This Property was investigated for its Mineral potential on June 3rd and 4th, 1978. Small amounts of Molybdenite were found as the only Mineral of economic importance. Area of outcrop is limited to the bed of a small creek.

The claims cover the southern part of a small Sugar Plum Granodiorite intruding the Horsethief Creek Group.

Extensive fracturing with abundant Pyrite, Muscovite, Sericite Alteration Development is present, plus rare Quartz veining. The Quartz veins are very far apart and the small amount of Molybdenite that was discovered is found in them.

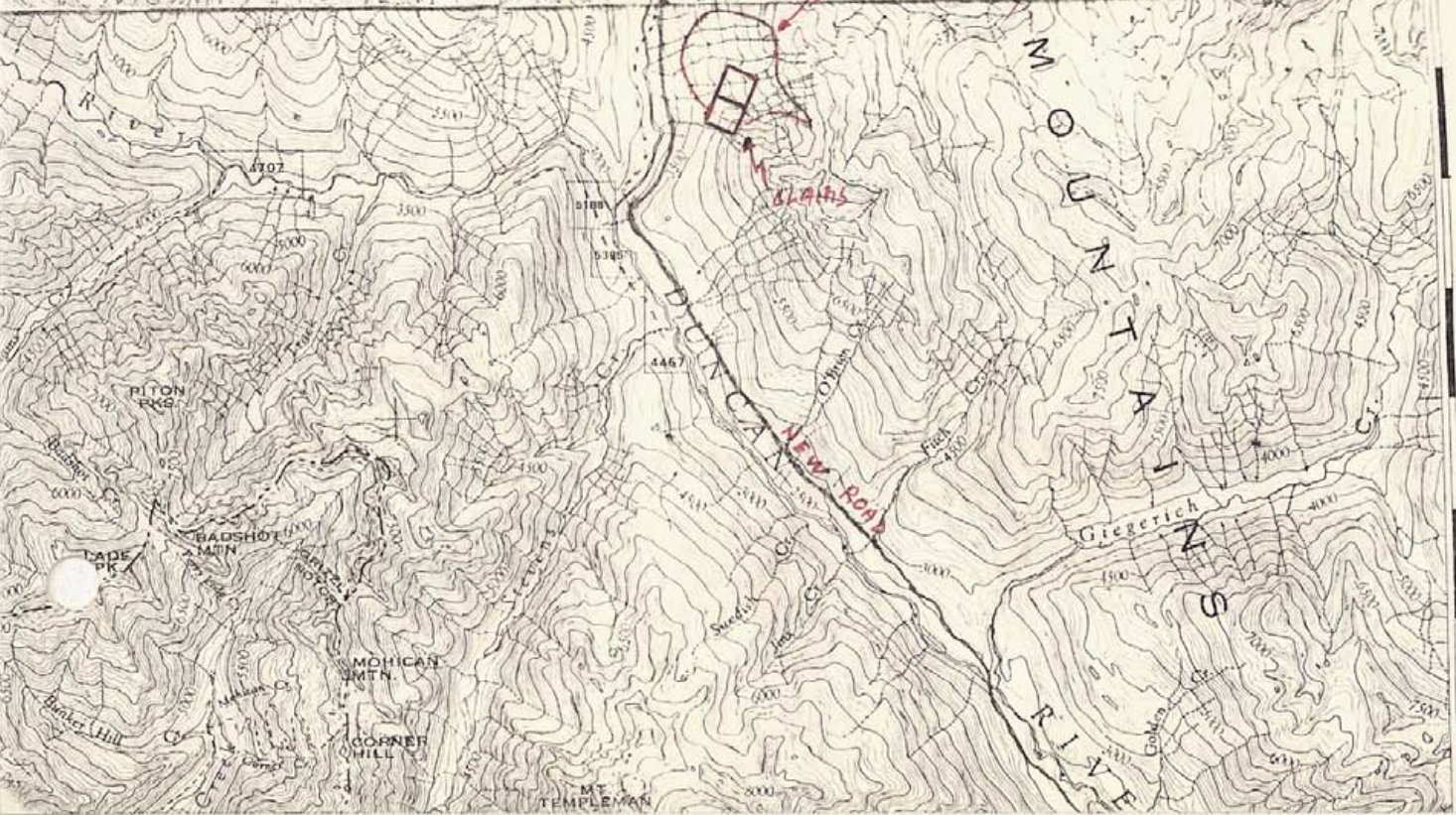
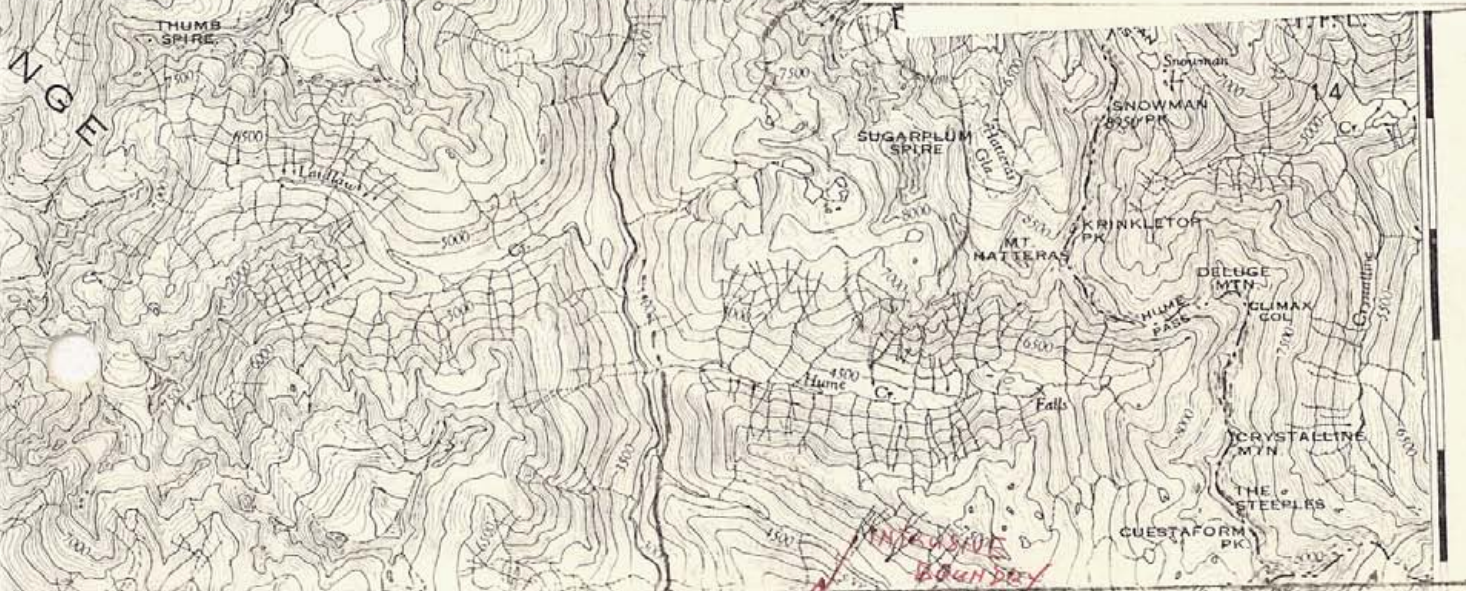
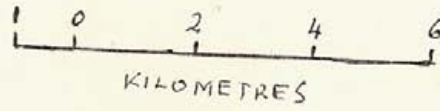
