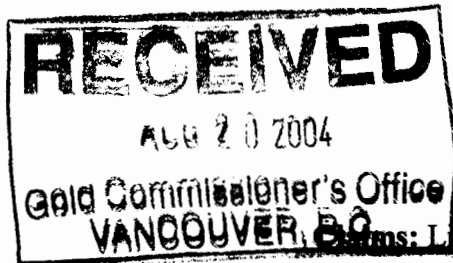

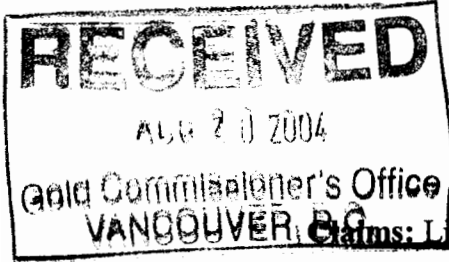

## 1. Introduction

The Little Southwester claim block consists of 10 units which were staked in May of 2003 to cover the area to the West of Williams creek on the South side of China Ck. The property is owned by Barry Hanslit.

The Little Southwester claim block is covered by both new and old logging slash. Fresh clearcutting and road building was started in summer of 2003 and has continued to present.

## 2. Location and Access

Access to the claim is from Port Albernie you travel on the Bamfield Rd to Museum mainline. Museum main provides access to Thistle Mine main which can be travelled North to Lizard Lk. Lizard Lk is on the Southeastern most portion of the Little Southwester Claim.

## 3. Property History

The China Creek area has a long established history of both lode and placer mining and exploration. Records show that placer mining was carried out in the China Ck watershed as early as 1862.

Lode mining/exploration started in the China Ck valley around 1890 and continues to present day.

There are no significant mineral occurrences on the Little Southwester to date.

## 4. Prospecting Activity

Prospecting consisted of travelling the new logging roads with an ATV and looking for any mineralized rock on the newly cut roads.

No mineralized zones were located on the property in which new roads were built.

Because no mineralization was located no samples were collected for assaying.

A map is included showing the area in which prospecting occurred.

There is no future work planned for the Little Southwester Claim.

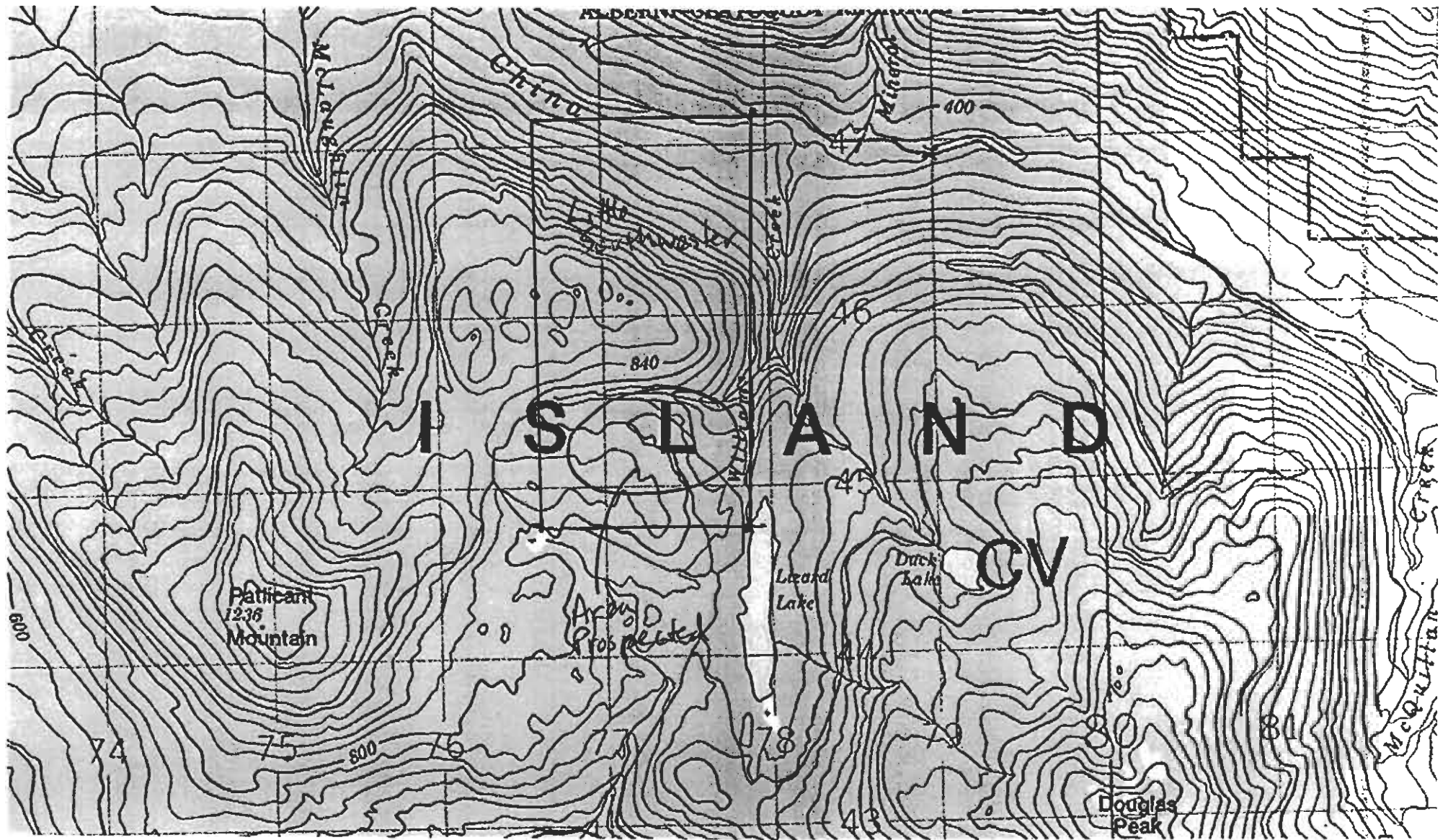

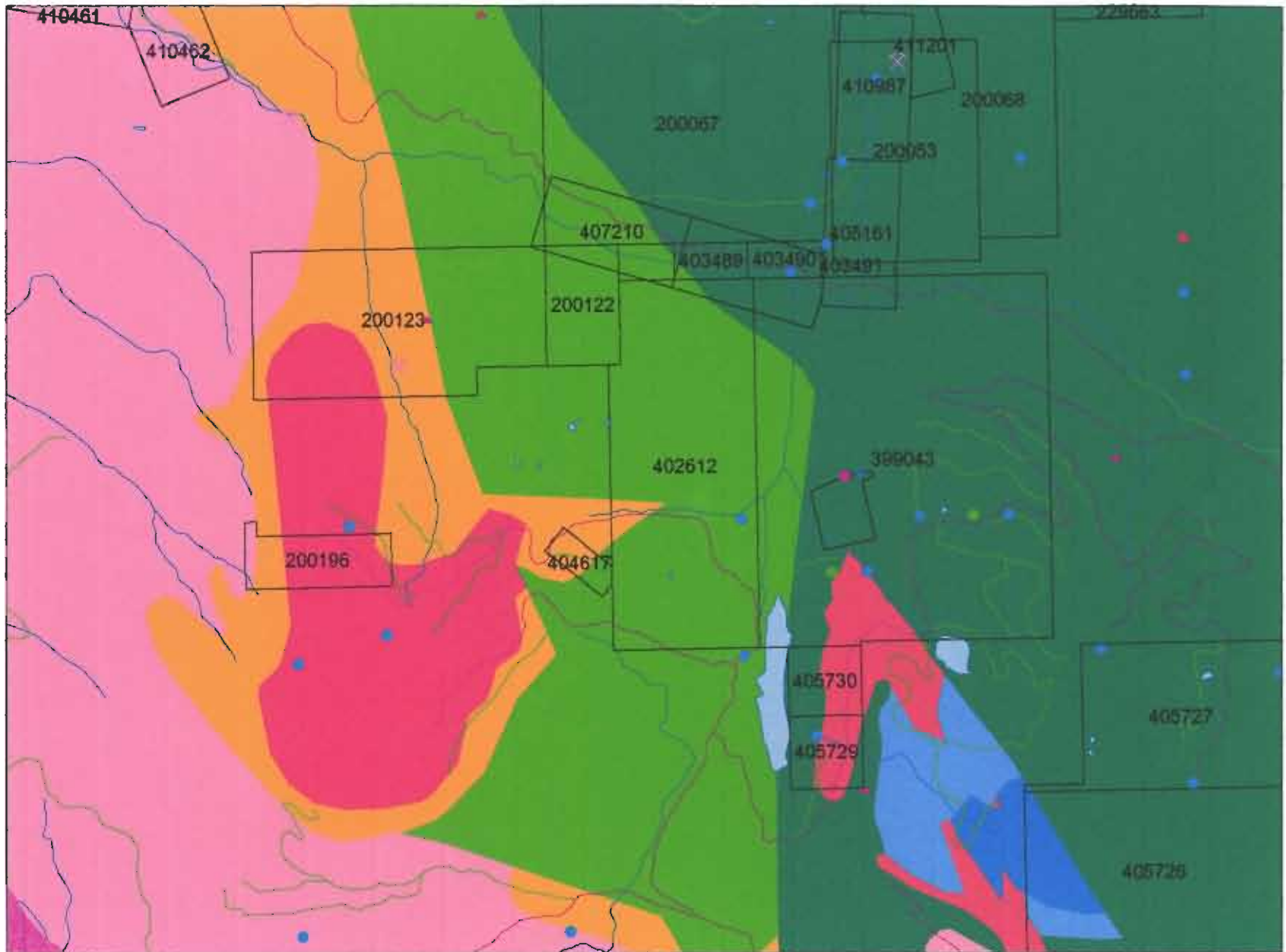
