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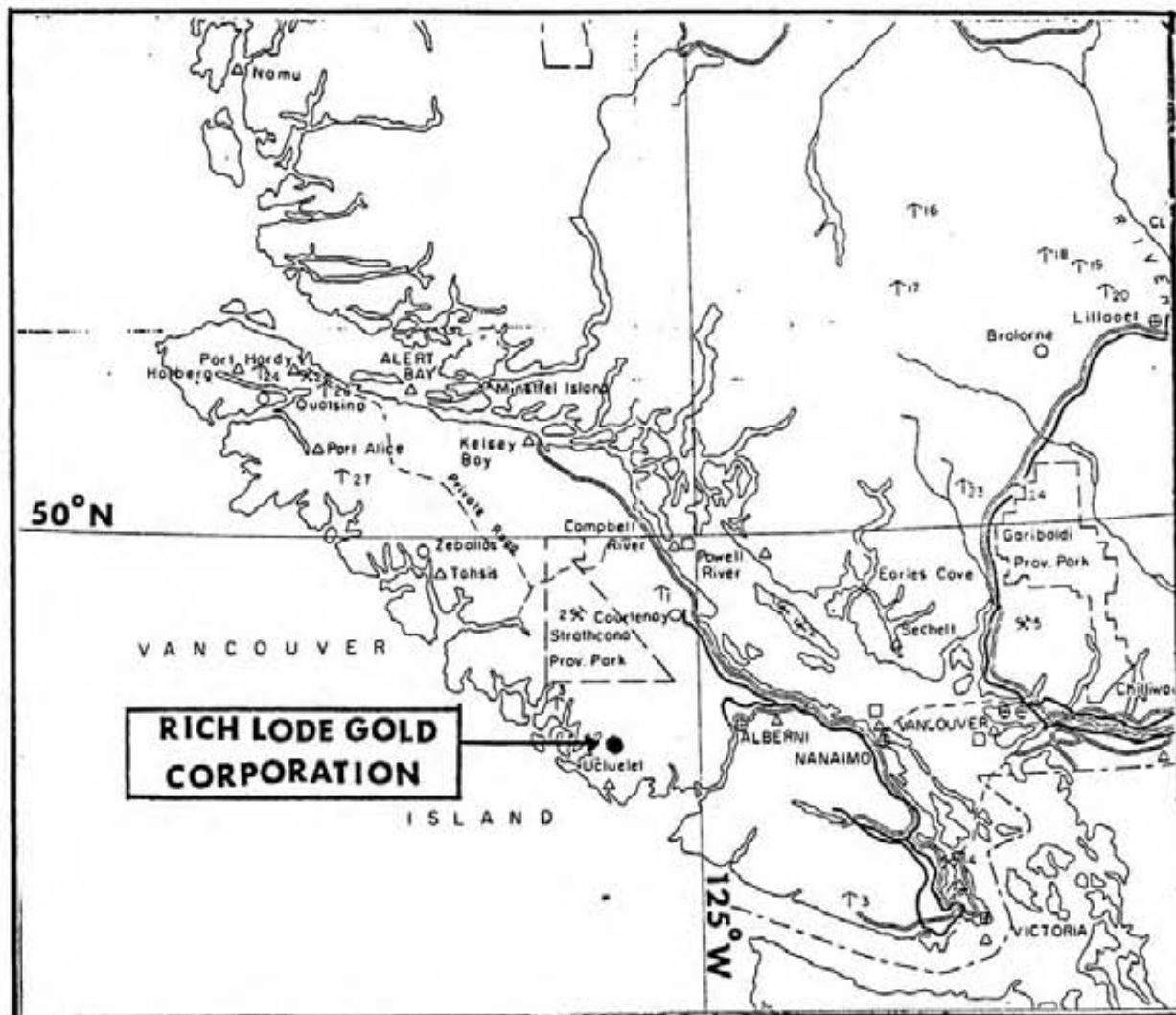

The property lies adjacent to and astride the Port Alberni Tofino highway and is 65 kilometres from Port Alberni via paved highway. Port Alberni is the supply centre for the area. It is a city of 25,000. Tofino is 54.96 km and Ucluelet 25.92 km from the property and both have facilities for housing men. Minor repairs would be available at these two locations. Figures 1 and 2 show the location of the property. The centre of the claim group is approximately 3,000 metres south of the junction of Canoe Creek and the Kennedy River. Access to various claim units would be by logging roads, some of which need clearing. Reference is made to Figures 1 and 2 appended to this Report for more detailed location.

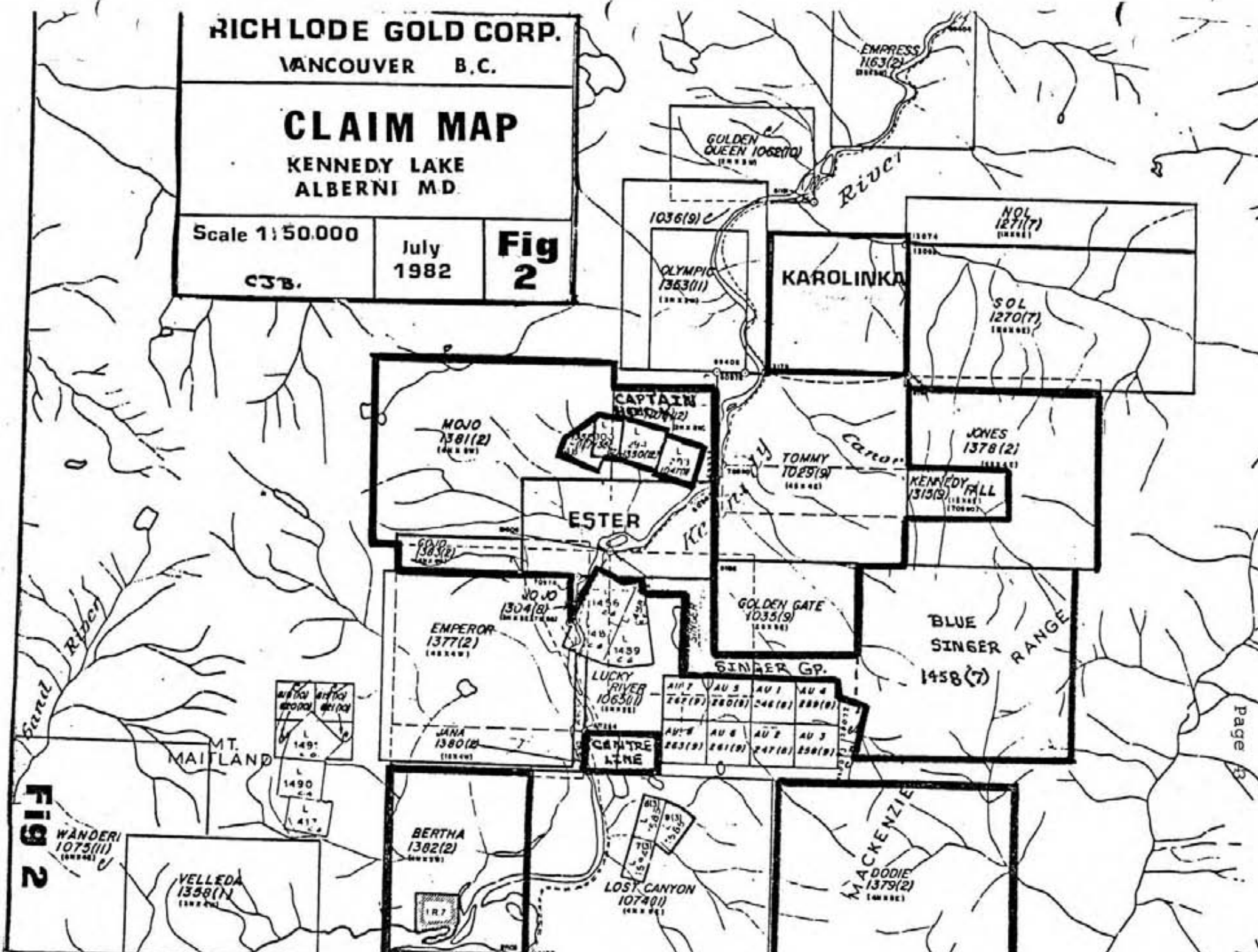

INTRODUCTION

PROPERTY

The claims are owned by Rich Lode Gold Corporation of 502 - 5850 Larch Street, Vancouver, B.C.

The Corporation owns sixteen mineral claims in the area comprising 156 units, of which each unit is 500 metres square. All claims were staked in 1982 for Rich Lode Gold Corporation.

These claims are astride the Port Alberni highway and are 65 kilometres by road from Port Alberni. The property is underlain by a series of basaltic and andesitic flows of Triassic Age which have been intruded by granitic rocks of Triassic-Jurassic age. Gold mineralization has been identified with a set of Northeast trending faults, fractures and sheeted zones. Spectacular values have been obtained over narrow widths. The gold is associated with quartz and minor sulphides. Prospecting in the area started before the turn of the century and, by 1899, a modest production was recorded from the area. Gold quartz stringers and veins are widespread in the area. This type of mineralization is common and well known in the Alberni area.

PHYSICAL FEATURES

The property lies on the western slopes of the Outer Mountain area of Vancouver Island, British Columbia. In general, the relief is rugged with differences in elevation on the property varying between 100 and 1200 metres. The property has been logged on the lower slopes. Second growth is thick and windfalls and stumps are plentiful making field traverses slow and sometimes difficult. The prevailing westerlies along with frontal passages cause abundant rainfall and the topography, a rapid runoff. There is ample timber and water on the property for any size mining operation.

REGIONAL GEOLOGY

Reference is made to E. Muller's publications of the Geological Survey of Canada, Paper 68-50 and Map O.F.463. It is from these two publications most of the regional geology was obtained. The rocks underlying a large part of the Kennedy River gold camp are basic volcanics belonging to the Karmutsen Formation of Triassic age. The Karmutsen is composed of basaltic pillow lava and massive flows. The lower members were apparently

deposited in a marine environment and, with continued deposition, the formation ended with the extrusion of subareal basalt flows. The grade of metamorphism is low except in the vicinity of granitic contacts. Overlying the Karmutsen are Upper Triassic sediments of the Quatsino Formation composed largely of limestones and calcareous sediments. The Quatsino has been largely eroded and is distributed in isolated patches resting on the basalts. The Island Intrusives of Jurassic age have intruded both the Karmutsen and Quatsino. They are composed of batholiths and stocks of granitoid rocks ranging from quartz diorite to granite. The West Coast Complex is genetically related to the Island intrusive. It is a complex composed of assemblages of hornblende gneiss, amphibolite and quartz diorite.

KENNEDY LAKE GOLD DEPOSITS

D. J. T. Carson, in 1969, classified the many and various mineral deposits within the Alberni area. The gold deposits covered by this Report have characteristics of his G8 classification and consist of quartz occupying faults or sheeted zones and fissure zones containing pyrite, sphalerite, galena, arsenopyrite, chalcopyrite

and native gold. Alteration is limited. High galena and sphalerite content appear related to high gold values (Bancroft 1937). Despite their overall uniformity, the veins occur in extremely varied host rocks including those of the Sicker Group, Karmutsen Formation, Bonanza Formation, Nanimo Group, skarn gneisses and Tertiary and older granitic intrusion (Carson 1969). These deposits then are probably of deep seated origin and are of Tertiary age. The Rich Lode Gold Corporation claims are surrounded by a number of gold properties some of which have produced in the past. These deposits owned by others are described in G.S.C. Mem. 204, 1937 and B. C. Department of Mines Bulletin No. 1, 1932.

LOCAL GEOLOGY

A recent discovered mineral occurrence on the "Rich Lode" claims is located on a westerly flowing unnamed creek 2300 metres south of the mouth of Canoe Creek and on the Singer Group I claim. This showing occurs near the head of a small canyon approximately 600 metres from the mouth of the creek. A series of fractures and quartz stringers are exposed on the north wall of the creek over a distance of 60 metres. At least 15 stringers containing quartz were exposed over this distance. The width of

these stringers varied from a hair line up to 8 cm. This zone has a strike of N40°E and steep dip to the west. Three of these stringers and fractures were sampled.

S5 - This sample was taken over a vertical height of 180 cm. of a fracture 2 cm. wide. The fracture contained vuggy quartz with minor chalcopyrite and galena. This sample ran 2.96 oz. gold and 1.06 oz. silver.

S5B - A similar sample taken one metre north of S5 ran 0.213 oz. gold and 0.08 oz. silver.

S7 - Quartz obtained from a stringer 3 metres up stream from S5. This sample was composed of vuggy quartz with no sulphides evident although a remnant crystal structure suggests either pyrite or galena may have been present. S7 ran .23 oz. silver and .084 oz. gold across 2 cm. over a 2 metre height.

The remainder of the showing was not sampled as oxidation and weathering had leached most of the sulphides. These samples should be considered character samples and were taken to determine the mode of occurrence and association

of the gold. Rock geochemistry was run on the remainder of samples taken in order to detect any trace elements. Samples 1 and 2 were taken from open cuts on the Tommy claim and samples 8, 9 and 10 were taken from the Tommy adit. The Tommy claim is owned by others but is adjacent to the Rich Lode claims and on strike of this zone.

PROSPECTING AND PHYSICAL WORK

During the period February 9th to 19th, 1983 prospecting and physical work were carried out on Rich Lode's Kennedy River claims.

On the Esther claim prospecting was undertaken by traversing the creek running through the center of this claim. As well, rock exposures to the north and south of the creek were examined. During the course of this work narrow pyrite sphalerite bearing quartz stringers were located in exposures of volcanic rock in the creek and these occurrences were blasted, sampled and marked with fluorescent paint (see plate 1 and appendix A for locations and results). Trenching and sampling was also conducted at several other localities (plate 1 and appendix A). Further physical work consisted of rehabilitating the old logging road through the property.

On the Jana claim two areas were trenched and sampled (plate 2, and appendix A). As well prospecting traverse were conducted on part of the claim.

Trenching was carried out on a cliff face by the highway on the Bertha claim (plate 2 and appendix A). Prospecting traverses were also carried out over parts of this ground.

Trail cutting and a traverse were carried out on the northwest corner of the Dodie claim.

An access trail was cut through the Centre Line East and Centre Line West claims.

A prospecting traverse was carried out on the Jones claim.

On the Mojo a prospecting traverse was also undertaken.



I have been advised by the Rich Lode Gold Corporation that a claim has been filed against the above claims by Walter Guppy.


I have therefore prepared supplementary additional information which I would appreciate being added to the report filed on May 10th, 1983.
