



August 1979. Proceeded to claim area which is situated approximately 2 miles from Hedley towards Princeton (Henry Creek). Attempted to locate ground Lot 47S. No samples were taken as I did not encounter mineralization.

September 1979. Spent day in area prospecting on or towards Lot 47S. Did not take samples as I did not see any mineralization.

Access to the claim is by road on old railway grade south side of Similkameen River and now by road up west side of Henry Creek.

The exploration potential is for Gold.

Rock type, I believe, is Hedley Diorite and Sediments and tuffs (Memoir No. 2).

I completed the Prospecting course Dept. of Mines in early 1960's. Was on the Government Grub Stake 2 or 3 years. Also took the Dept. of Mines night prospecting course at a High School held in Victoria by Dr. F. Shepard of B.C. Dept of Mines.


