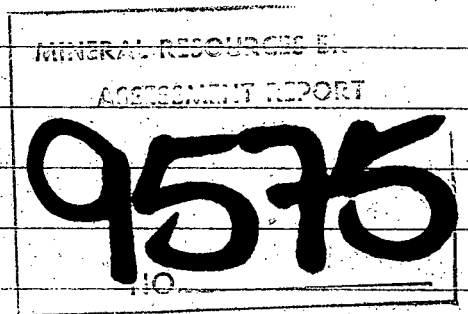

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PROSPECTING REPORT #1

August 13 to 26/1980.

Prospecting was mainly confined to locating by altimeter, the mineral occurrences reported in the B.C. MINISTER of MINES REPORTS for the years 1937/38/39.

As over 42 years have lapsed, since any exploration or development work has been carried out, and due to the fact that there are many dangerous slide areas caused by hanging glaciers and ice snow fields encountered in the claim area, extreme caution and full awareness must be maintained at all times.

Old trails to mineral occurrences have all but been obliterated by rock slides, many of the rock trenches have been caved in, but by altimeter and following up quartz float trains in the talus, 50% of the quartz veins were located. (see map P.#16). Visible Gold is not uncommon in the quartz veins.

PROSPECTING REPORT #2

July 26/27/28/1981

Mr. Carl Lalonde, Geologist & Exploration Mgr. for Prism Resources Ltd. and I chip sampled the vein in the cross cut of the adit, and upper glory hole, being the original discovery made in 1936.

We traversed the McCope claims, and parts of the accessible McDon goup, and helicopter surveyed the extremely inaccessible areas of the McDon Claims.

On his observations I reduced the McCope Claim to 6 units & McDon Claim to 6 units.

It is his recommendation that a thorough channel sampling of the adit vein, and the other quartz veins be undertaken to have a more comprehensive understanding of the true value of the property, at to-days
