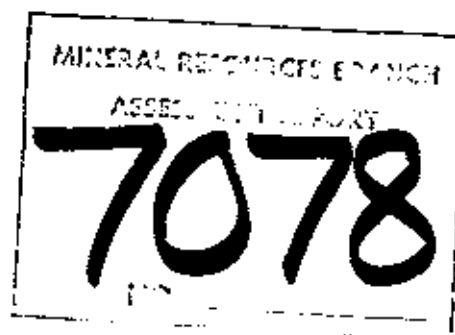




PROSPECTING REPORT ON THE GOLD VIKING GROUP (NEW
PHEONIX, GOLD VIKING AND VIKING FRACTION)

The properties of The New Pheonix, Gold Viking and Viking Fraction were reached by a branch road leading off the Forestry Road on the east side of Springer Creek. Roads into the property areas also require much work to have proper accessibility and this should be the first priority in any further exploration.

Prospecting the area to the east of Climax Creek was not rewarding because of the heavy growth of vegetation. In the area where overburden was lighter, new outcrops were noted. Here again past work has indicated a certain amount of mineralization. Some minor faulting was noted in the area and it is possible that Climax Creek may indicate a north south fault in which case extensive work using a bulldozer will be done in the areas of previous mineralization to try and uncover some new lodes.



GENERAL GEOLOGY OF THE GOLD VIKING GROUP

The general geology of the Gold Viking group is one of an admixture of sediments of the Slocan series related to the Nelson Batholith. Exposures on some of the roads and old workings that were examined show an admixture of argillites, limy argillites with a certain amount of metamorphism that has taken place in this area. In some areas especially on the Phoenix mineral claim metamorphism and alteration was noted to be quite widespread.

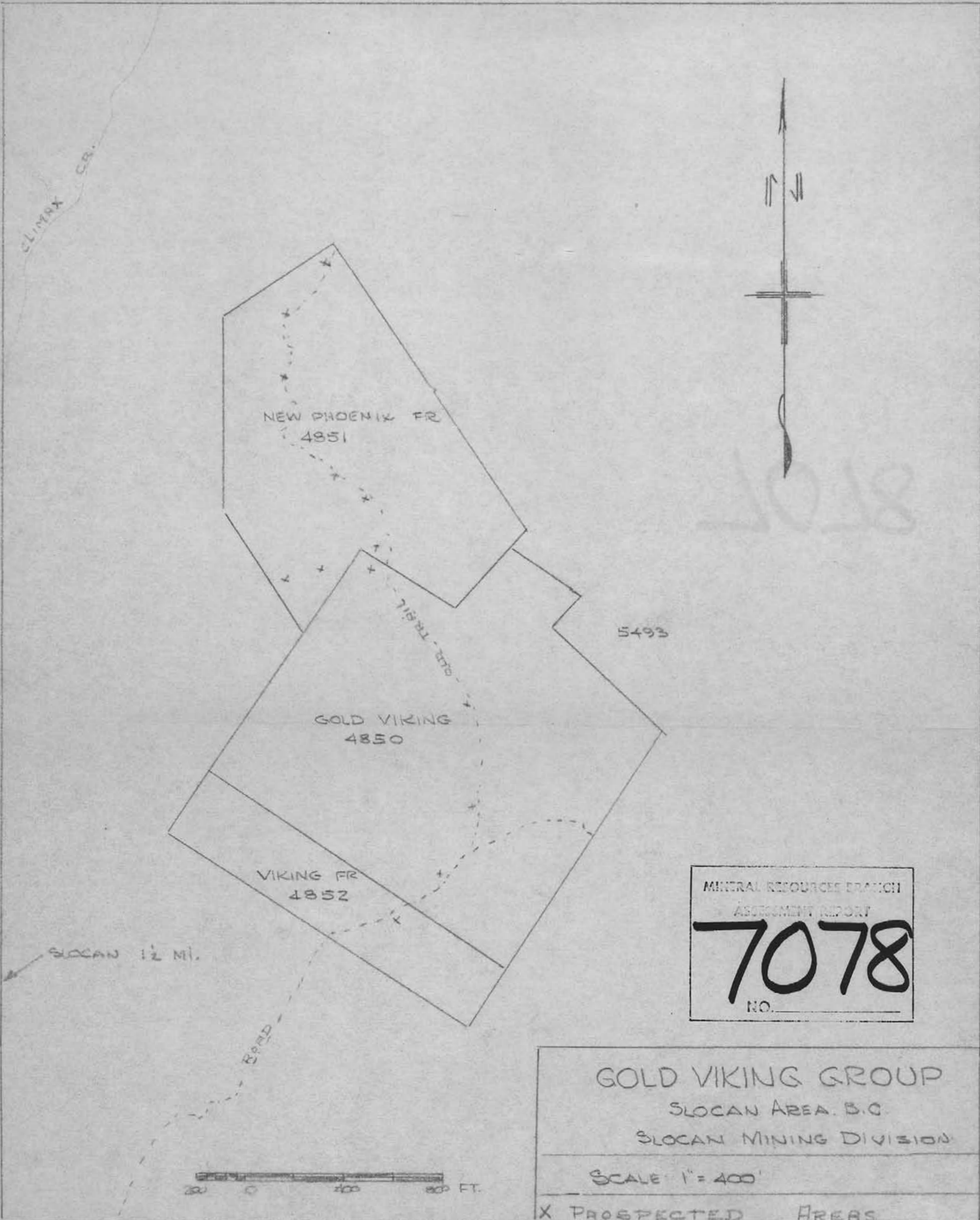
