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1. Introduction:

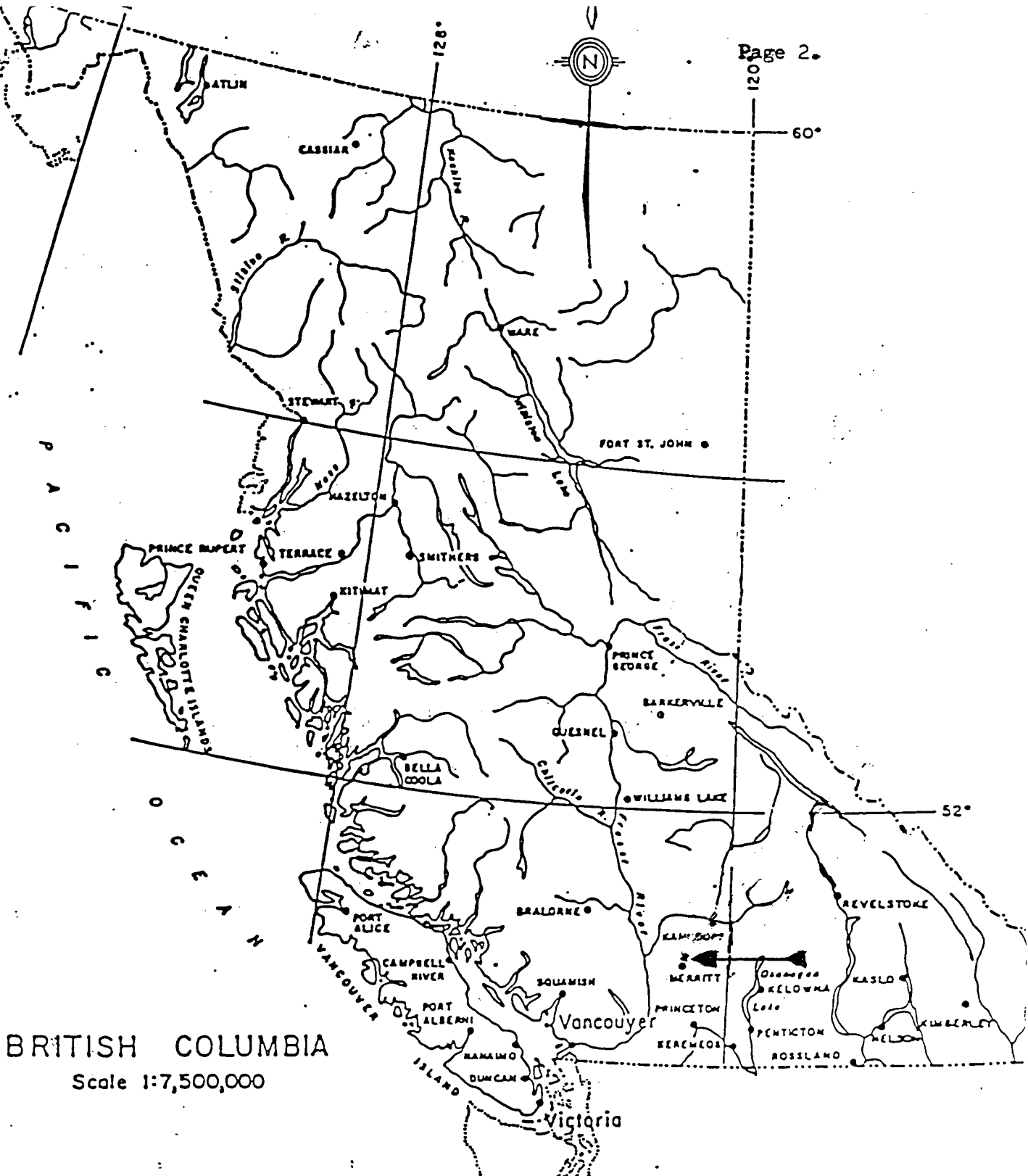
The Azure#2 claim was taken in 1988 by the present owners (myself and W.T. Hall) because of the grade and size of the quartz vein and the hope of being able to come up with more showings without having a large budget. However, after lots of researching and prospecting in the area I feel the deposit has more value as ornamental stone than as a copper gold deposit.

2. Summary:

On May 18, 1989, Dirk Moraal representing Corona Corporation, and myself examined and sampled the Azure#2 claim. Dirk Moraal also drafted the map. The map and assays are the basis of this report.

3. Location and Access:

The Azure#2 claim is located approximately 17.5 kilometers northeast of Merritt B.C. Access is either north up the Mill creek road from Lower Nicola or on the Coquihalla highway which traverses the northeastern corner of the claim.

The mineralization is very uniformly distributed and the assays are representative of the whole deposit. The 2 soil samples taken above the vein did not kick. This could be in part to the thickness of the overburden.
