

SUMMARY

An exploration programme consisting of cutting and flagging lines and collecting and analysing soil samples was done on the Porcupine Claim Group, one of several claim groups purchased in 1980 by Nithex Exploration Ltd. Some anomalous soil areas were found, and detail soil sampling and prospecting is planned.

INTRODUCTION

In 1980, Nithex Exploration Ltd., purchased several groups of claims which lie in a north-trending belt just east of Ymir, B.C. The Ymir-Nelson region has been one of the major gold producing areas of the province, and has produced 1,783,000 tons of ore with a content of 529,000 oz. of gold. The area has received little attention in the last 30 years, but, with the recent increase in the price of gold, the area has become of interest again. The Nithex ground was accumulated over the last several years by the vendors, and was purchased by Nithex because it is a reasonably large area of ground with geology favourable for the discovery of gold deposits.

LOCATION AND ACCESS

The Porcupine Claim Group is in the Nelson Mining Division at latitude $49^{\circ}15'N$, longitude $117^{\circ}11'W$ on NTS sheets 82F/3E and 82F/6E (Figure 1). It is on Porcupine Creek three km SE of Ymir, B.C. Access to the Property is by a dirt and gravel road which leaves Highway 6 at the confluence of the Salmo River and Porcupine Creek two km south of Ymir. The area is 6 km NE of Salmo, 30 km south of Nelson and 500 km east of Vancouver.

CLAIMS

The Porcupine Claim Group is located on Mineral Titles Reference Maps M 82F/3E and M 82F/6E. Pertinent claim data are listed in the table below.



The above information conforms with the records of the Claim Recorder in Nelson. The claims are shown on Figure 2, and are described in Appendix I.

HISTORY OF THE PORCUPINE GROUP

The first mineral claim in the group was located in 1896, and most of the claims were located and crown granted between then and 1902. Production has come from two claims, and totalled 54 tons to 1948. The Maple Leaf (Porcupine) produced 44 tons of lead-zinc-silver ore. The remainder was produced from the Nevada. After 1948, little exploration was done in this area.

Nithex Exploration Ltd. purchased the Porcupine Claim Group in 1980.



GEOLOGY OF THE PORCUPINE GROUP

The most recent and complete description of the geology of the area is by Little (1966). The rocks strike northerly and dip at moderate angles to the east. The main rock types are grey, fine-grained argillites and black phyllites. These rocks are intruded by granitic stocks and lamprophyre sills and dikes.

Mineralization on the Porcupine, Franklin, Champagne and Nevada claims consists of pyrite, galena and sphalerite, with silver and gold values, lying within Pend D'Oreille schists at or close to the contact with small bodies of Nelson Plutonic rocks. Traces of copper and tin have been reported. Mineralization has been described as being within silicified zones and shear zones.

EXPLORATION APPROACH

A base line 2.3 km long was cut from the Porcupine Creek Road on the Rule No.1 Claim northward to the north end of the Porcupine Claim. Cross lines totalling 16.25 km have been flagged 100 meters apart and picketed at 25 meter intervals.

A base map with a scale of 1:2500 was prepared from 1:2500 topographic maps that were made from available air photographs taken in 1980. On this base map the grid was plotted and adjusted to fit the roads and topography.

In total, 537 reconnaissance soil samples were collected on the Porcupine Claim Group, one at each picket. The samples were analysed by Acme Analytical Laboratories Ltd., of Vancouver, for lead, zinc, silver and gold (Appendix II). The lead, zinc, silver and gold values were plotted on 1:5000 maps, a separate map for each element, so the maps could be overlaid to compare the amounts of each element.

The object of the reconnaissance soil sampling was to test for lead-zinc-silver-gold mineralization on the claims. Silver background is high with most samples greater than 0.2 ppm Ag, and many samples with more than 2.0 ppm Ag. The gold background is 0.005 ppm Au, and the samples range up to 0.155 ppm Au. The background concentrations of lead and zinc were also very high, and, in general, the anomalies in these two metals coincided with anomalies in gold and silver.

The anomalous sample sites should be inspected on the ground, and detail sampling should be done where appropriate.

CONCLUSIONS

1. The geochemical reconnaissance programme outlined areas of interest on the Porcupine Claim Group.
2. Additional detail sampling should be done on the anomalous areas, and these areas should be prospected carefully and a geological map should be prepared.



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

Sample preparation

Soil samples are dried at 75°C and sieved to -80 mesh.

Rock samples are ground to -100 mesh.

Digestion

A .50 gram sample is digested with dilute aqua regia in boiling water bath and diluted to 10 mls with demineralized water.

Determination

All the above elements are determined by Atomic Absorption from the solution.
With background correction.

Geochemical Analysis of Au

Digestion and extraction

A 10 gram sample which has been ignited over night at 600°C is digested hot with dilute aqua regia, and the clear solution is extracted with Methyl Isobutyl Ketone.

Determination

Au is determined by AA from the MIBK extractant with background correction.

Geochemical Analysis of Ba

A .100 gram sample is digested hot with NaOH and EDTA solution. The solution is analysis for Ba by AA.

Geochemical Uranium Analysis

Digestion

A .50 gram sample is digested hot with nitric and perchloric acid and diluted to 10 mls.

Fusion

An aliquot is solvent extracted with salting agent and aliquot of is fused with NaF, K₂CO₃, & Na₂CO₃ flux in platinum dish.

Determination

The fluorescence of the pellet is read in the Turner fluorometer.
