A map showing surface and under ground workings as well as trenches has been prepared and forms part of this report.

LOCATION AND ACCESS

The historical name of the claim is known as the Wigwam property and is located approximately 20 miles south west of Revelstoke, B.C. at Longitude 119 degrees West and 50 degrees North Latitude.

The property is reached by the partially paved road that leads southward from Revelstoke. At 12 mile an all weather gravelled forestry access road follows the Akolkolex River eastward. The road passes through the property at mi 9.8 or 15 km.

The following locations were prospected and itemized as locations numbers 1 to 14 showing elevations.

A description is as follows:

| 1 | 2175' | The lowest working is a drift about 75' above the Akolkolex River on the north side of the logging road. A tunnel is collard in biotite schist and argillaceous limestone. The adit is caved and the working could not be examined. No mineralization was seen on the dump. |
| 2 | 2225' | 300 feet west of the above tunnel is the site of an old tunnel destroyed by the construction of a road. |
| 3 | 2500' | 900 feet along the trail is a short 15' tunnel collard in white marble. It was driven along a 1 foot wide band of oxidized sulphides. Scattered sulfides were noted in the marble. |
| 4 | 2575'
ICE ADIT | 200 feet farther along the outcrop is a tunnel with 386 feet of crosscut, 227 feet of drift and 50 feet of raise. Near the portal the tunnel crosscuts white marble which grades into a highly silicified zone near the collar of the drift. A 505' wide zone of lead zinc replacement was noted about 151' from the portal. At 102' along the northwesterly drift a 4x8 incline raise was driven in the right wall for 50' across the beds. The raise is at approximately 45 degrees. The drift was driven along a highly altered gossaned lenticular band that varies from 1 to 8 feet in thickness. Just above the portal is a trench revealing oxidized sulfides. |

SHOWING ELEVATION

- 4(a) 2565' Quarry - some mining of limestone carried on here.
- 5 2625' About 100' northwest of the above adit is a 50' tunnel. Near the portal a 3' band of massive sulphides was noted. There is a sloughed-in trench 25' west of the portal.
- 6 3075' Old trenching has exposed highly folded beds which are massively replaced by pyrrhotite, sphalerite and galena. The actual thickness of the zone could not be determined. The trench is about 150' below the trail. The zone dips 30 degrees ENE and strikes NNW.
- 7 3250' Further west along the trail there is an open cut exposing a light and dark band, silicified limestone shows sparse sulphides across 9 feet.
- 8 3275' 225 feet farther along the hillside the silicified marble is faulting and mineralized with sphalerite and sparse galena along bedding planes. The zone appears to be mineralized over a thickness of more than 50'.
- 9 3425' 200 feet north of the above showing, a 50' crosscut
GALENA ADIT was driven along a 1 to 2 foot wide zone of coarse galena and sphalerite galena predominating in silicified marble.
- 10 3275' 200 feet from the 3275 elevation showing at
CROOKED ADIT S 50 degrees W there is a short 35' drift. The tunnel was driven into a small anticline in silicified marble. A 10' crosscut was driven in the left wall and a 15' verticle raise at the face. Bands of replacement sulphides were noted in most of the tunnel. "S" shaped folding was evident.
- 11 3250' Two trenches were cut 100' east of the above adit. The
12 3195' trenches are partially sloughed in. 60' below the the portal of the Crooked Adit is a trench showing zinc, lead mineralization.
- 13 3350' 150' N.W. of the above drift, a trench exposes banded replacement sulphides in limestone.
- 14 3400' This trench cuts bands of oxidized sulphides across

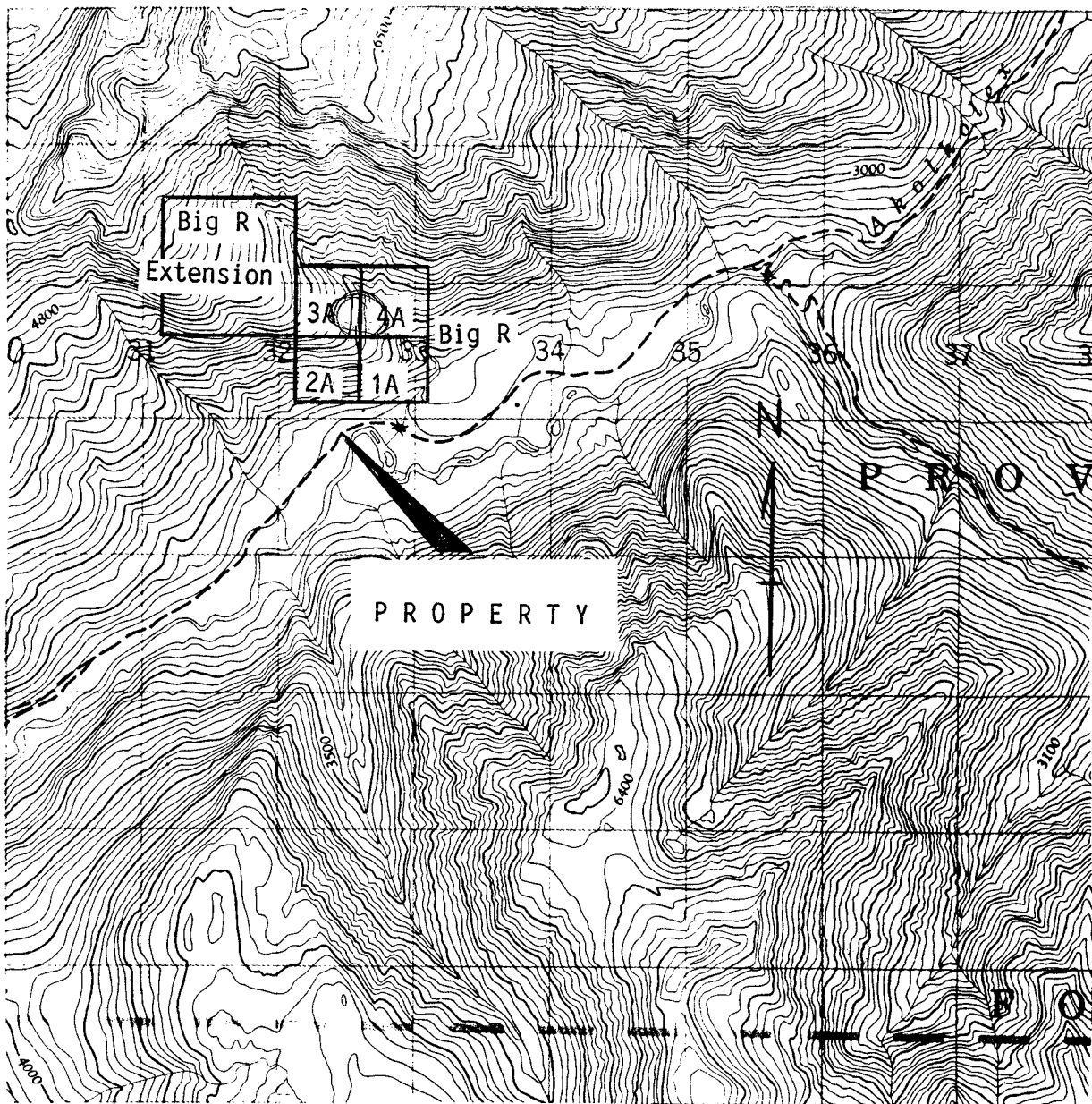

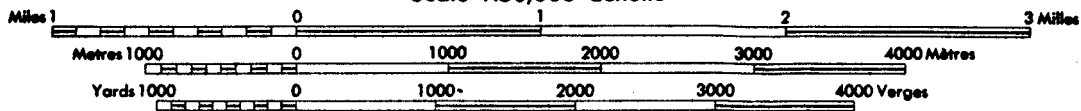

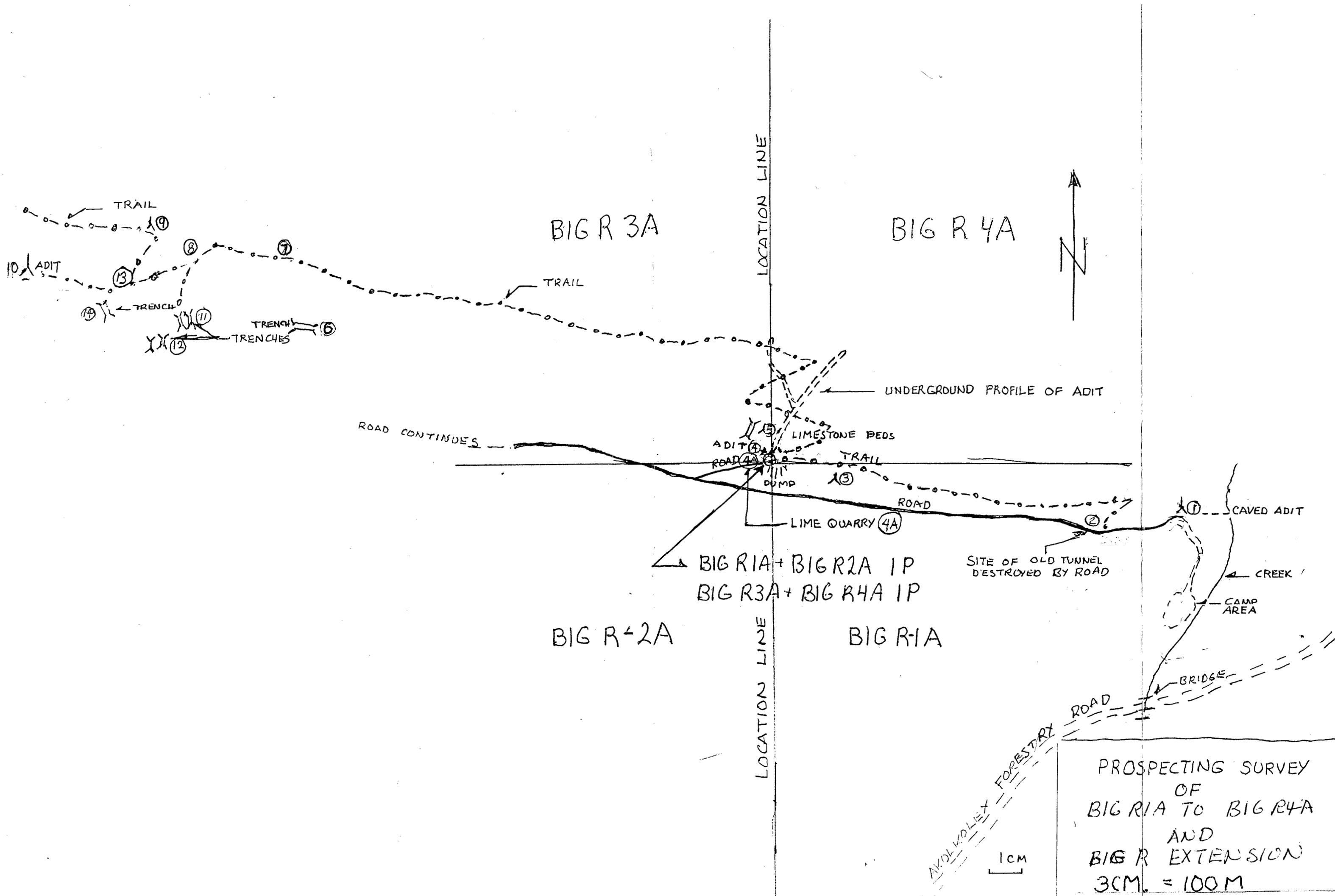
