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Introduction

The purpose of this report is for assessment work credit; and also to review the current and previous work done on the claims, to assess the potential of the property.

It includes Information collected from field Survey, Examination and prospecting on several occasions during this past summer on the Gordon, Gail, Chris, Chris FR, Joe FR, and Gordon FR.

A program of mineral Exploration and a Geophysical Survey is recommended.

The Chris - 1 - 8 - 2 post mineral claims are situated about = 1½ miles N.E. of old Camp McKinney. They are bounded to the E and W by the Inkameep = claims and the Kettle to the south = they are reached by a bush (4 x 4) road from the Southern Provincial Highway at Rock Creek Canyon Bridge: for 5 miles this road is followed - then Jolly Creek Trail is followed for approximately 2½ miles and Chris 7 - 8 are just north of the power line (approximately 500 m) Rock Creek runs right through the full length of the claims from N-to-S- Rock Creek crosses Chris 2-4-6-8= The topography is very good; shallow rolling hills. The road runs through the full length of the claims. Elevation is approximately 4000 to 5000 feet above sea level.

The Gordon Claim & Chris FR

are Situated approx. 7.2 km from Rock Creek Canyon Bridge on Camp McKinney Road accessible by car; runs through the whole property from S.E. corder to N.W. corner which is approx. 650 m. west of Camp McKinney (Now ARK Energy) Mine Shaft and mine Camp.

Gail Claims

are accessible by 4 x 4 or pick up truck; they are Situated between the Gordon and the Chris Claims -- the Gail No. 1 & 2 -- No. 1 Post is situated approximately 350 m. north of Jolly Lake - Elevation 3900 to 4200 feet above Sea Level.

Technical Data & Interpretation

Main Showing is on the Chris 3 & 4 - 5 & 6. Blasted and cleaned 3 old trenches (circa 1900) opened new Showing (Shear zone) with 555 cat. with 6 way Blade and Back hoe on the Road and made cat Road from Road to old trench west Side of Road. Good Shear zone 20' wide mineralized few inches wide with abundant Galena, Chalco, Pyrite and sparce Zinc. We surveyed a traverse connecting all trenches and pits and old Shaft in the area -- took numerous Rock Samples, Prospected 2 men - 10 Days.

4 - Good Showings on the Gail No. 5 & 6 and 1 & 2 consisting of very old workings, but had no time this year to further Prospect the property. Will do a Geophysic Survey next summer. Plus back hoe and cat work.

We did back hoe work on the Gordon Claim Intersected a calcite vein 3 to 6' wide and a Graphite vein 12" wide approximately 350 feet west of the calcite Vein. found some very old workings on the S.W. corner of the Property 1 claim North of the E.W. South Boundary. This claim is situated in the immediate Vicinity of Camp McKinney and warrant a lot more exploration which we will carry on in 1988 in Geophysic, EM and MAG and Soil Sampling. The location is very favourable for Gold and Silver.

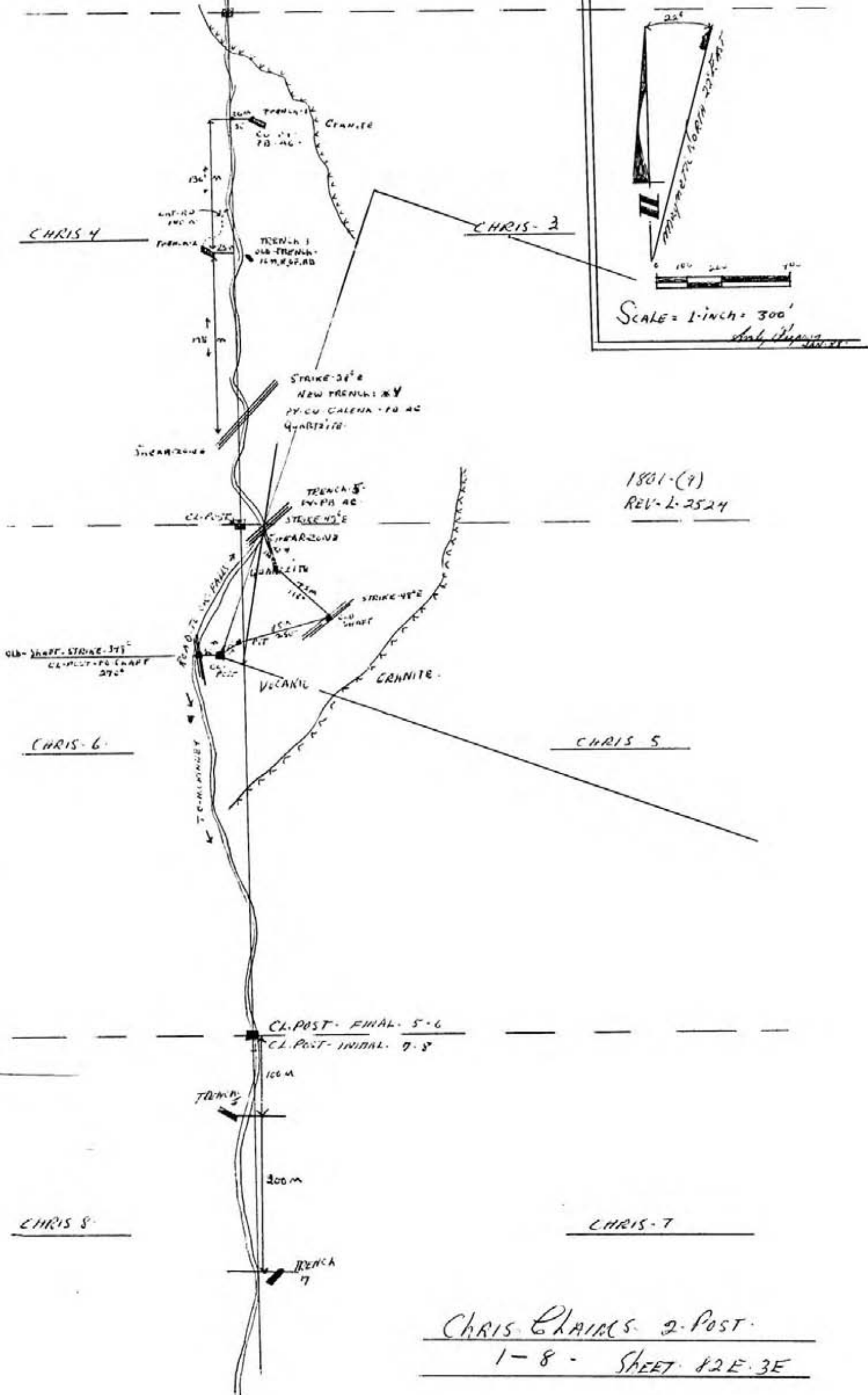
