INTRODUCTION

The claim is located in the Canim Lake area in central B.C. The claim is owned by Cominco Ltd. and the property is known to Cominco as the KIM property.

During the period 13 June to 22 July, 1977, a program of percussion drilling involving a total of 2630 feet (801.81m) in ten holes was carried on MTK #1 mineral claim. Prior to the drilling access right-of-way was slashed out and a TD15 bulldozer was then engaged to build the access roads and drill sites. Minor slashing only was required in certain areas upon the completion of the roads and drill sites. All drill sites were reseeded with the prescribed seed mixture upon the completion of the project. The reclamation work was inspected and passed by the Deputy Forest Ranger from the 100 Mile House office on 20 July 1977.

This report includes a summary of percussion data including hole designation, coordinates, elevations, depth of overburden and length of hole. Coordinates and elevations are given in feet to be consistent with the field designation involving an old grid in feet and topographic base also in feet.

Each percussion hole has been marked by placing a wooden pole bearing the hole designation in each collar.
