SUMMARY GEOLOGY (lithology, age, structure, alteration, mineralization, size, and attitude):  
**East trending quartz fissure fillings cut greenstones and quartzites of the Anavelit Group west of Camp McKinney. Veins are 0.3-1.5 m wide and carry pyrite, galena, sphalerite and free gold.**

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## INTRODUCTION

This prospecting report briefly summarizes prospecting and physical work carried out by ANDY DUPRAS, JOE CRANEY and GORDON WHATLEY on the Lou and Billie claim on 5 to 8 and 12 to 14 June, 1986. On November 8, Andy Dupras and Bevan McFadden, P. Eng., of Granges Exploration, collected 13 rock samples from old diggings for assay. The purpose of this work was to locate the old diggings, pump out the Eureka shaft and to obtain reliable assays from old diggings. (P. Peto)

## PROPERTY, LOCATION, ACCESS & PHYSIOGRAPHY

The LOU claims (12 units) are located in the Greenwood Mining Division (Figure 1) under record number 4513 having an anniversary date on 14 January. The LOU LCP is situated approximately 800 feet west of the Cariboo-Amelia mine about 11 km north of the Rock Creek Bridge. The claims are accessed via the Mount Baldy ski road from Oliver on highway 97 or from Rock Creek on highway 3. They are located on the south slope of Mount Baldy, heavily timbered with scrub pine, at an elevation of 5000 feet.

## TECHNICAL DATA

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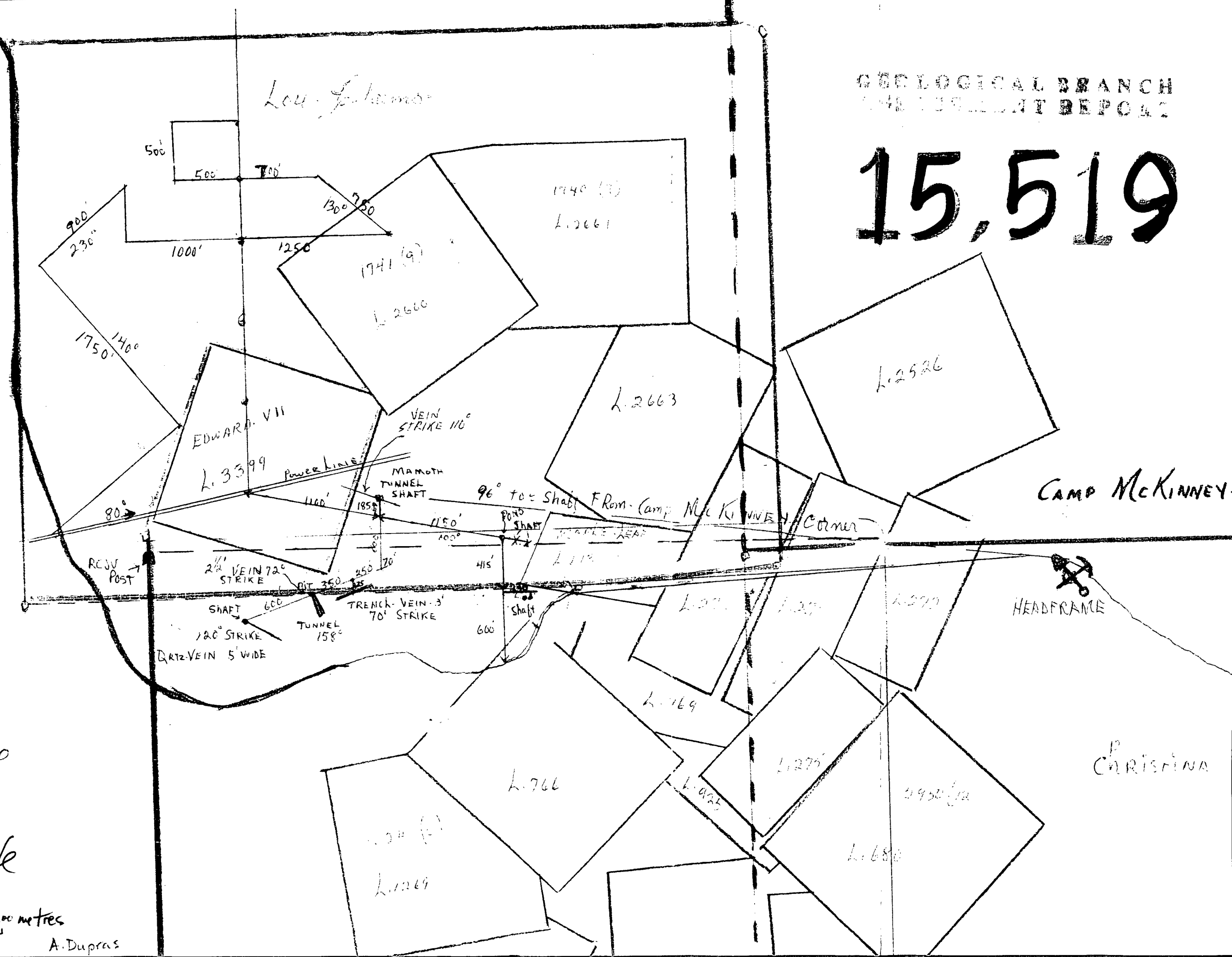
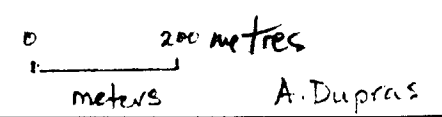


FIGURE 4: TRAVERSE MAP

Andy Dupras camped on the property, June 5 to 8, cut a base line 2250 feet from the Eureka shaft to the main powerline then did approximately 5 mile traverse survey locating all shafts, pits and trenches (figure 4). On June 12-14, we tried to pump water out of the Eureka shaft, hauled out timber but we could only drop the water level 45 feet. We also showed the workings to an Inco geologist who collected several rock samples. Our prospecting found encouraging mineralization in numerous trenches and the shaft dumps. Granges Exploration collected 13 rock samples with my assistance and these were assayed for gold and silver (figure 3, and appendix).

## INTERPRETATION

The prospecting work resulted in the location of numerous old, forgotten diggings on mineralized quartz veins west of Cariboo-Amelia mine. Our attempts were unsuccessful at pumping out the Eureka shaft due to technical difficulties. Our work laid the


ground work for subsequent exploration on the BILLIE claim by Peter Peto, Ph.D.

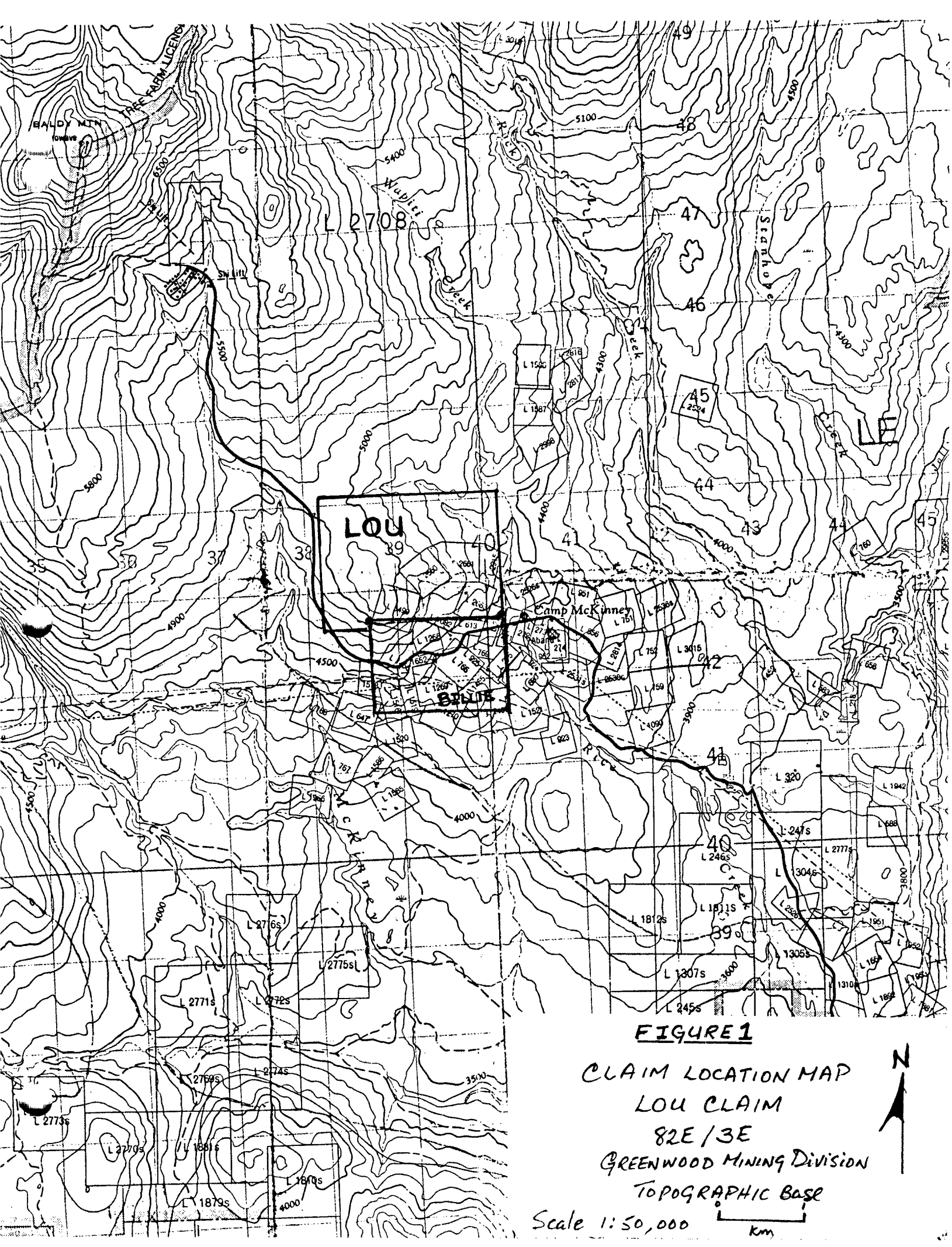

 TOPOGRAPHIC BASE

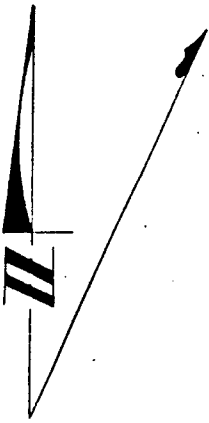

IN (A REEP. 4446)

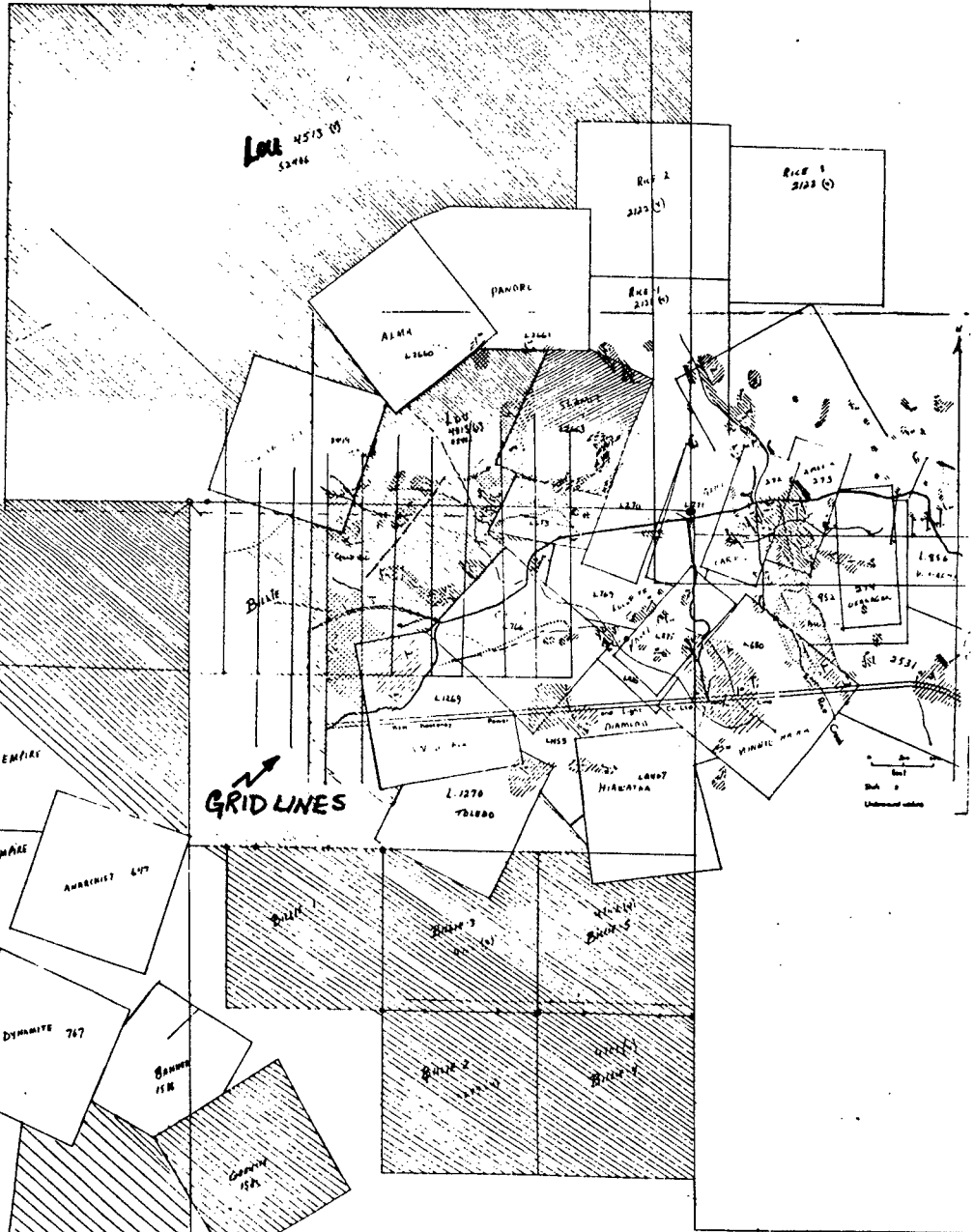

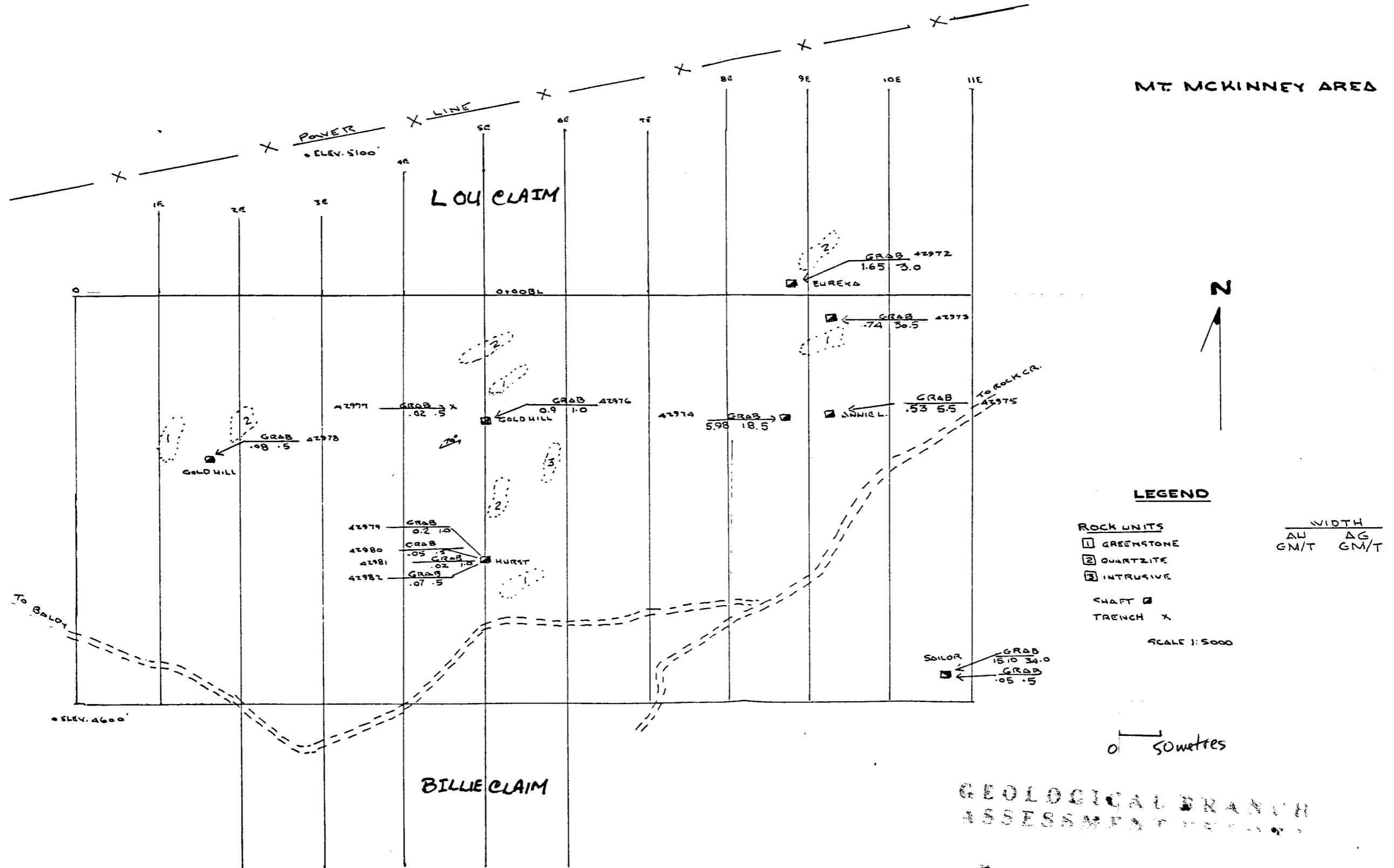
