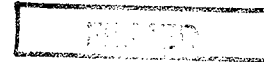

I N T R O D U C T I O N

- (i) GENERAL GEOPGRAPHIC: The Deer Claim is 5 kilometers north of Atlin. Access is the Atlin Road which borders the Western boundary of the claim and the Trahn Gulch Trail which borders the Southern boundary of the claim.
- (ii) PROPERTY DEFINITION: There are two reasons why I staked this property- (No. 1) A local oldtimer told me he used to run supplies out to a prospector in the early 1930's who was drifting on a nickel show. I thought platinum might be involved. (No. 2) I used J.D. Atken map from the geological Survey of Canada Memoir 307. I covered the contacts on the eastern part of the claim which borders up to the old gold shows of Monro Mountain.
- Bob Leneve and myself are the owners. I am the operator - Brad White. Homestake mines are going to put a gridd and Mag. survey on the eastern part of the claim.
- (iii) SUMMARY OF WORK DONE: Most of the work done was trying to find the old workings. I was unable to locate the drift but found the cabin and forge. Most of the calim is covered with over burden except for the southern part which I prospected. I blasted 30M. x 1M. x 1M. trench on a granit plug with no results.

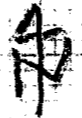
STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATION
