

# DIAMOND DRILLING REPORT ON WALLED GROUP MINERAL CLAIMS MABEL LAKE AREA VERNON MINING DIVISION, B.C.

#### INTRODUCTION

A program of diamond drilling was initiated by Mr. Wallace Chaput of Lumby, B.C., during the period of June 1-11, 1979 to test the depth of dolomitic limestone in Walled group of mineral claims. These claims are located about 48 kilometres northeast of Lumby, and about 3 air kilometres east of Mabel Lake, in the Vernon Mining Division, B.C. The property is centred about  $50^{\circ}32'$  North Latitude and  $118^{\circ}37'56''$  West Longitude.

#### ACCESSIBILITY AND PROPERTY

The property is accessible by about 48 kilometres of all weather gravel Mabel Lake road from Lumby, B.C. This road can be travelled by four-wheel drive vehicle. The supply will be available from the town of Lumby.

The four units of Walled mineral claims were staked by Joe Gallagher of 9308 Meadow Road, Vernon, B.C., as an agent for Mr. Wallace Chaput, Lumby, B.C. on January 13, 1979 and recorded on January 24, 1979 at Vernon Mining Recording Office, Vernon, B.C.

Mr. Wallace Chaput of Lumby, B.C. located Walled #2-4 on June 2, 1979 and recorded at Vernon Mining Recording Office, Vernon, B.C. on June 15, 1979. The recording numbers and date of expiry is as follows:

#### GEOLOGY

The geology of the area is not studied in detail previously, but the study of geological map by A.G. Jones (Vernon Map Area, 1946-51) of Geological Survey of Canada, Memoir 296, and open file #637 Geological Survey of Canada, indicate that the area is underlain by the older formation of Shuswap terrain of Monashee Group of Precambrian age. The Shuswap Metamorphic Complex consist of granitoid gneiss, thin bands of quartzite, marble, dolomite recrystallized limestone, and amphibolite. The outcrops are not well exposed as most of the area is covered by glacial till, but the general strike of these formations is almost east and west with  $50^{\circ}$ - $70^{\circ}$  south dip.

The area under study is mainly underlain by recrystallized limestone, dolomite with garnets and marble.

#### DRILLING

The 40.84 metres of diamond drilling is completed by drilling three diamond drill holes at this property by Eagle Drilling Ltd., Box 759, Lumby, B.C. during the period of June 1-11, 1979. The purpose of this drilling was to test the depth and quality of dolomite. The location of these drill holes are located on accompanying claim map. The core is logged by G.C. Singhai; the way is stored in Chaput Nives case sted, Lumby, B.C.

#### CONCLUSION

The above drilling program indicates that this colour of dolomite and marble can be used as face stone and in construction industries, but the quality of it should be tested.




