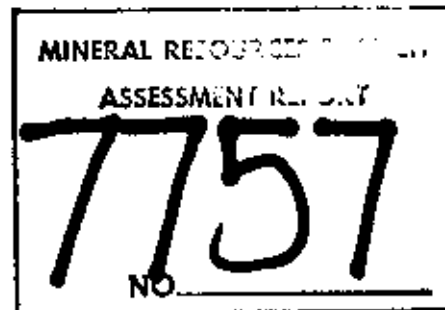

LOCATION AND ACCESS

The Foggy Group is located on Foghorn Mountain, about 15 km SE of Clearwater, and can be reached via a rough 4WD road from Birch Island.

CLAIMS

The property consists of 2 claims, Foggy 2 and 3, record numbers 1678, 1679, totalling 40 units, in the Kamloops M.D. and held by Craigmont Mines Limited.

HISTORY AND PREVIOUS WORK

The property has been known since the early part of the century when George Fennell mined small quantities of silver-lead ore on Foghorn Mountain. (BCDM 1913, -15, -16, -17, -24). Rexspar Uranium built a road into the property in 1958 and carried out various surveys and trenching (BCDM 1958). Additional trenching and drilling was subsequently done by J.A. Fennell, M. Fennell, Barriere Explorations Ltd. (BCDM 1970, -74, AR 4876). Airborne surveys by both Craigmont and Barriere Reef Explorations in 1979 located conductors west of the old workings, some of which coincide with a large gossan.

GEOLOGY

The claims straddle the contact between rhyolites, tuffites and associated fragmentals of the Eagle Bay formation and intermediate to basic volcanics, tuffites, limestones and shales of the overlying Fennell formation. The contact trends northwesterly and dips steeply to the southwest. A large gossan, some hundreds of metres in extent, occurs within Eagle Bay rocks, between the old workings and the contact, and overlies highly altered and pyritized rhyolite(?).

DRILL PROGRAM

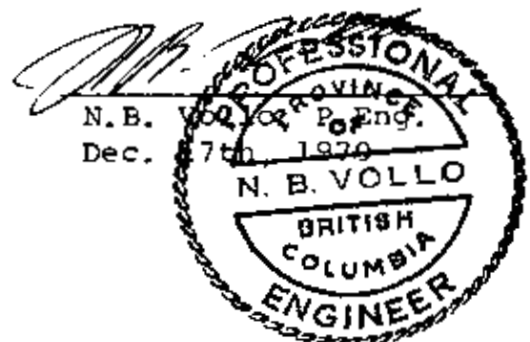
361 m of AQ diamond drilling was completed in 4 holes, all of which intersected chloritized and pyritized rhyolite(?) with only minor amounts of galena and sphalerite.

CORE STORAGE

Core is stacked on site.

QUALIFICATIONS

The core was logged by the writer, who obtained a BA in Geology from the University of Saskatchewan in 1950, an MSc in Geology from McGill University in 1959 and who has practiced his profession for 30 years.
