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

INTRODUCTION

THE SPIRIT PROPERTY CONSISTS OF 20 (TWENTY) UNITS STAKED
IN 1976 OVER GROUND ORIGINALLY HELD BY MAVERICK MINES AND OILS LTD.,
JUNIPER MINES LTD. AND IAN G. SUTHERLAND. EAGLE RESOURCES LTD.
ACQUIRED THE PROPERTY IN 1977.

WORK BY PREVIOUS INTERESTS ESTABLISHED AN AREA OF WEAK
MOLYBDENUM MINERALIZATION IN AN ALTERED PORPHYRRY WITHIN AN INTRUSIVE
HOST ROCK.

THIS REPORT IS BASED ON INFORMATION GATHERED WHILE EXAMINING,
THE PROPERTY AND CORRESPONDENCE WITH THE OWNERS.

LOCATION AND ACCESS

THE SPIRIT GROUP IS 1.5 K.M. NORTH OF THE KETTLE VALLEY
RAILWAY (C.P.R.) STRADDLING CAMP CREEK WHICH FLOWS IN A SOUTHERLY
DIRECTION. THE PROPERTY CAN BE REACHED BY LOGGING ROAD FROM PEACHLAND OR PRINCETON. THE ROUTE FROM PEACHLAND IS APPROXIMATELY 20
(TWENTY) KILOMETRES BY TWO WHEEL DRIVE ROAD.

OWNERSHIP

THE CLAIM GROUP IS CURRENTLY OWNED BY EAGLE RESOURCES

LTD. (N.P.L.) THE MINERAL CLAIM CONSISTS OF 20 (TWENTY) UNITS

CALLED "SPIRIT", MINING DIVISION, ~ SIMPLICAMEEN.

TOPOGRAPHY

CAMP CREEK LIES AT AN ELEVATION OF 3600 FEET AT THE MAIN MINERALIZED ZONE. THE CREEK VALLEY SLOPES ARE STEEP FOR A SHORT DISTANCE BEFORE BECOMING GENTLER AT A HIGHER ELEVATION.

GLACIAL OVERBURDEN IS EXTENSIVE OVER THE WHOLE CLAIM GROUP FROM ONE HALF A METRE TO TEN METRES THICK.

THE WHOLE AREA IS ARID AND ONLY AVERAGES THIRTY CENTAMETRES OF RAIN DURING OFF MONTHS AND ONE METRE OF SNOW DURING THE WINTER.

OBSERVATIONS

THE PROPERTY HAS HAD CONSIDERABLE EXPLORATION WORK DONE ON IT BY PREVIOUS OWNERS. GEOCHEMICAL SAMPLING, MAGNETOMETER SURVEY, ELECTOMAGNETIC SURVEY, GEOLOGICAL INTERPRETATION, BULLDOZER TRENCHING AND PERCUSSION DRILLING WAS CARRIED OUT. DESPITE THIS LATTER WORK NO COMMERCIAL GRADE MINERALIZATION WAS FOUND.

THE PURPOSE OF THIS RECENT EXAMINATION WAS TO FIND COMMERCIAL GRADE MOLYBDENUM OR COPPER MINERALIZATION IN ORDER TO JUSTIFY A COMPREHENSIVE INDUCED POLARIZATION SURVEY AND SUBSEQUENT DIAMOND DRILLING.

THE AREA IN QUESTION WAS METHODICALLY PROSPECTED ON A PACED GRID TRAVERSE SYSTEM. THE TRAVERSE LINES CROSSED AT APPROXIMATELY 40 METRE INTERVALS IN ORDER THAT ANY SURFACE OUTCROP COULD NOT ESCAPE EXAMINATION.

MOST OUTCROPS VIEWED CONSISTED OF SLIGHTLY ALTERED QUARTZ MONZONITE.

THE QUARTZ-SERICITE-PYRITE ALTERED ZONE WITH MINOR MOLYBDENUM VALUES WAS TRACED 100 METRES FURTHER BY TWO OUTCROPS AND COARSE FLOAT.

NO INCREASE IN MINERALIZATION WAS NOTED.

OBSERVATIONS ...cont'd...

ALL DIRECT METHODS OF PROSPECTING AND GEOLOGICAL

EXAMINATION ON THIS PROPERTY HAVE BEEN EXHAUSTED. TO DATE NO
MORE MINERALIZED ZONES HAVE BEEN FOUND. DUE TO THE DEPTH AND

EXTENSIVE COVERING OF OVERBURDEN, AN INDUCED POLARIZATION SURVEY
IS RECOMMENDED BEFORE ANY DIRECT DRILLING OR TRENCHING IS ATTEMPTED.




