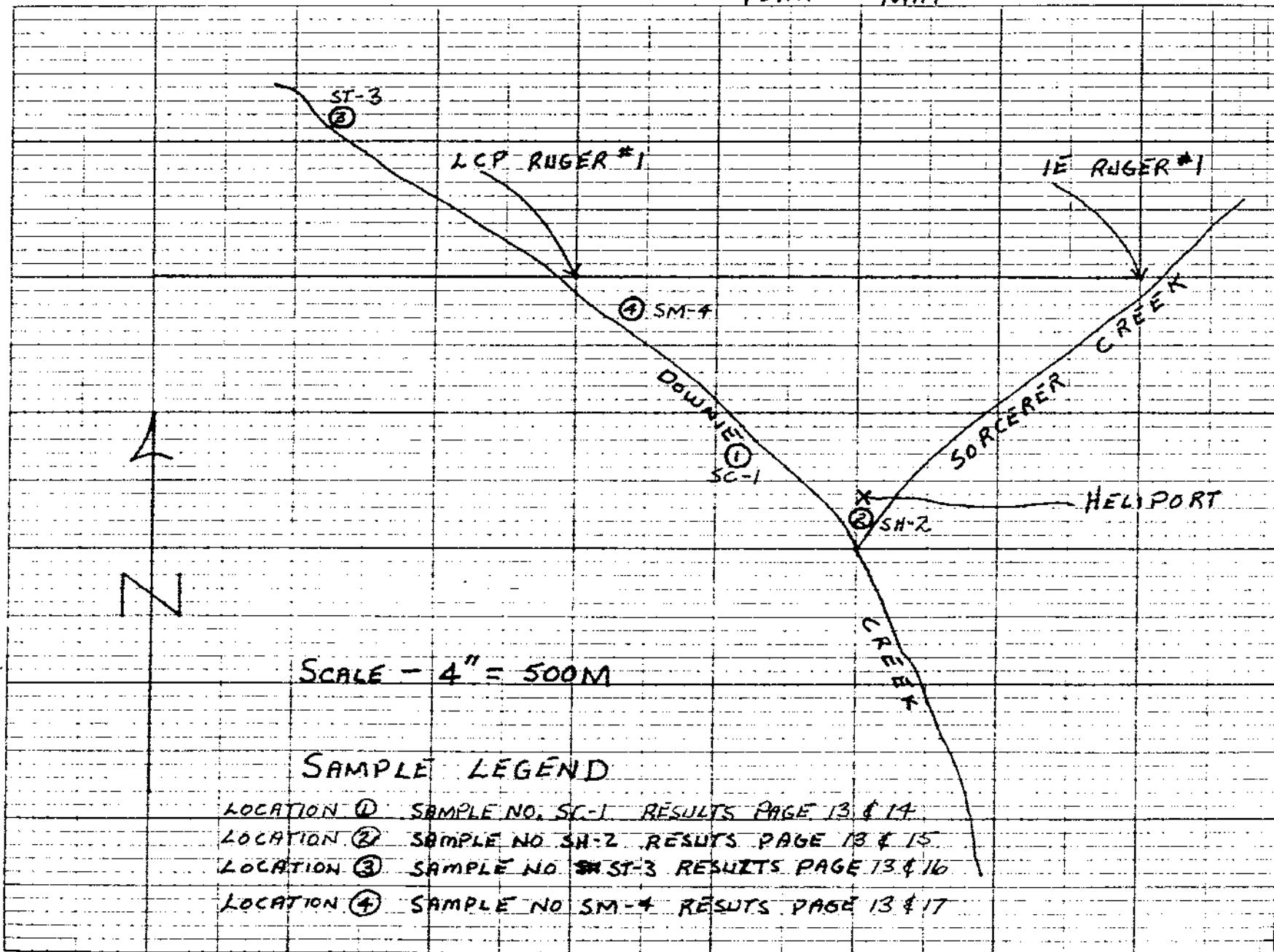


