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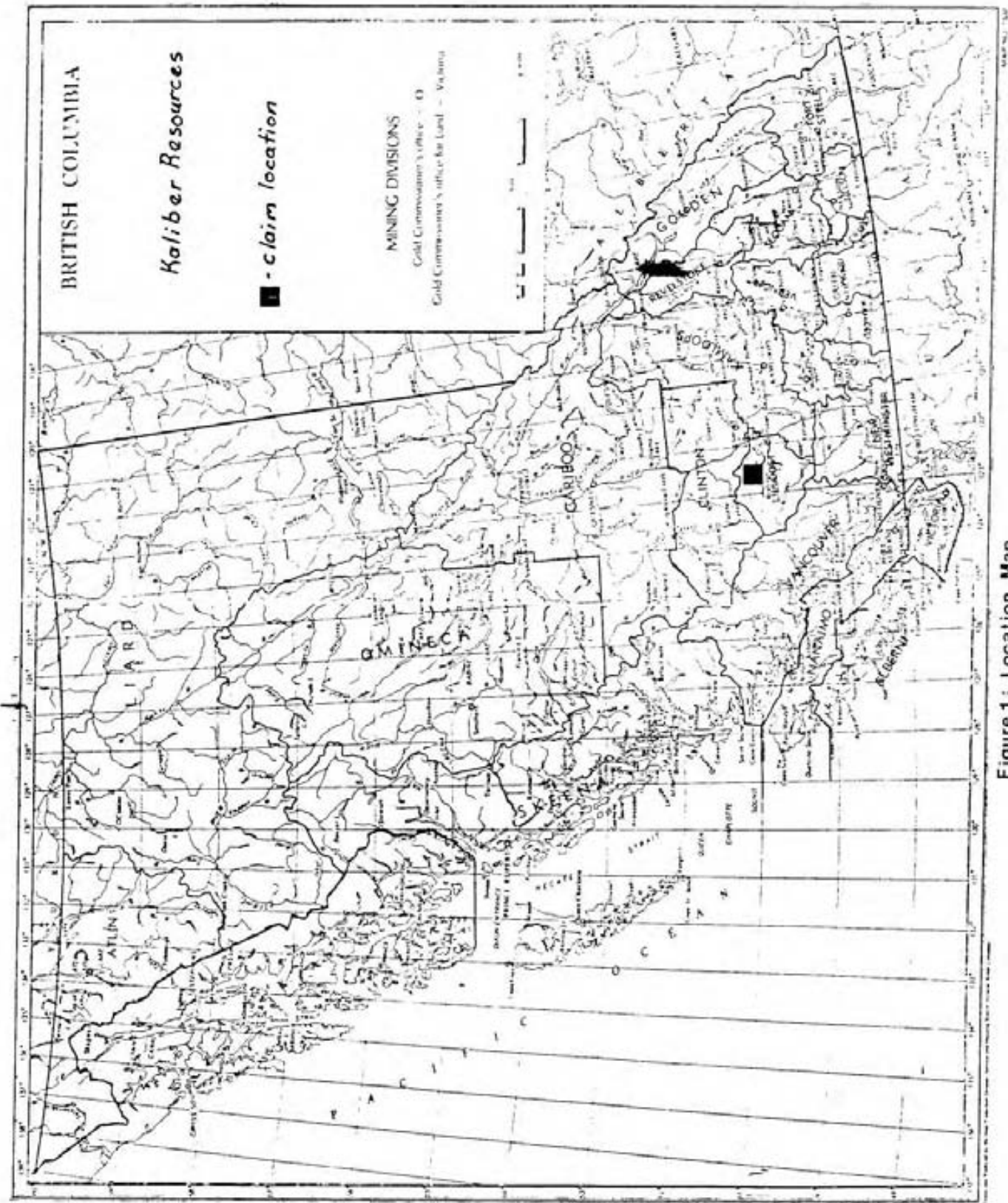
SUMMARY REPORT

Pursuant to a request from the directors of Kaliber Resources Ltd., Straightliners Exploration Services visited a property consisting of lot numbers 6823 and 6828 (reverted crown grants) and the Dream 9 claim. The total claim area contains four claim units.

Upon inspection, Straightliners found the adit described by Peter P. Tsaparas in his report dated November 15, 1984 (see figure 3). The entrance to the adit was located some 200 vertical feet above the Lillooet-Goldbridge highway. The slope distance was determined to be 258 feet north of the highway.

Entry into the adit was easily accomplished although the portal was partially collapsed. The portal can probably be repaired or replaced with a minimum of timbering due to the apparent stability of the wall rock. Once past the portal the adit is in fairly good repair, needing very little timbering to bring the adit up to industry standards.

The adit follows a N27E bearing for 248 feet from the portal, where the adit divides with one branch proceeding due north for a short distance and once again along the N27E bearing to a total distance of 345 feet from the portal, where an end face was found. The main branch continues along the same bearing



for another 262 feet (total distance of 510 feet) to where the adit has collapsed.

The adit follows the strike of a quartz vein which can be seen from approximately 20 feet into the adit to the 510 foot distance of the main adit. Observed widths were noted to vary from 1/2 foot to over 4 feet in some locations.

In order to evaluate the economic potential of the adit, Straightliners conducted a sampling survey along the main adit. Five samples, collected from the main quartz vein, are located according to figure 3. The following table summarizes the assay results (see appendix A for assayer's report).

Assay results suggest that gold, silver and zinc mineralization may be present on the Kaliber Resources Ltd.

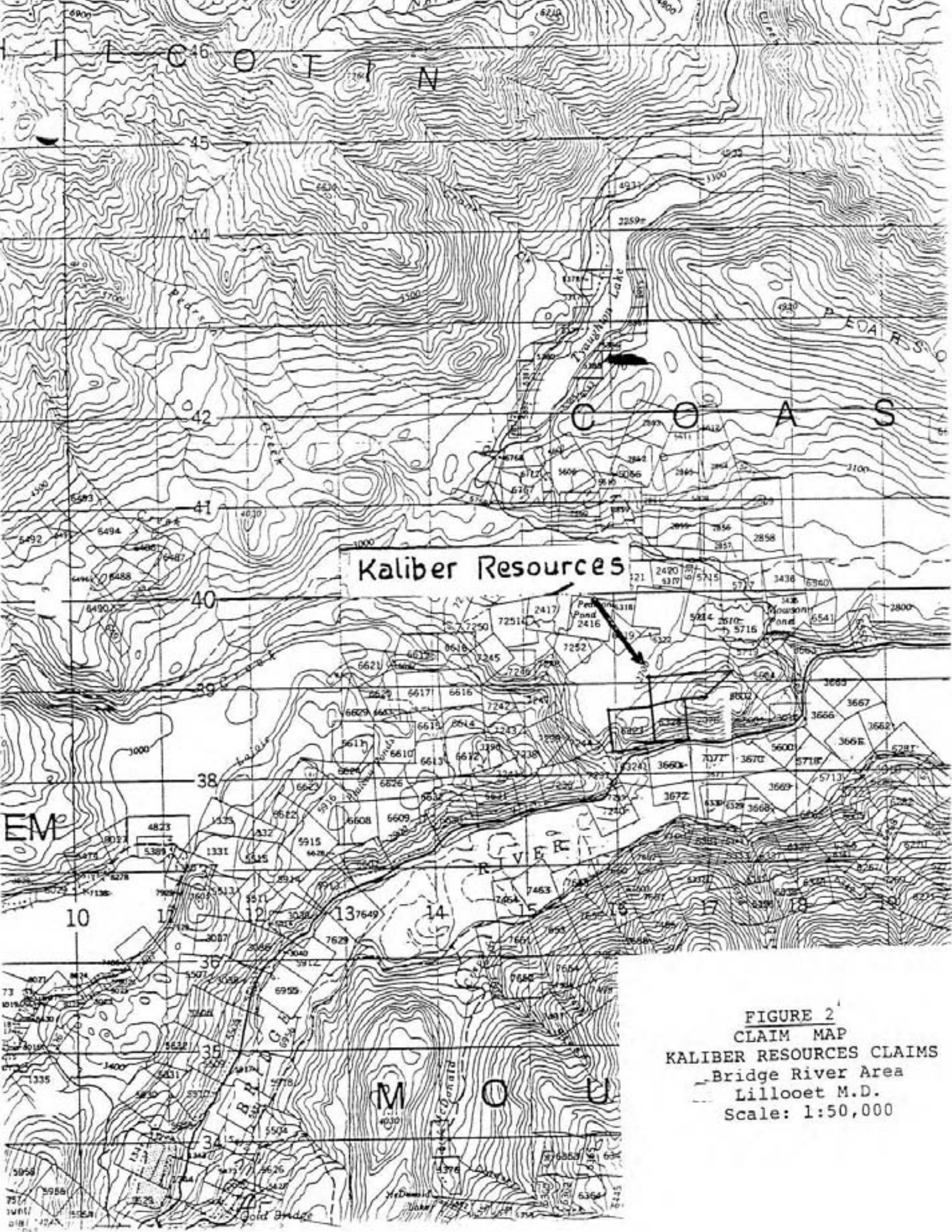

property. The appearance of relatively low concentrations of economic metals in the above assay samples should not rule out the presence of economic grades of mineralization.

A sample collected by Peter P. Tsaparas, P.Eng. (Nov. 15, 1983) from the dump, containing 0.09 oz. Au/T and 2.85 oz. Ag/T, was interpreted by him as possibly originating from^s beyond the collapsed portion of the adit (beyond 510 ~~feet~~). Straightliners shares this opinion.

In order to better evaluate the economic potential of the property it is suggested that an attempt be made to sample from beyond the collapsed part of the adit either by percussion drilling (from above or from within the adit) or by repairing the adit.

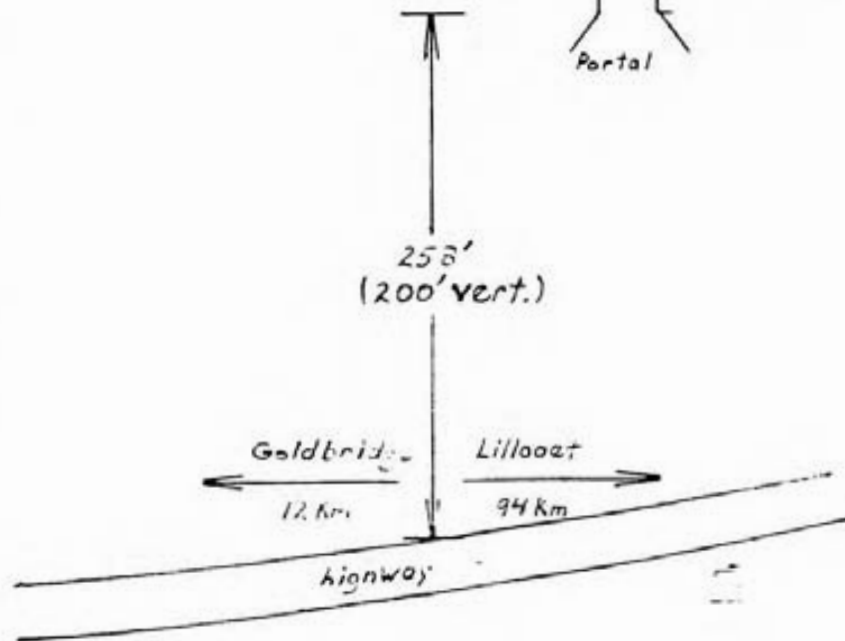
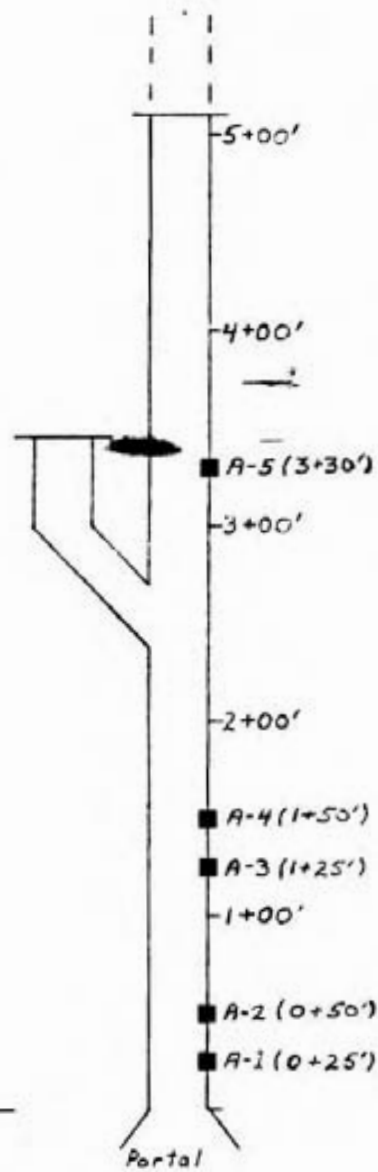

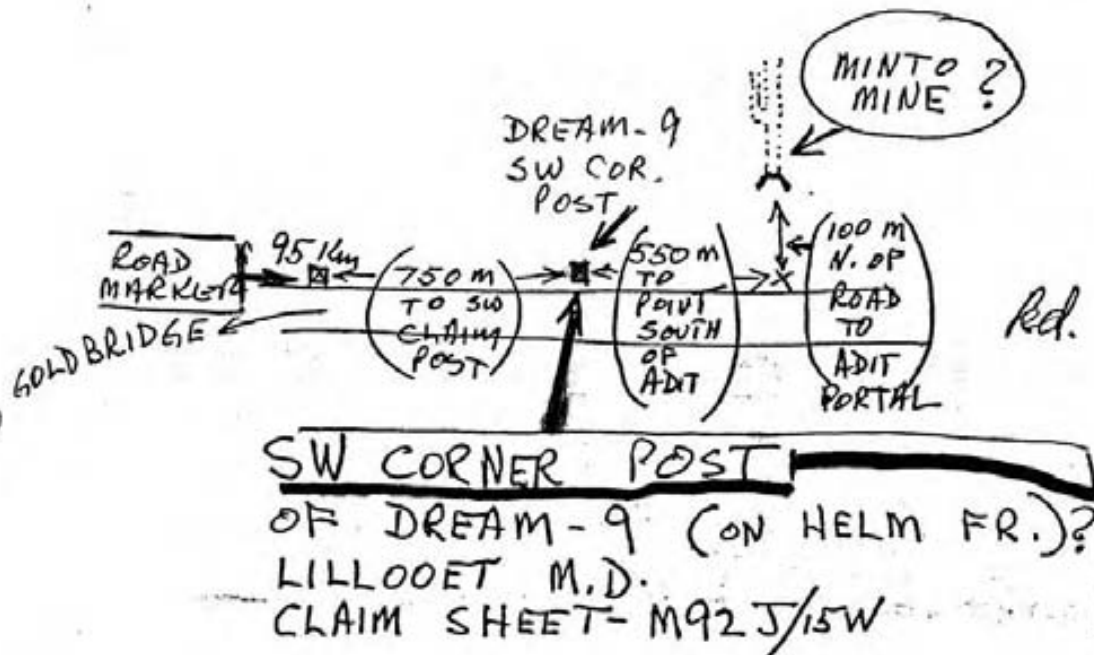
