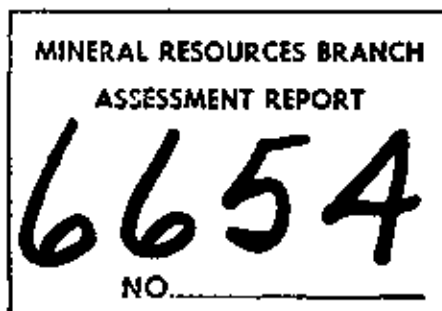

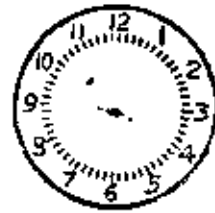

(as per attached fly-leaf copy)

In April 1978, a geochemical report by A. J. Davidson and R. D. Westervelt was filed for assessment credit on behalf of Union Carbide Canada Limited on the Atlanta and Consolidated Alabama Crown Grants near Ymir, B.C.

As outlined on Page 1 of this report, we had anticipated that these two Crown Grants covered the old Arrow Tungsten (Stewart) prospect previously reported in the literature. Subsequent field work within the past week, has confirmed that the Arrow Tungsten workings are actually located some 1500 metres southwest of the two Crown Grants.

To avoid any future confusion by people working through the assessment reports, I would suggest that a copy of this letter be attached to the subject assessment report so it is clearly indicated that these two Crown Grants do not cover the original Arrow prospect workings.

An update on the actual location and references on the Arrow Tungsten has just been forwarded to your Mr. G. L. James for correction on the Mineral Inventory maps and reference list.

I. INTRODUCTION

Summary and Work Done:

Two reverted crown grants, the Atlanta (Lot 2280) and Consolidated Alabama (Lot 2279) hereafter referred to as the Arrow group were acquired by application in April 1977 by Union Carbide Canada Limited. The property was originally known as Arrow Tungsten Mines Limited and has been known since 1942. The property was extensively trenched and a 60m drift and a 30m raise were put in in the 1950's. A more complete history may be found in Little H. W., 1959, "Tungsten Deposits of Canada", G.S.C. Econ. Geol. Series No. 17 pp 115, 116.

On the Arrow group of two claims, 3.2km of chained and flagged grid with a N-S base line was laid out and 102 soil samples were taken and sent to be analyzed for W, Mo, Cu and Zn.

This work was done between May 20, 1977 and May 28, 1977. Total assessment work claimed is \$1,797.86 and the costs will be allocated as in Table I.

The work was paid for wholly by Union Carbide Canada Limited.

The program was carried out under the direction of A. J. Davidson and was consulted by R. D. Westervelt, P. Eng.

Location and Access:

The Arrow group of two reverted crown grants (Atlanta Lot No. 2280 and Consolidated Alabama Lot No. 2279) 450(4) and 451(4) are located in the Ymir area, Nelson Mining District (Fig. 1). The claims are on the south side of Stewart Creek about 5 km from the Nelson-Salmo highway just north of Ymir. They can be reached by following a road from Porto Rico on the north side of Stewart Creek to a point north of the claims, then across the creek, up and cross-country to some of the old workings.

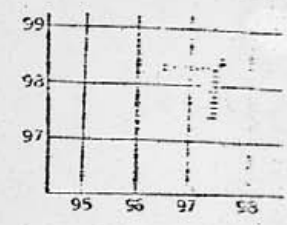

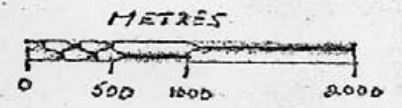

LOCATION OF GEOCHEMICAL GRID WITH RESPECT TO CLAIMS

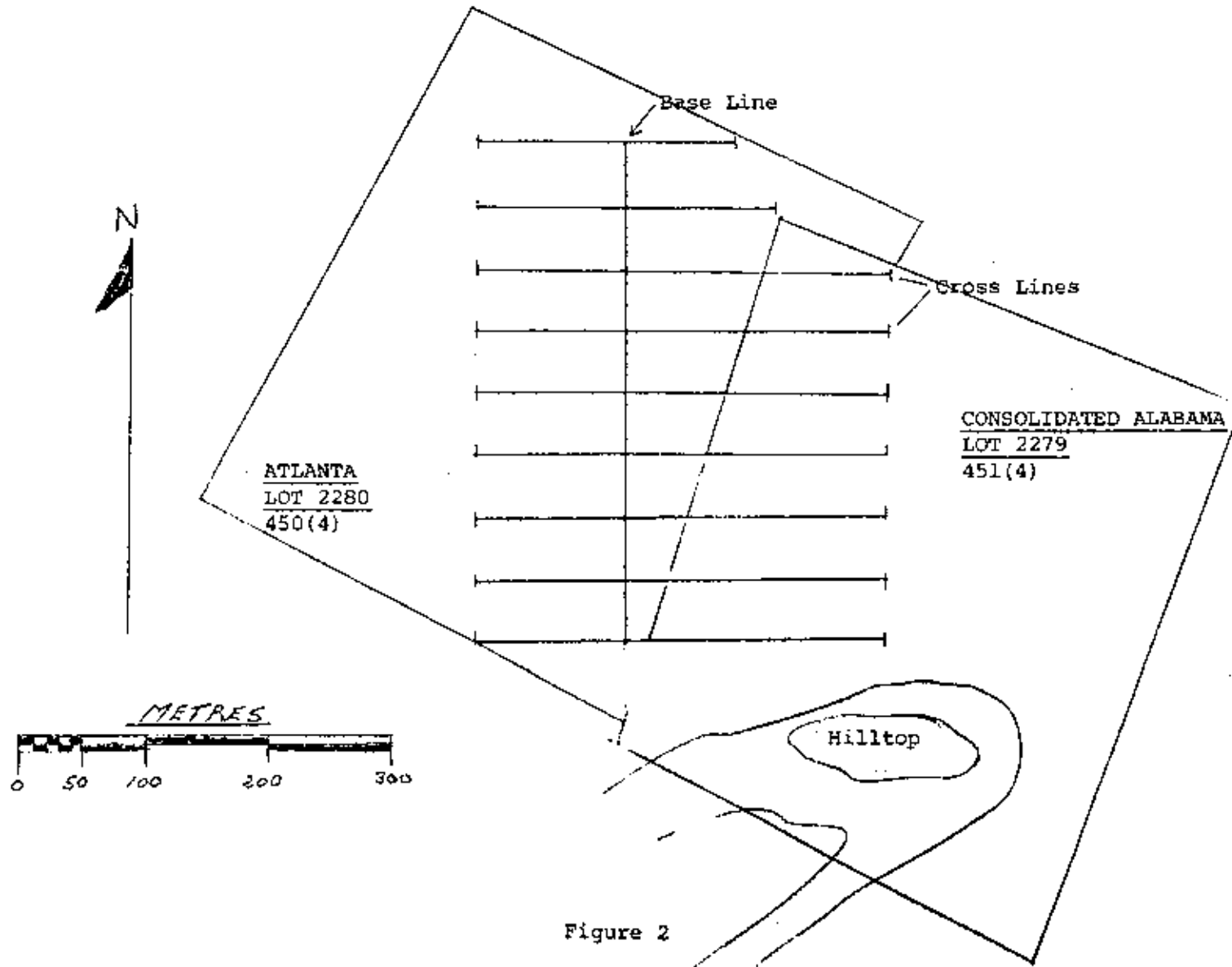

## II. PREPARATORY SURVEY:

A 3.2 km flag and chain grid was laid out on the Arrow property between May 20th & May 28th. The positioning of the grid with respect to the claims was determined by compass, elevation and topography. The base line (at 000°) measured 450 m with cross lines spaced every 50 m. Seven of the cross lines were 330 m long while two were 240 m and 210 m respectively. Extremely dense bush made extension of these last two lines impossible.

## III. GEOCHEMICAL REPORT

A geochemical survey of 102 samples was carried out on the Arrow group between May 20th and May 28th, 1977. The samples were taken on the 3.2 km prepared grid. The author, M. Burson and S. Fraser (geologists) and E. Rehtlane (field assistant) laid out the grid and took the samples. Samples were taken from the top of the "B" horizon (approximately 20 cm below the surface) with a hand trowel and placed in Kraft Geochemical envelopes. Each sample weighed approximately 500 g. The samples were sent to Bondar Clegg Ltd., 1500 Pemberton Avenue., North Vancouver, to be analyzed for W, Mo, Cu, and Zn. Tungsten was extracted by the basic fusion method and analyzed by colorimetric methods. Molybdenum, copper, and zinc were extracted using "hot aqua regia" and were analyzed by atomic absorption. Figures 3 and 4 show the sample location and the geochemical results.



ARROW TUNGSTEN GEOCHEMICAL RESULTS

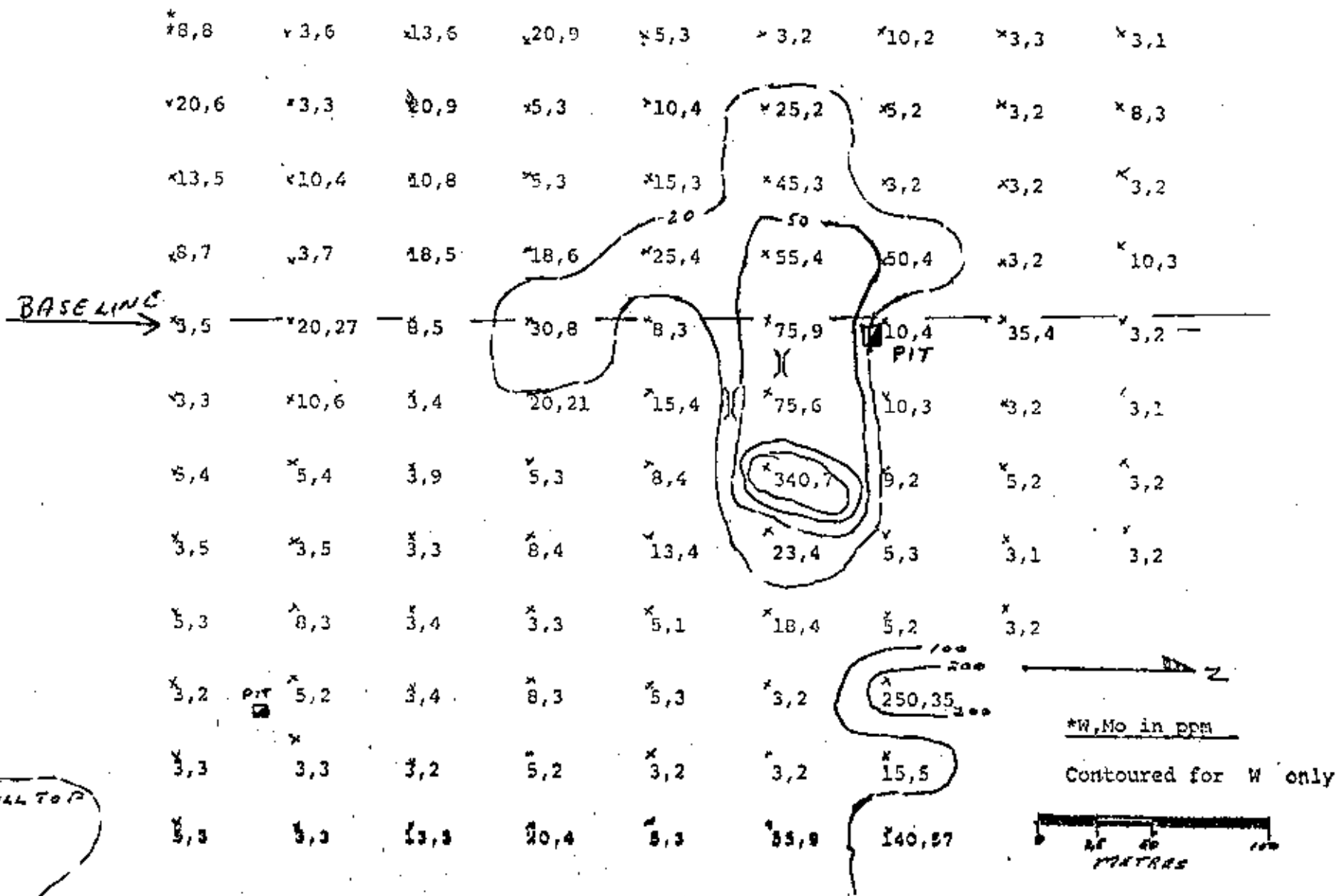

ARROW PROPERTY GEOCHEMICAL RESULTS "B"

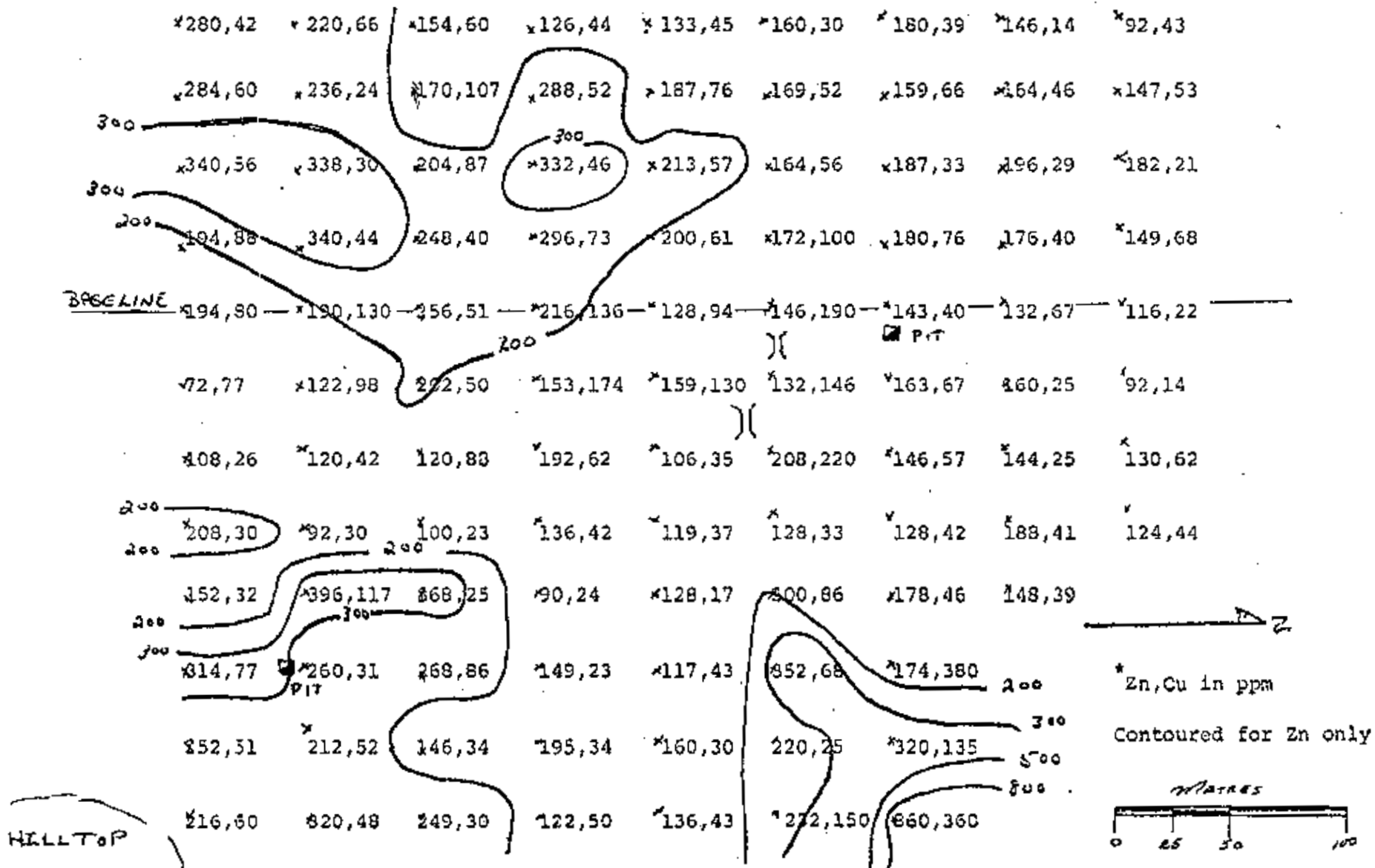


IV. CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The geochemical results (Figures 3 & 4) show that although the absolute values are low (high of 340 ppm W) significant relative anomalies do exist. The tungsten anomalies are generally coincident with at least Zn and sometimes with both Zn and Cu. One of the anomalies covers the central part of the grid where some old trenches were found and the other tungsten anomaly occurs in dense bush at the eastern end of the northerly two crosslines. It was these two crosslines that could not be extended further to the east due to extremely dense bush. The significance of these anomalous areas has yet to be determined. Any further follow-up on this property should include extending the grid to the northeast to further define the northeastern anomalous zone.





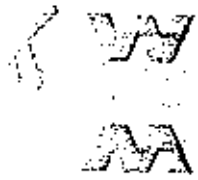
