
INTRODUCTION

The DAGO Claim consisting of 9 units are located in the Aspen Grove area mainly to the east of Kidd Lake (see page 2 index map) at 19°55.5' N. Lat by 120°38' W. Long. The Claims were held by White River Mines in 1972 whom conducted a Diamond Drill program consisting of 6,318 feet.

The current owner-operator of the property is Tri-Power Minerals Corporation (NPL) with their head office at 1205 Sunvalley Crescent, Cache Creek, B.C.

The property is underlain by Upper Triassic rocks of the Nicola Group, consisting of a varied assemblage of volcanics, and includes lenses and beds of argillites, tuffs and limestones. Copper mineralization is widespread, mainly associated with shear zones in the volcanics, but also occurring as lenses and disseminations in the sedimentary and tuffacaeous formations. There are also gold and silver values.

Two holes were drilled 2" in diameter for a total depth of 90 metres. The holes FD-1 and FD-2 were drilled on the Dago Claim.






