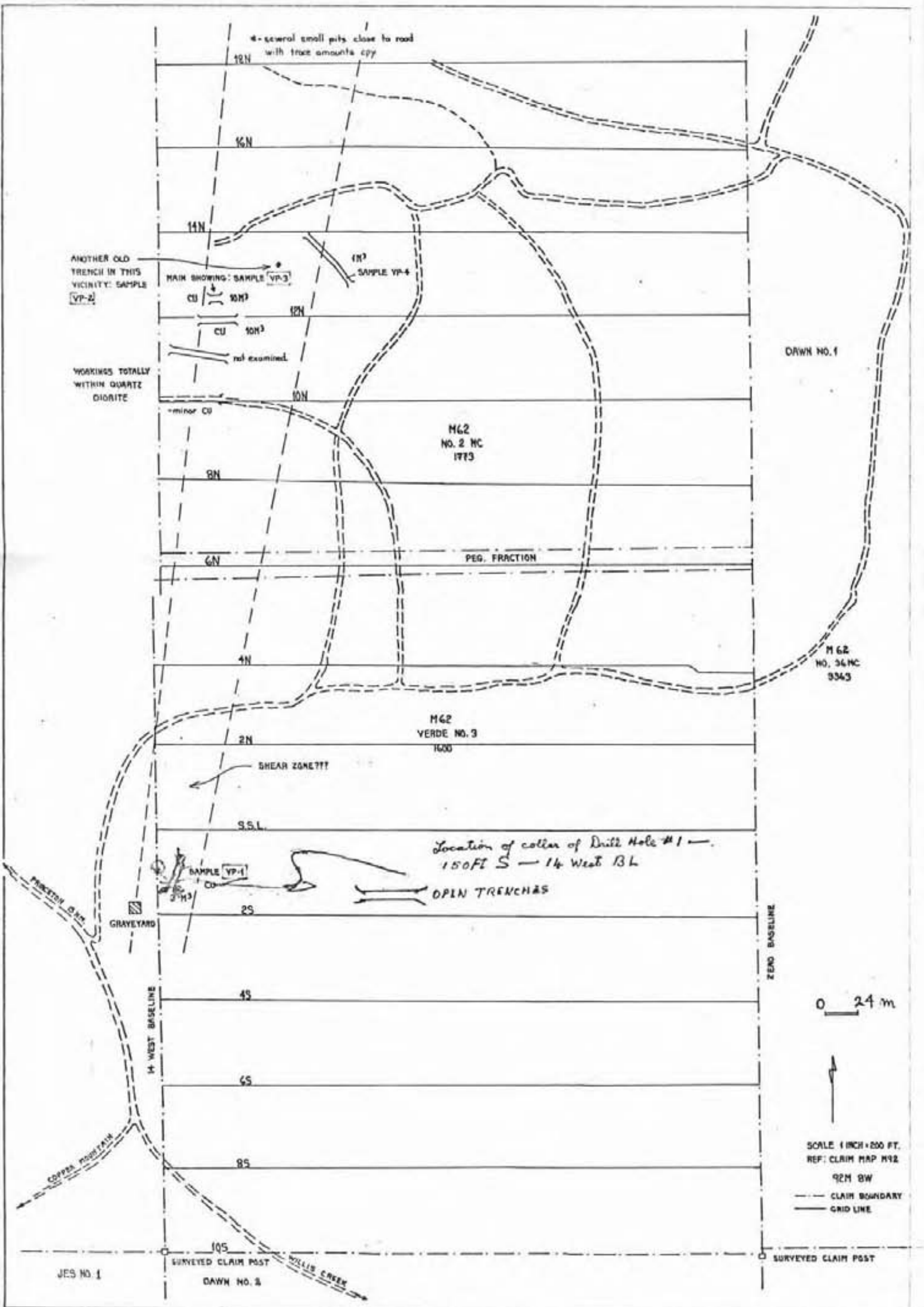

Flow banding evident - minor bands up to 1/2" thick stained with orange FeO ₂ . 5°-10° to core axis 126'-128' intensely sheared Dendritic Mn growth evident on many fractures and associated with fractures
