ROAD BUILDING

In order to facilitate access to the trenching sites on the Mets 2 Mineral Claim, a road was constructed with a John Deere 450 bulldozer. The road extends from the flats off of the north end of Metsantan Ridge for a distance of approximately 1.25 km to the top of the ridge along the north slope.

Bucking or limb slashing would not be necessary as all work was done above treeline. Road access was not required for those trenches on top of Metsantan Ridge; the bulldozer was "walked in" to the trench sites.

TRENCHING PROGRAM

The trenching program started in July 1985, with the tractor/backhoe "walked in" from the Sturdee Airstrip. It was returned there at the end of the program in September 1985. During this period, 36 new trenches (totalling 1,718 metres in length, averaging 1.5 metres in depth, and 1.0 to 1.5 metres in width) were completed.

Subsequent to the backhoe excavations, the trenches were further cleaned by hand tools to enable proper sampling and mapping. The unusually late arrival of assay data in conjunction with the early onset of winter conditions prevented filling in the trenches during this program. Although all of the trenches are located above treeline, a site reclamation program is planned for the summer of 1986.

Trench and road locations are illustrated at a scale of 1:5000 on Figure 3.

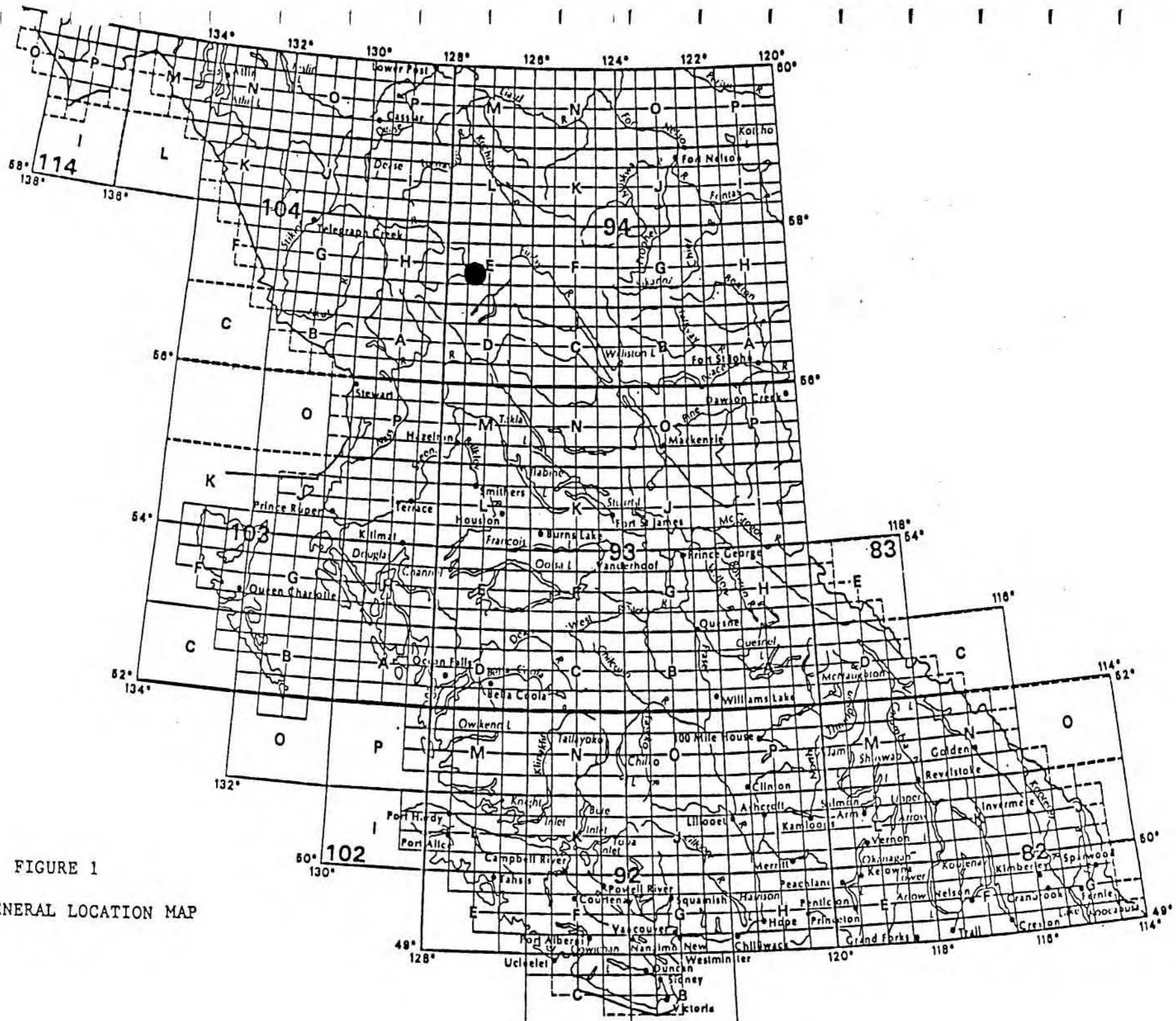
