SUMMARY

Geological mapping of the 'A' claims was carried out by de la Mothe Exploration Services Ltd. from March 17 to March 20, 1984 to obtain a geological picture of the property and its economic potential.

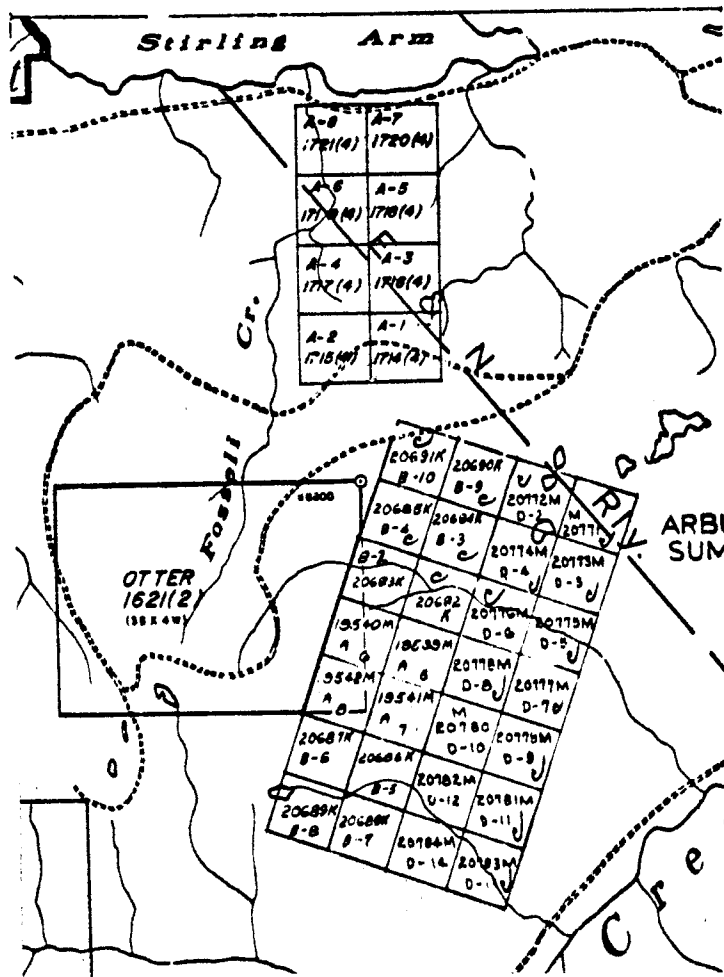

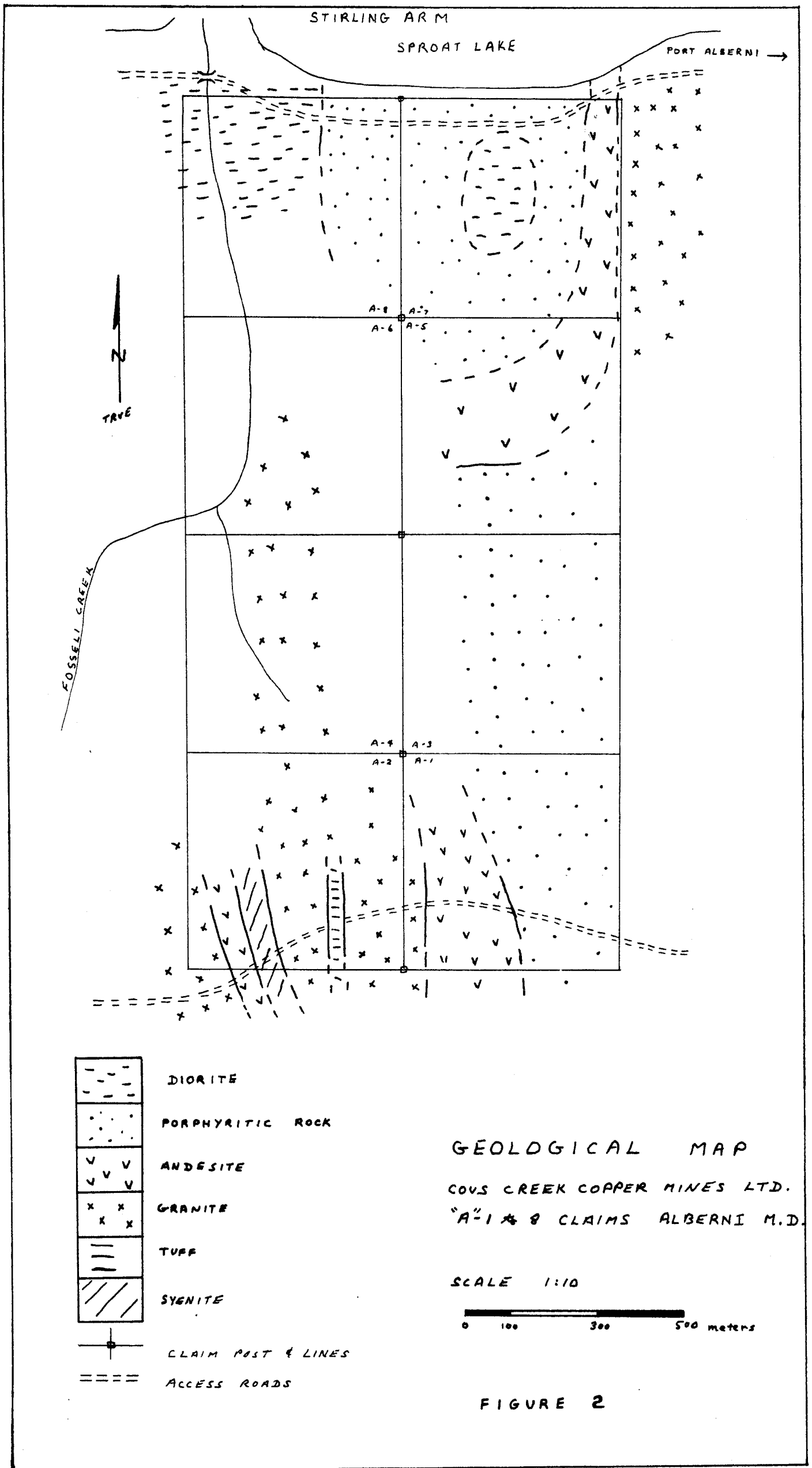
