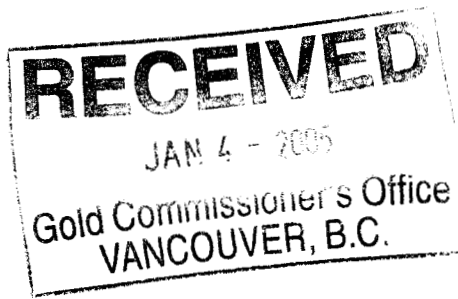

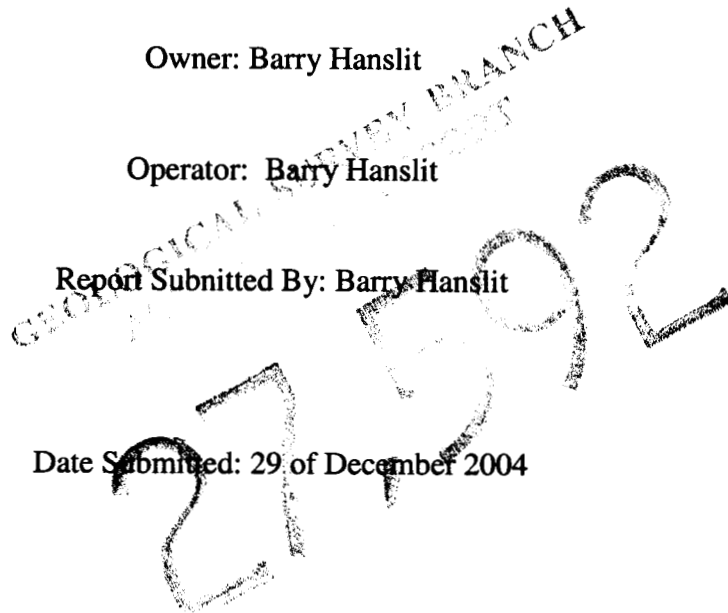

1.0 Introduction

The Blue Grouse claims 1 and 2 consists of a total of 2 units which were staked during October of 2003 to cover an area to the west of Lizard Lake.

2.0 Location and Access

The Blue Grouse claims are accessed from Port Alberni on Vancouver Island via logging roads. The Blue Grouse claims are located to the west of Lizard lake and are accessed via China Ck. Mainline and Duck Lake Mainline.

China Creek area has a long established history of both lode and placer mining exploration. Records show that placer mining was carried out in China Ck watershed as early as 1862.
