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INTRODUCTION

The Golden Eagle claims (20 units/5E + 4S) are situated on the western watershed of Kwikwit Creek. This location is in NTS 82M3 in the Kamloops Mining Division. Recorded and expiry dates for the Golden Eagle claims are as follows:

Golden Eagle: Recorded Sept. 27, 1983
Expires Sept. 27, 1983

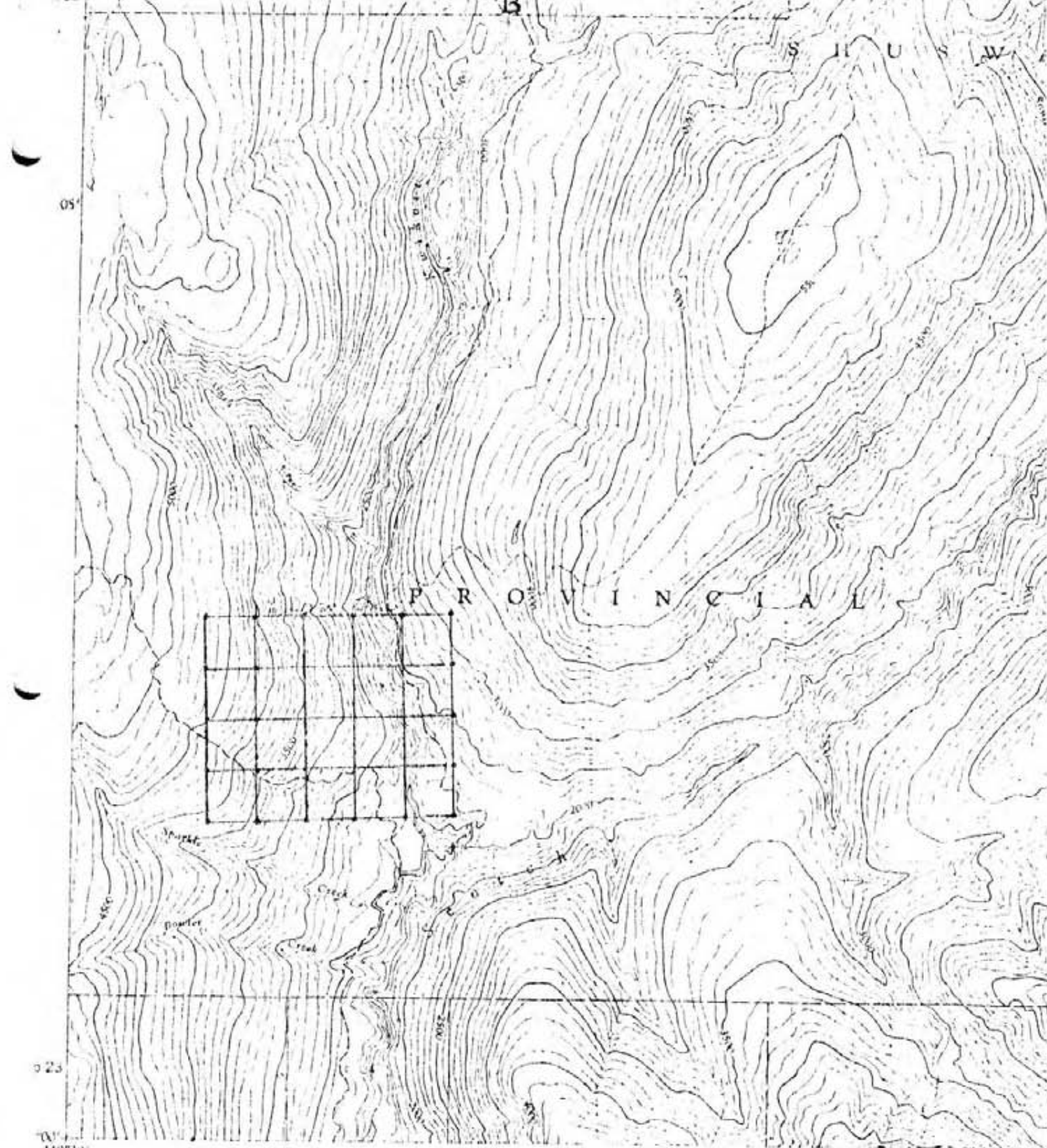
The registered owner is Larry D. Lutjen; R.R. #1, Box # 12, Site 11; Chase, B.C. VOE 1M0. There is no known history of exploration on the claims but the group of claims to the west; presently owned by Orell Resources Ltd., have produced high value of silver/lead/ zinc/gold ore

On the 25 - 30 of August 1983 the Golden Eagle claims were prospected by Larry D. Lutjen (Certified) and Richard D. Lodmell (Certified) in four quadrants as follows: (L.C.P., E2, E2S2, S2) - 2 days; (S2, E2S2, S4E2, S4) - 2 days; (E3, E5, E5S2, S2E3) - 1 day; and, (S2E3, E5S2, S4E5, S4E3) - 1 day. Prospecting commenced at the 1433 M level in the NW corner of the property. The area is heavily forested with spruce and Balsam Fir with considerable overburden. Small outcroppings of chlorite schist, quartzite, minor quartz mica schist, diorite, green rock, and basalt were found with mineralization as outlined in Figure 1.

CONCLUSIONS:

The Golden Eagle claims contain very little exposed rock due to excessive overburden, but several mineralized veins were discovered during the six-day prospecting program. Each of the veins were characteristic of the Adams plateau (i.e. limonite stained quartz, pyrite, calcopyrite, magnetite, calcite, and limonite). The strikes of the veins all run N to NE and are dipping to the West. In the future we plan to extend the exposure of the veins with cross-trenching and will determine at that time the feasibility of a geophysical survey to map the ore body.

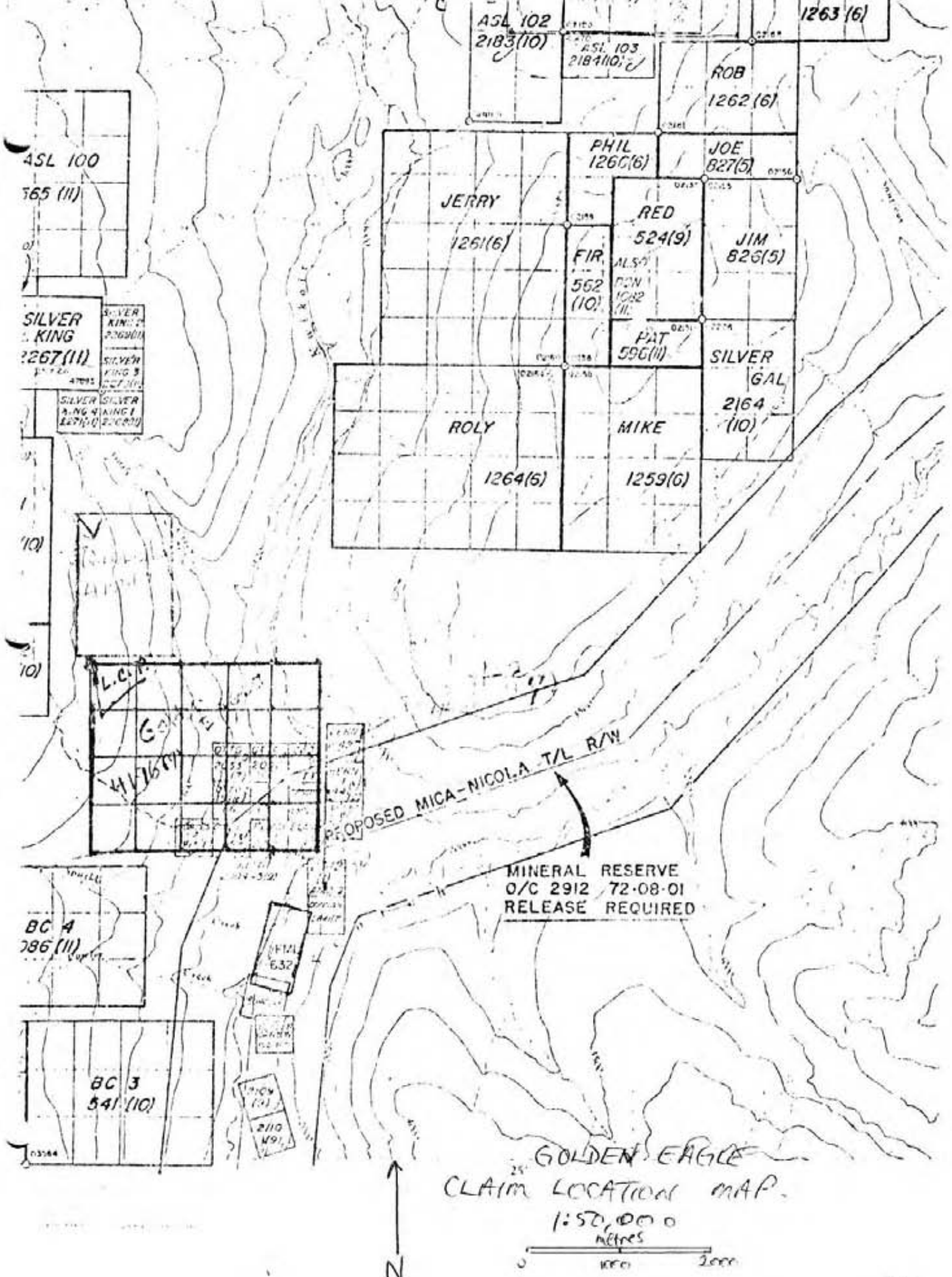




R 11 GOLDEN EAGLE CLAIMS

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
