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- INTRODUCTION -

The Summit, Amco No. 7, Amco No. 9, Amco No. 11, Amco No. 12, Amco No. 15, Amco No. 37 Fr., Amco No. 38 Fr., and Amco No. 39 Fr. Mineral Claims are located in the Nelson M.D., twelve kilometers south east of Salmo on the north west side of Mount Waldie, at approximately 5,500 feet elevation.

Access to the claim is gained by traveling east up Sheep Creek to Yellowstone Mountain, and then south up logging road. The claims lay on the West side of Billings Creek.

This gold property was recorded on the 20,21 and 22 day of September 1982. It consists of nine Reverted Crown-Granted Mineral claimes.

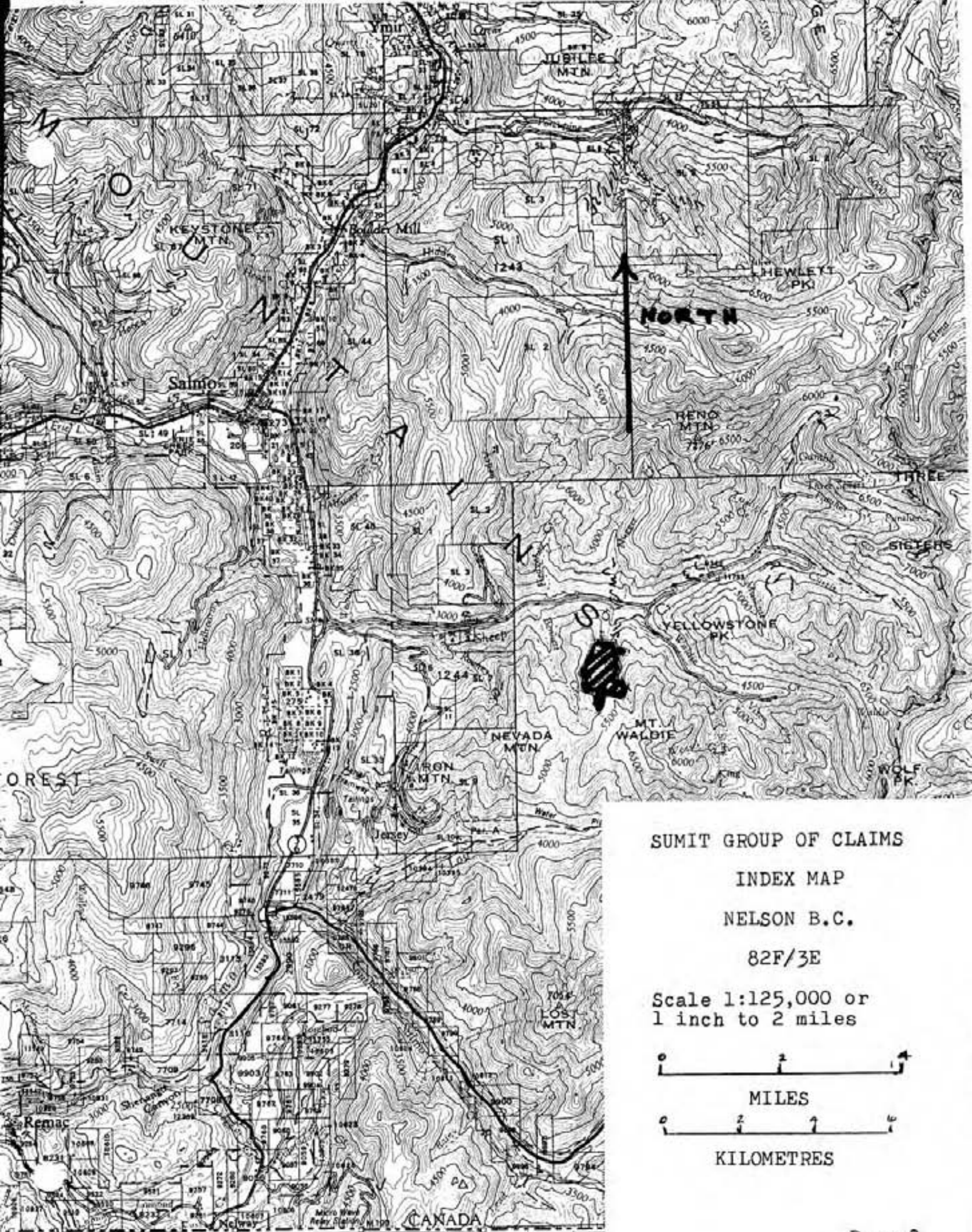
The current owner - operator of the above listed property is Richard H. Mayes, Box 856, Rossland, B. C.

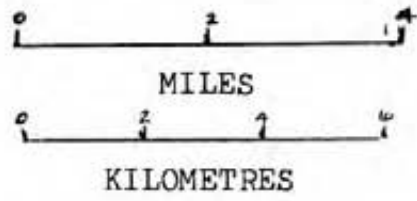
Prospecting-

-DETAILED TECHNICAL DATA AND INTERPRETATION-

The purpose of the investigation was to locate gold - bearing quartz veins on the north west arm of Waldie Mountain and then to attempt to determine the economic potential of those veins.

A number of quartz veins were found on the north west arm of Mount Waldie, varying in width from a few centimeters to a metre in width. Most of the veins were found to be barren or carry only a trace of gold.

The only east striking vein was found to run through the Sumit claim, which has been heavily mined.

PROSPECTING REPORT


The area prospected is made up of predominately schists and argillites of the Laib formation, with minor occurances of shale , limestone and quartzite and argillaceous quartzite.

Minor occurances of granodiorite was found approximately 500 meters north west of the Sumit glory hole. Although exposures are scarce, they occure in the vicinity of white quartzites and limestone contacts.

A number of narrow quartz veins were found just west and south west of the Sumit glory hole.

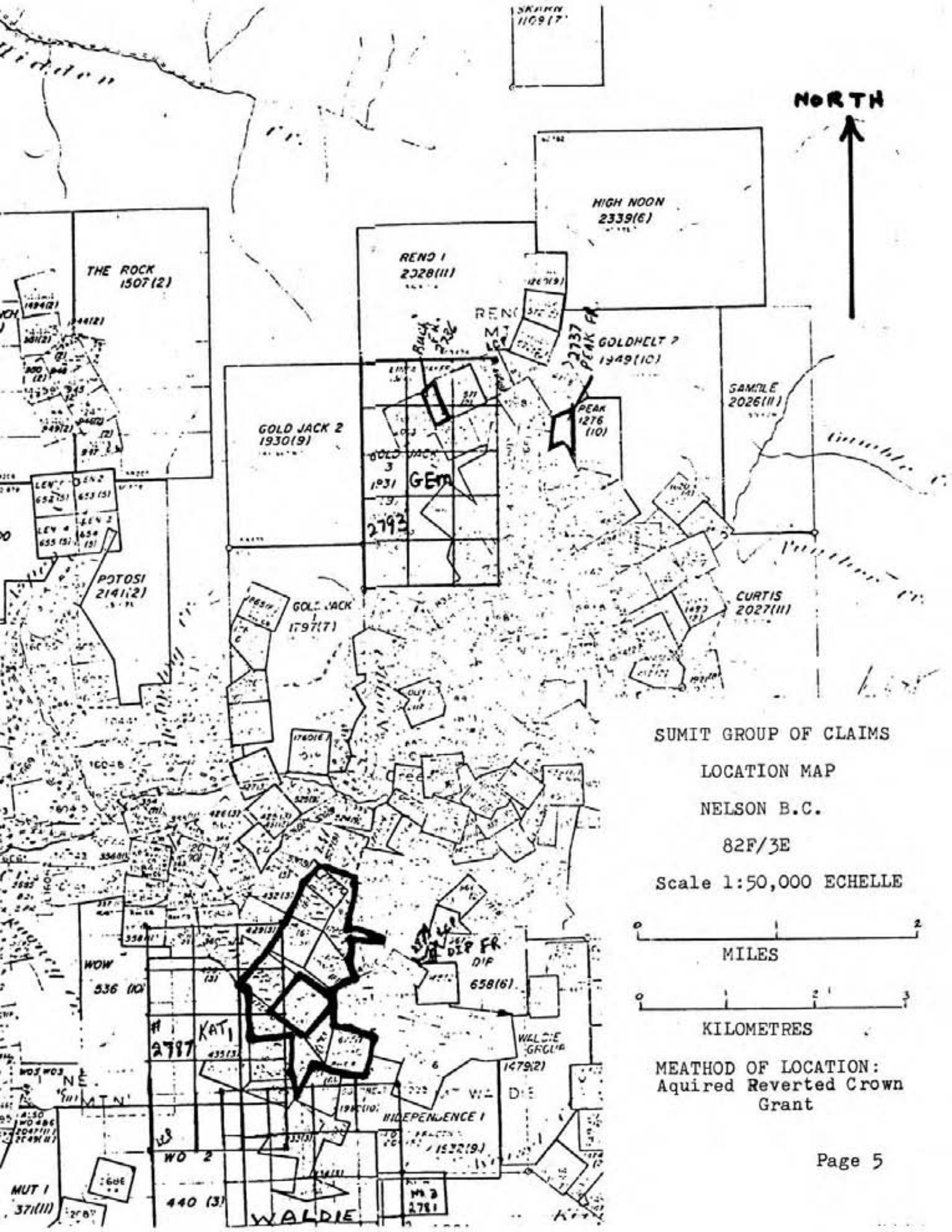
The area prospected is well exposed on the higher ground, however, the valleys are well timbered with few outcrops.

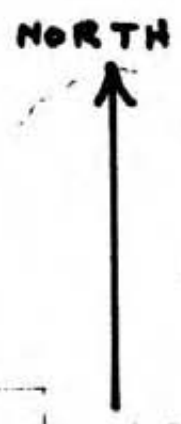

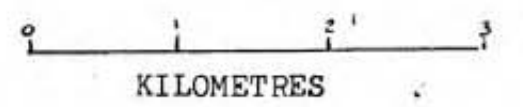
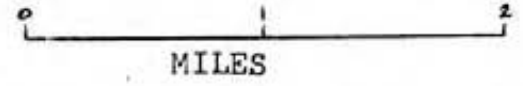
SUMIT GROUP OF CLAIMS

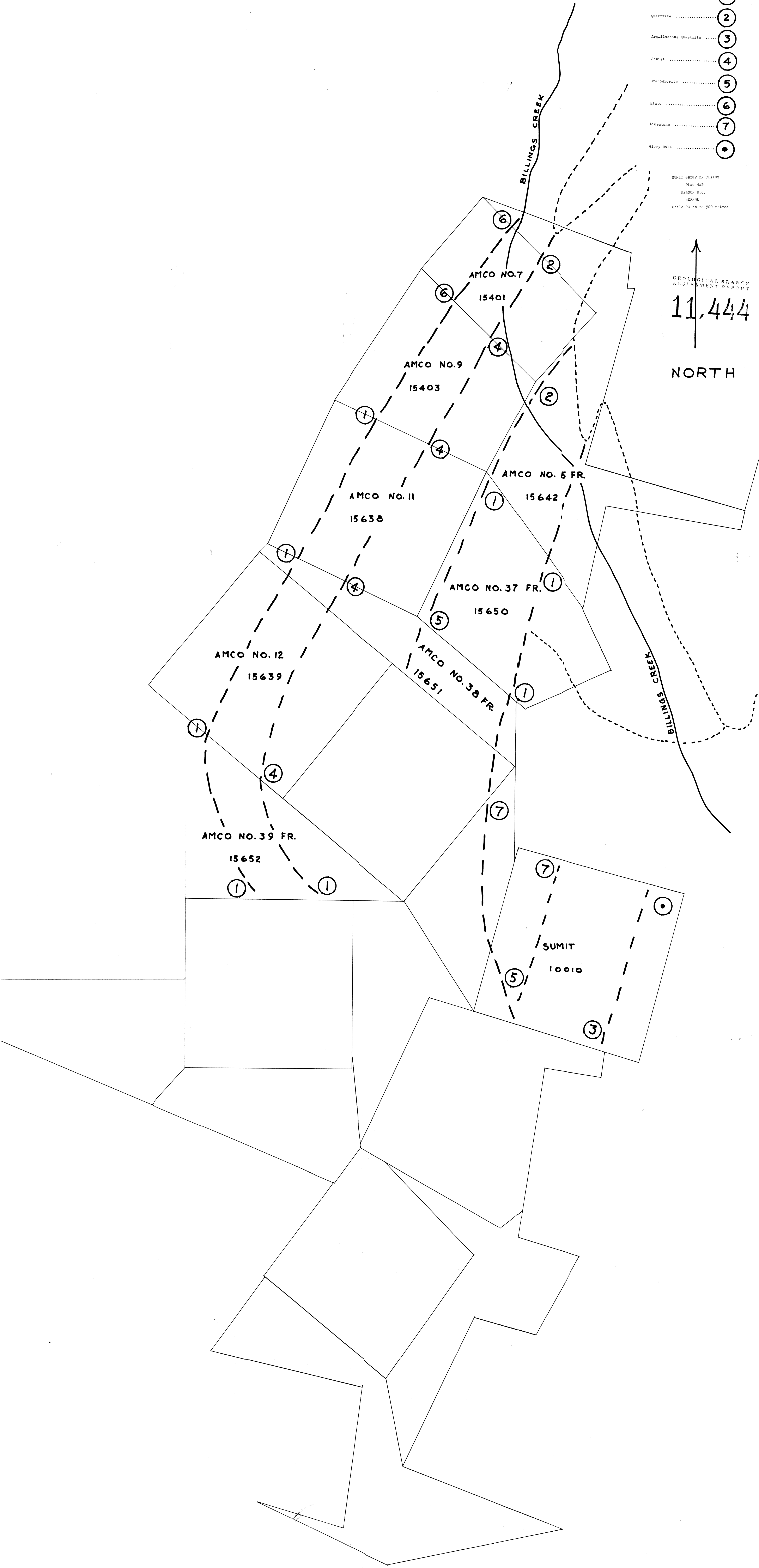
