Introduction

Mineralization found on the North slope of Mt.Demers Between the West bank of the Fleet River and the South slope of Mt.Modeste.

This area is on the North ridge of the San Juan River valley, approx. 24.5 km East of Port Renfrew B.C. Access to this area is Hwy #18 to Cowichan Lake then onto South Shore Rd. to Mesachie Lk.
