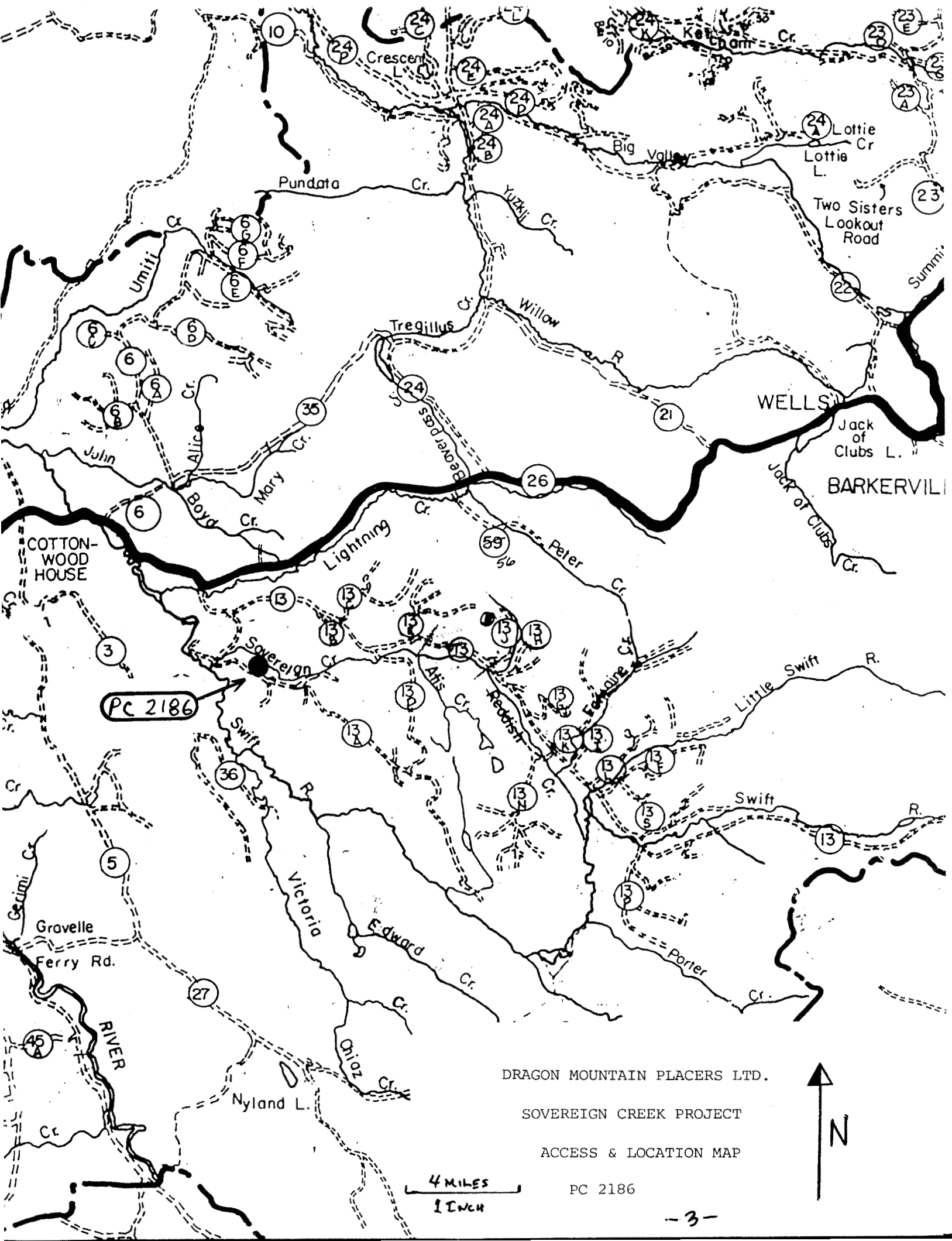

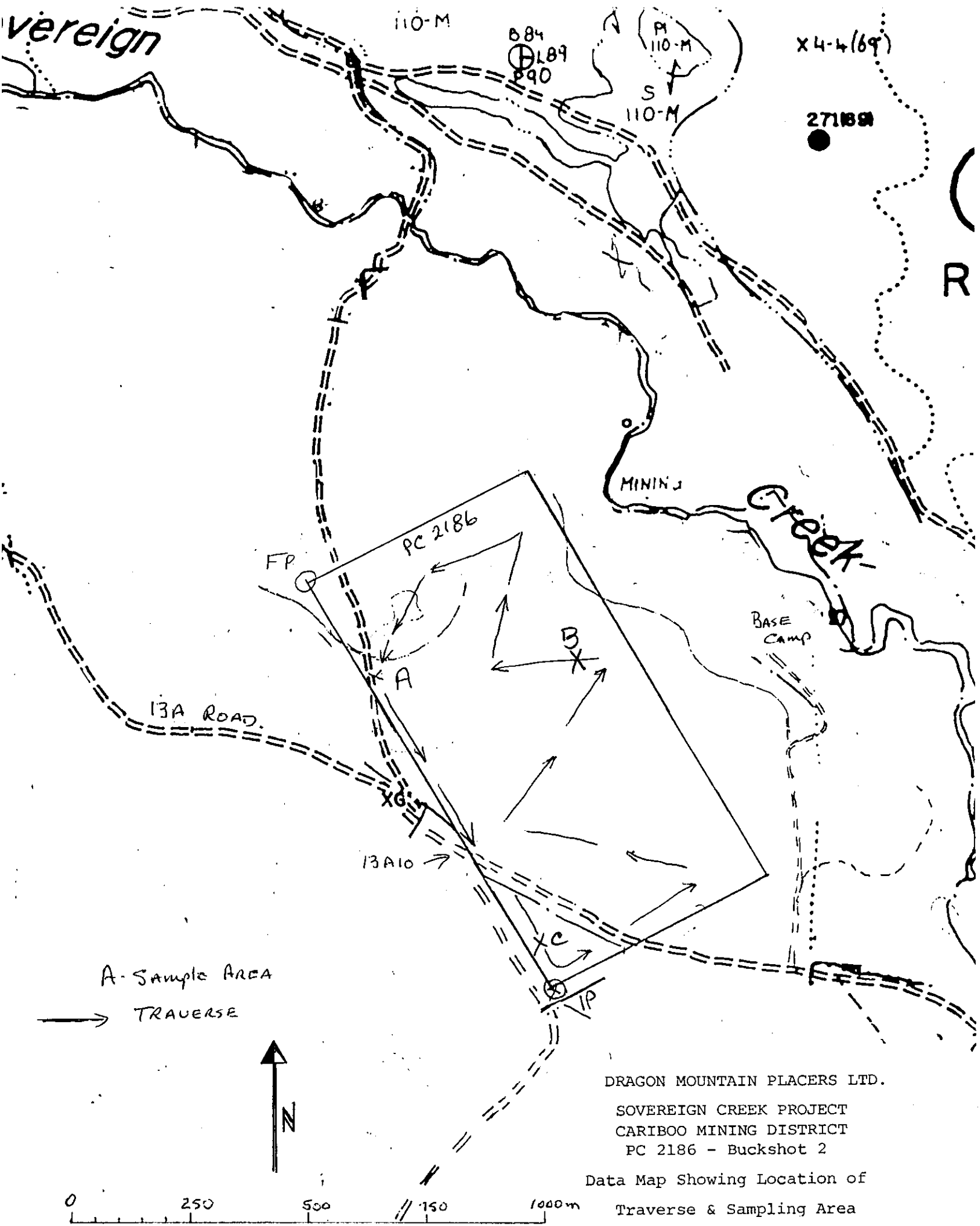

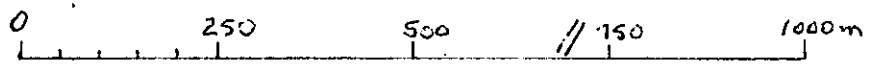

**Evaluation and Recommendation Report**

for Placer Claim Buckshot 2 - PC 2186

located near Sovereign Creek in the Cariboo Mining District

Latitude 52 59' 50"

Longitude 122 02' 30"

This report has been prepared at the request of Dragon Mountain Placers, the owner of the subject claim. The object of the report is to evaluate the physical and sedimentary aspects of the claim, grade the property as to its merit, and if positive, recommend further exploration on the project.

Location and Access

As noted on the enclosed maps, the claim is located south of Sovereign Creek, and is crossed by the 13A forestry road at the 13A10 post. To get to this point one travels 4 kms. east of the Cottonwood Store, located on Barkerville Hwy.26, to the Swift River forestry service road (1300 Road), then 3 kms. south and east on the 1300 road to the junction of the 1300 and 13A roads. From here follow the 13A road roughly 7 kms. to 13A10 post, which is located on the SW portion of the claim.

### Discussion

The surface of the claim was logged several years ago, so visibility of the surface is quite good. The surface of this claim is relatively flat with the exception of a fairly steep sided valley, with an intermittent stream, located in the northern portion of the claim. The valley trends in a NE-SW direction swinging west where it crosses the western boundary of the claim. Depth to the valley floor in a vertical direction is roughly 30 meters.

Visual examination of the surface sediments indicate the entire claims surface consists of glacial gravels with constituents grading in size from silt to small boulders roughly 30cm. in size. Particles are broken, angular, and consist primarily of quartz, schists, and basalt.

Locally on the surface, are a few large granite and grey schist boulders ranging up to 1m in size.

Several probe samples were taken, which confirmed the lithology of the near surface sediments as discussed above, with one group of samples at point A on the traverse being assayed for its gold and silver content. As presented on the enclosed assay report, the gold content was very promising.

*Sample Location and Description*

*Probe A - located 5 m east of west boundary and 200 m south of north boundary.*

*Depth & Lithology - 1.2 m of gravel, with particles grading from silt, to pebbles 4 cms in size, along with broken particles of granite, green schist, argillite and limestone.*

*Probe B - located 400 m east of west boundary, and 400 m south of north boundary.*

*Depth & Lithology - 1.0 m of gravel, with grain sizes ranging from silt to pebbles up to 4 cms in size.*

*Probe C - located 50 m east of west boundary and 50 m north of south boundary.*

*Depth & Lithology - 1.0 m of gravel, consisting of silt, sandstone and pebbles up to 5 cms in size.*

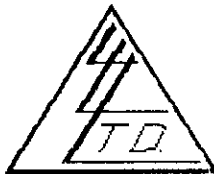
*These samples were taken with a hand held auger using an auger with a diameter of 10 cm.*

### Recommendation

Due to the close proximity of this claim to known production along Sovereign Creek, as well as to surface workings located approximately 1 km. to the south west it is recommended that additional exploratory work be undertaken in the form of drilling and trenching. While the valley at the north is covered with glacial material, it is quite possible that this material may be relatively thin under the steeper portions of the valley slope. It has been noted that to the east along Sovereign Creek, just north of mileage marker 13A11, Channel type pay gravels occur overlain by 3-8 meters of glacial sediments. It is therefore recommended that some trenching be done on the valley flanks to explore the possibility that those pay gravels also underlie the northern portion of the claim. A drill program in the central and southern portion of the claim would also provide very worthwhile information, while a surface sampling program will determine the size and value of the surface gravels in the vicinity of the A area samples.
